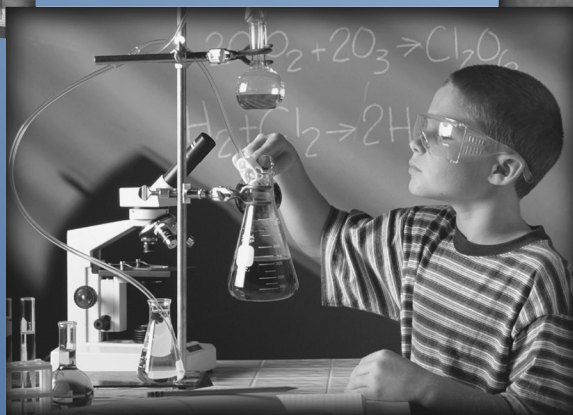
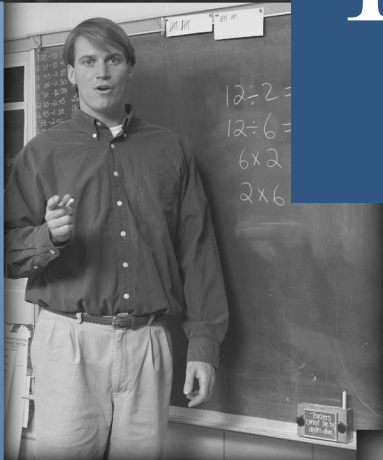

The *State Profiles* is an annual report aggregating many of the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program's statistics to the state level. Per §70-1210.531, the *State Profiles* delivers, "A summary report to the people and Legislature of Oklahoma of the information provided by the Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program."

The Oklahoma Educational Indicators Program provides school site, district, state, and national educational statistics derived from a number of sources. These sources include the Census Bureau's American Community Survey, Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE), Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education (OSRHE), Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs, National Center for Education Statistics, ACT, Inc., The College Board, and all Oklahoma public schools. This program has proven to be vital to parents, researchers, grant writers, school administrators, legislators, and the general public.

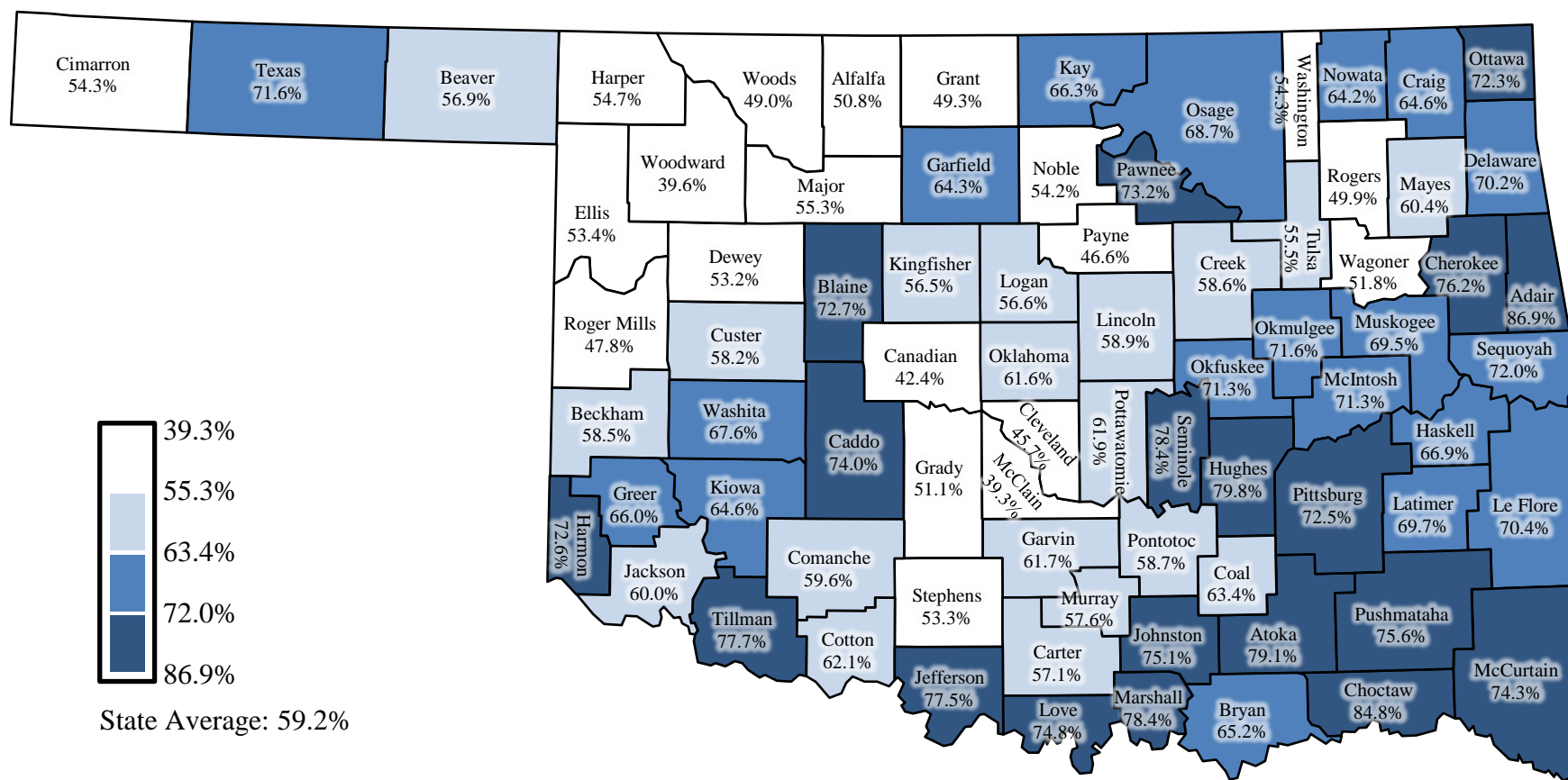

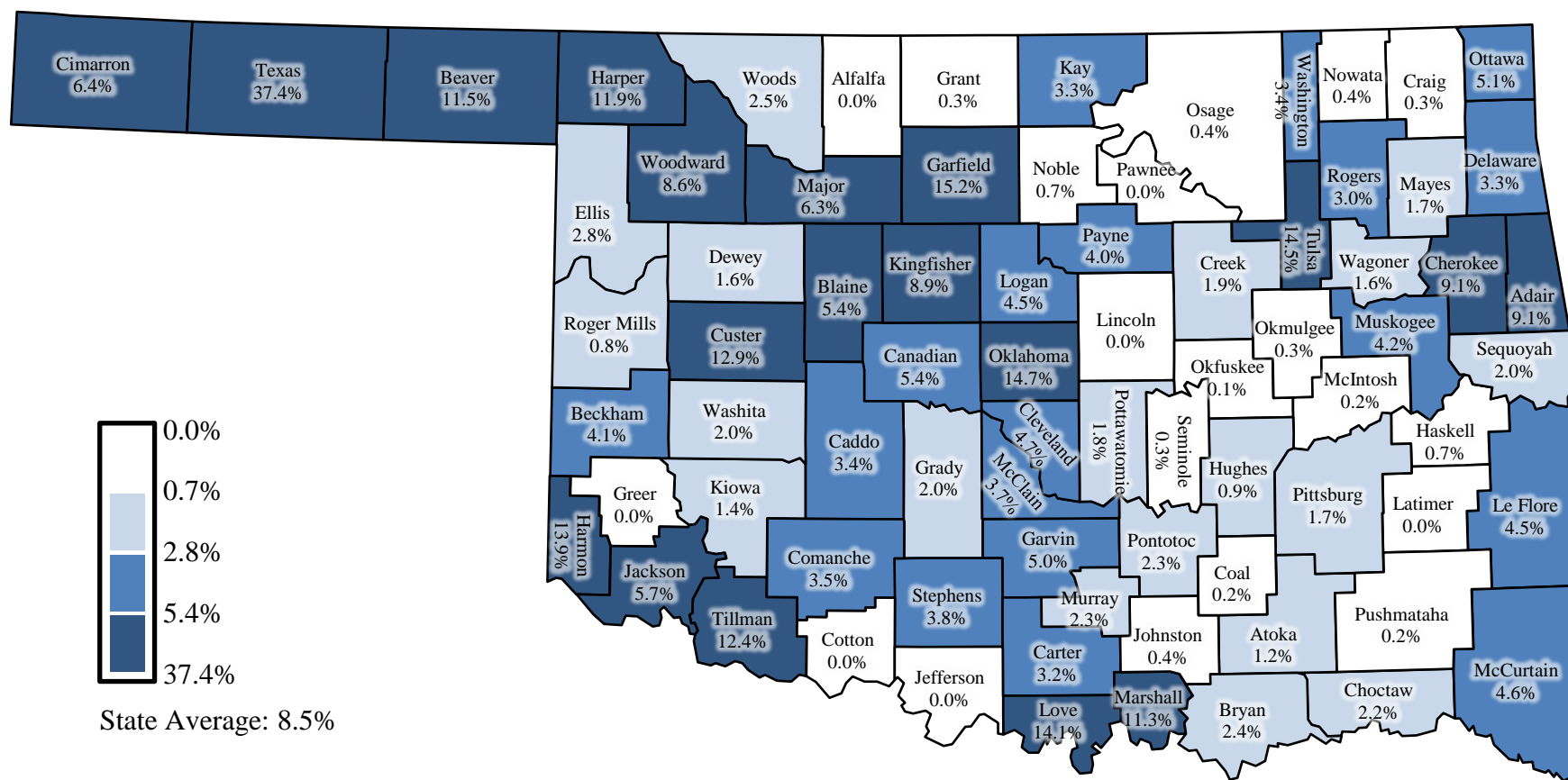
% Students as Economically Disadvantaged

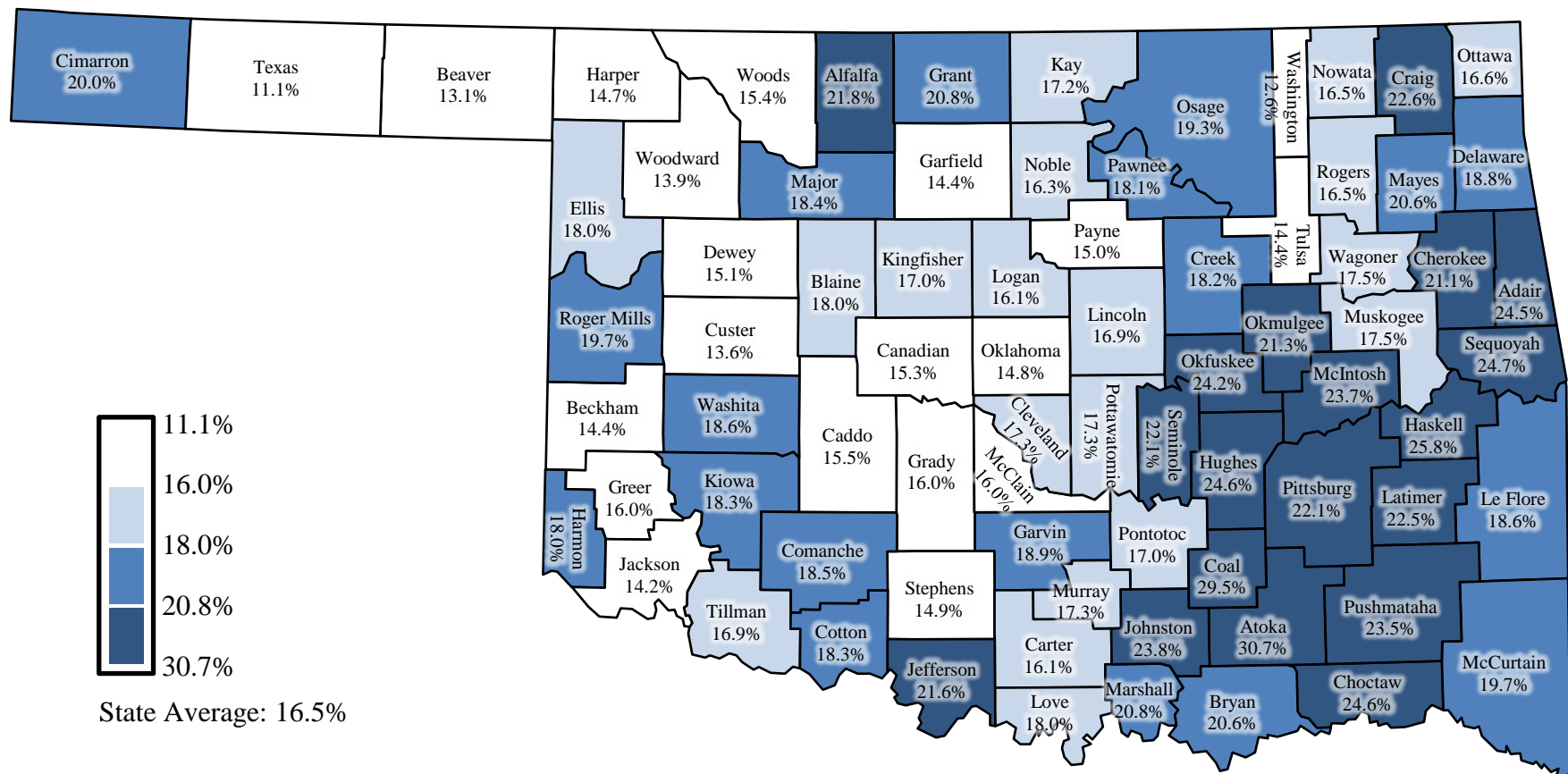
% Students Identified as English Language Learners 2019 - 2020 School Year

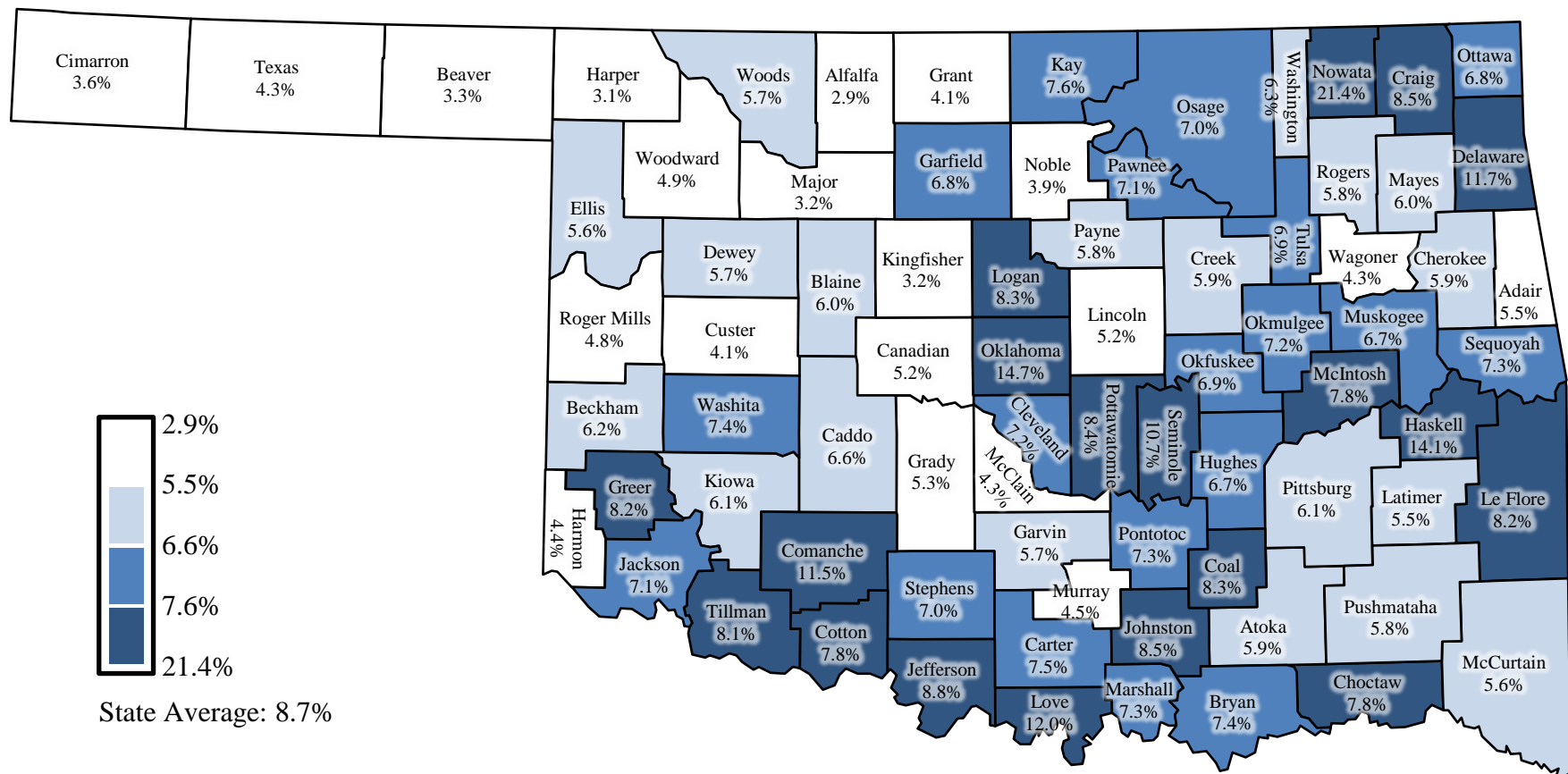
% Students in Special Education 2019 - 2020 School Year

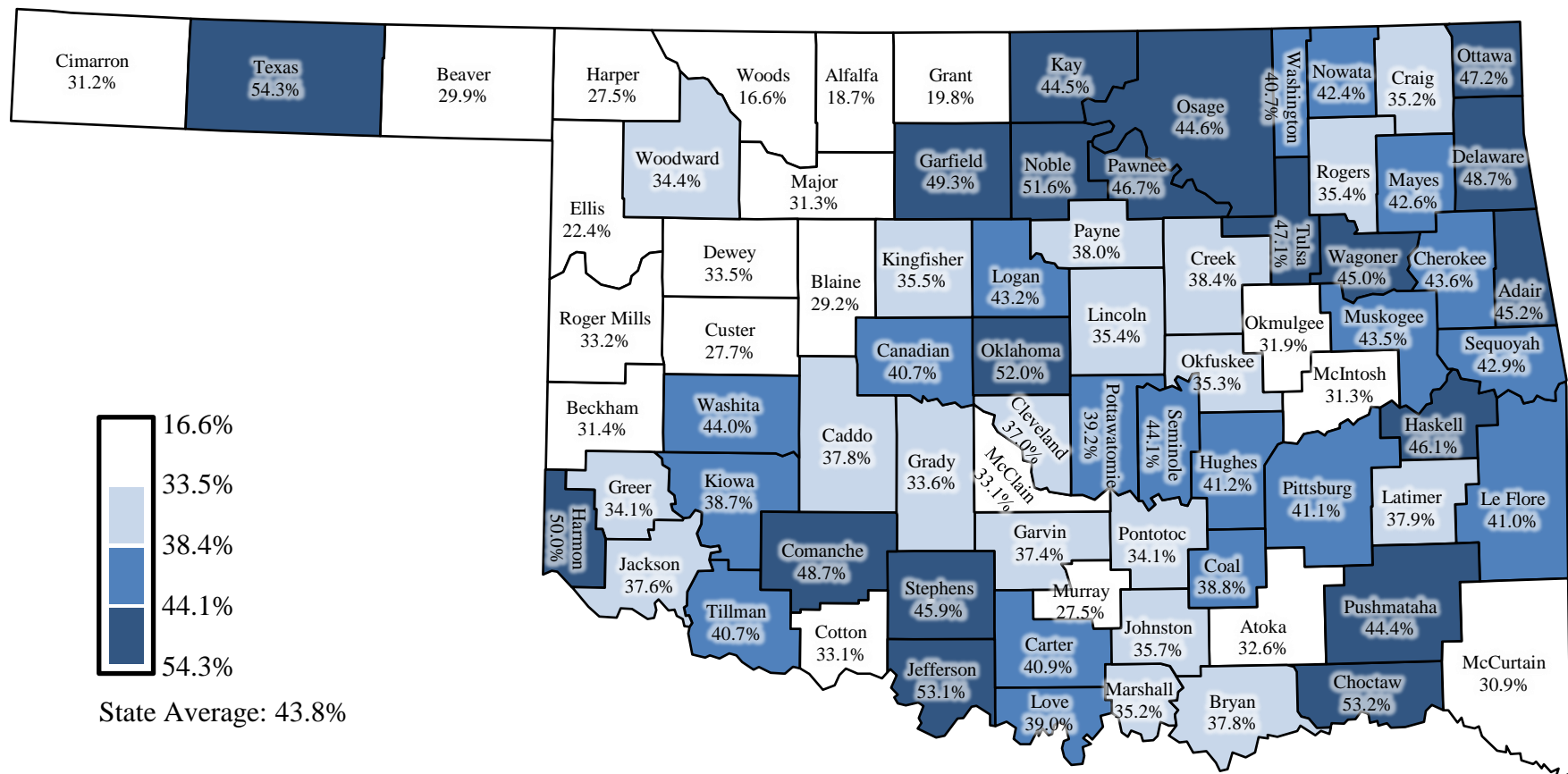
Incoming Student Mobility Rates 2019 - 2020 School Year

% KG-3rd Grade Students in Reading Remediation 2019 - 2020 School Year



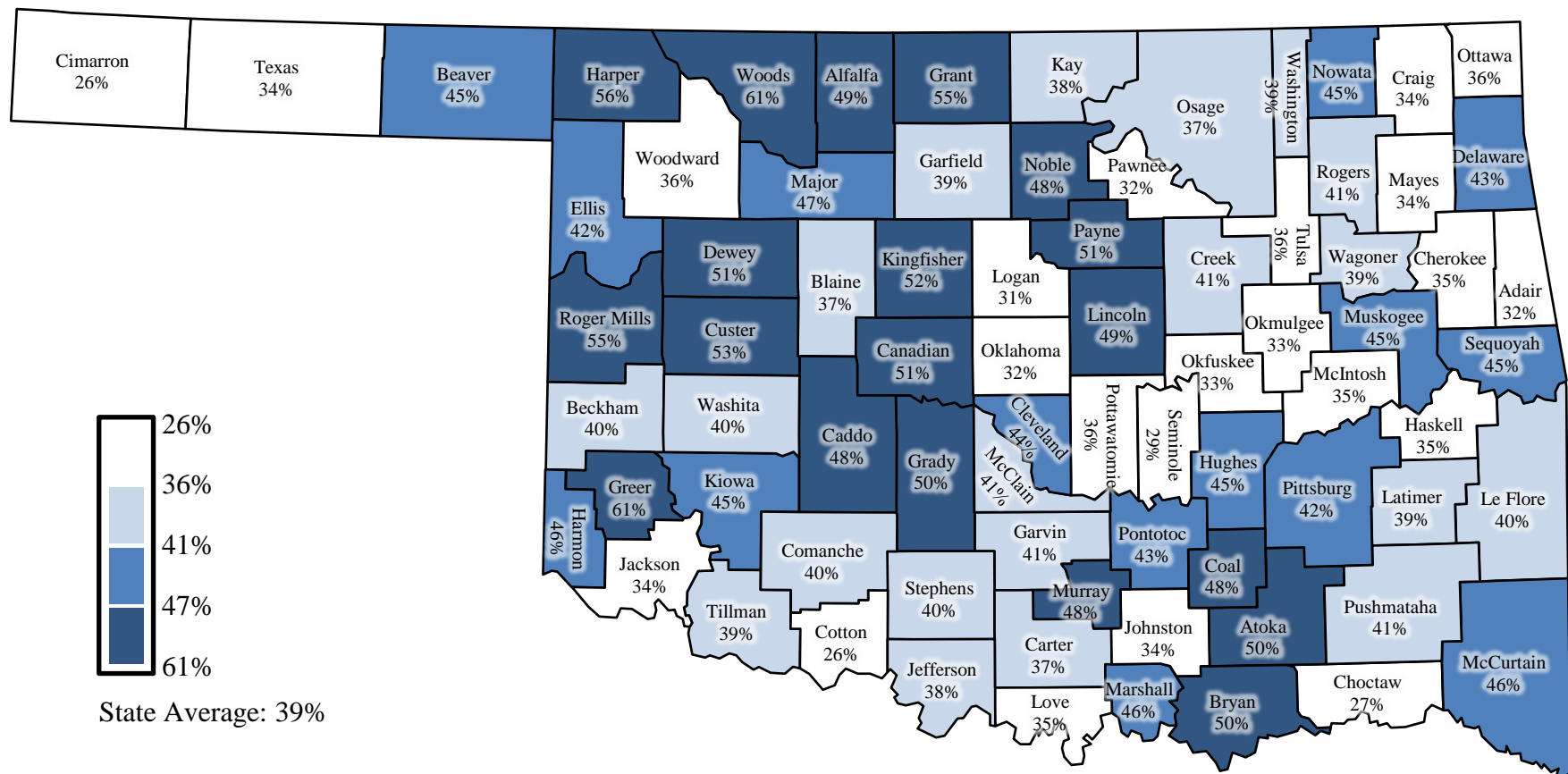

2018 - 2019 School Year



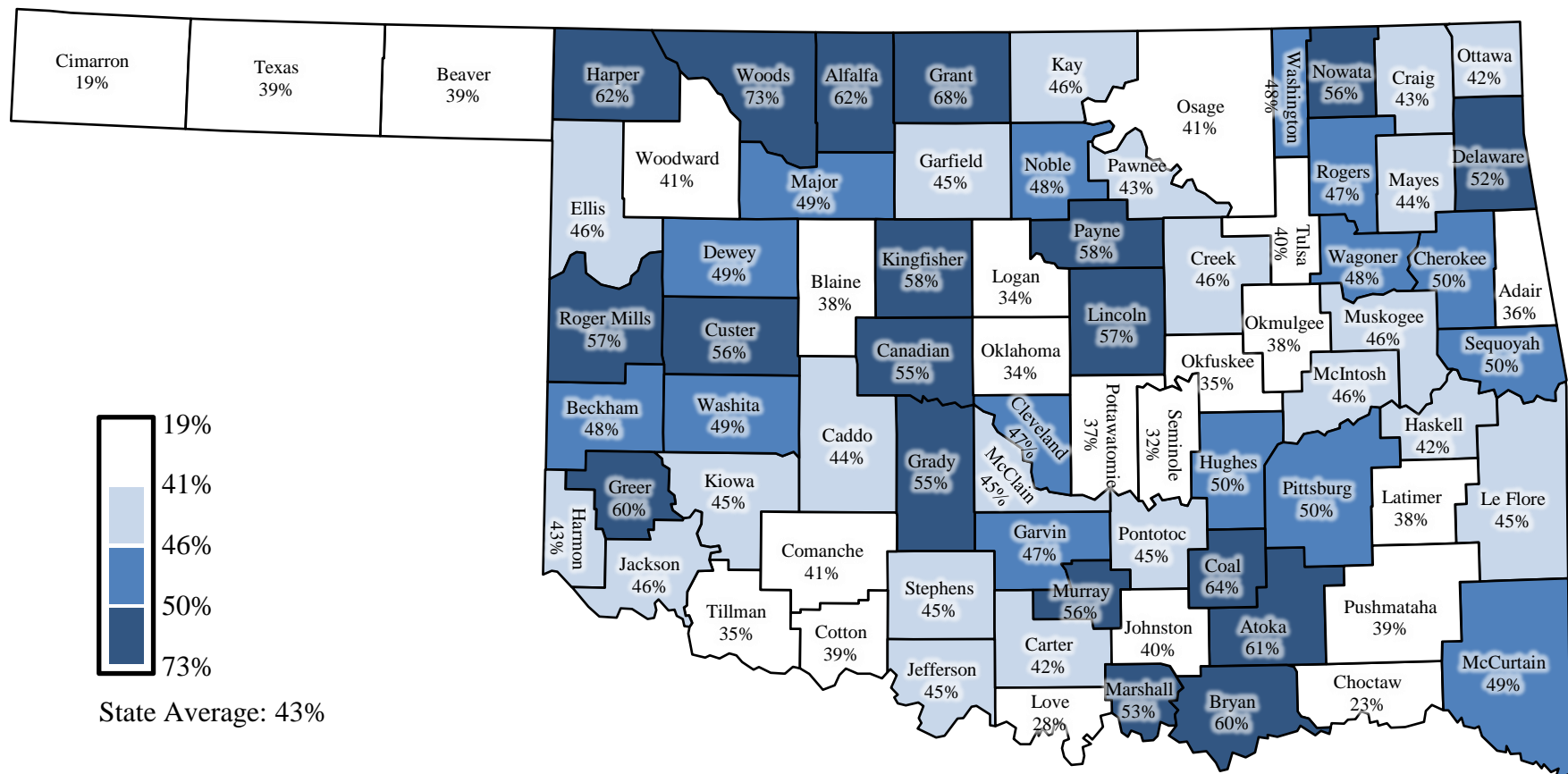

2018 - 2019 School Year



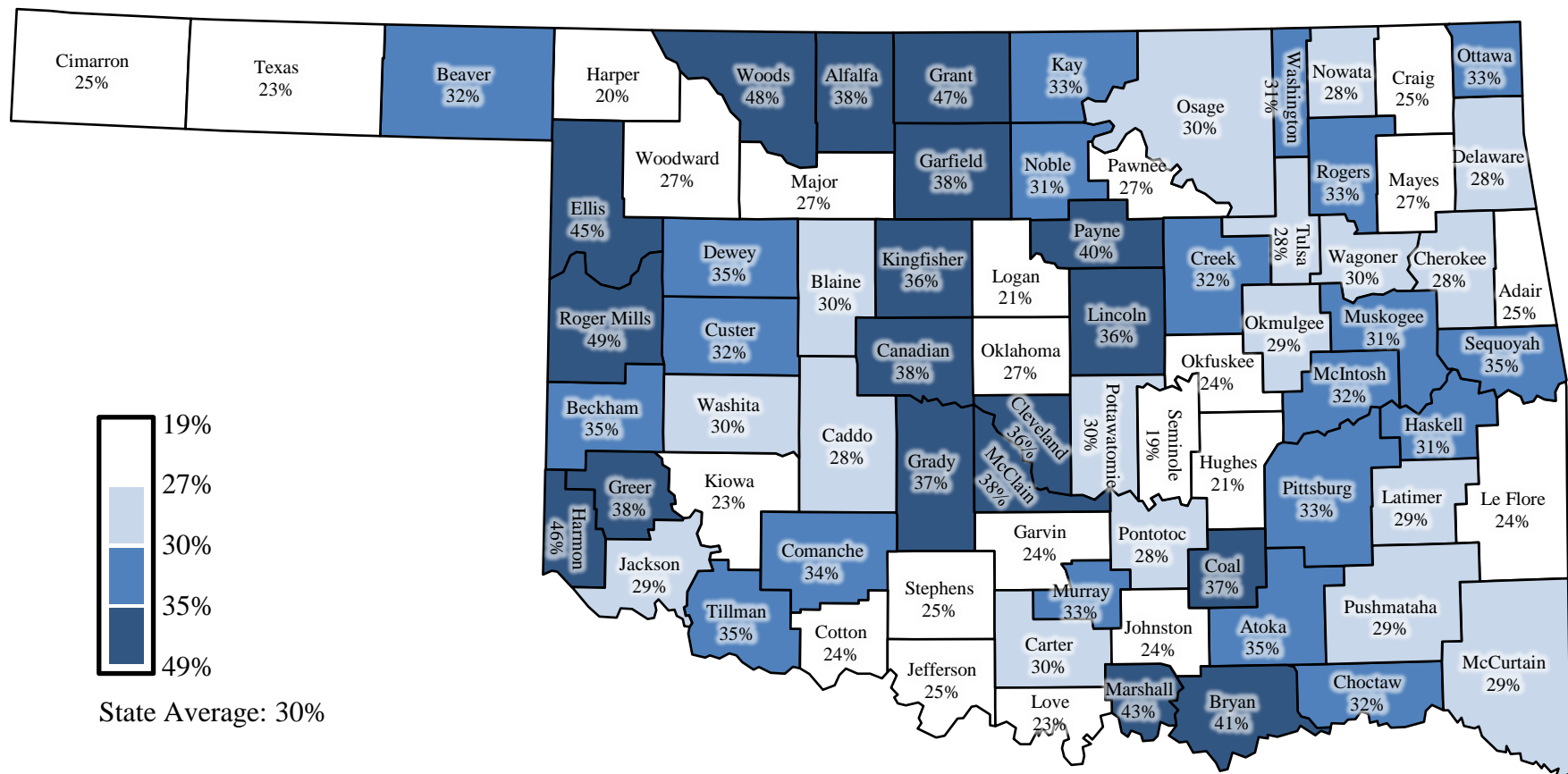

2018 - 2019 School Year



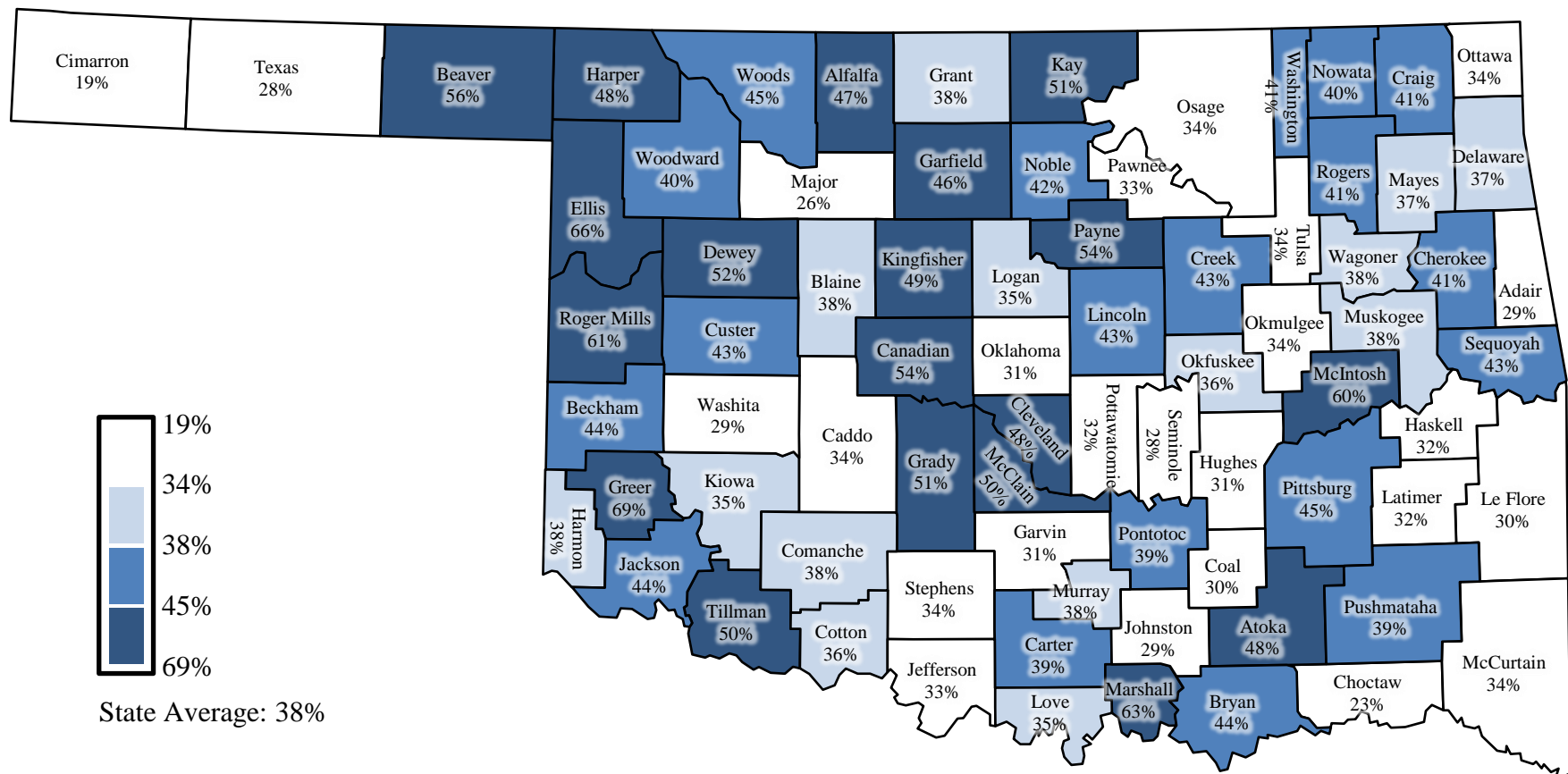

2018 - 2019 School Year



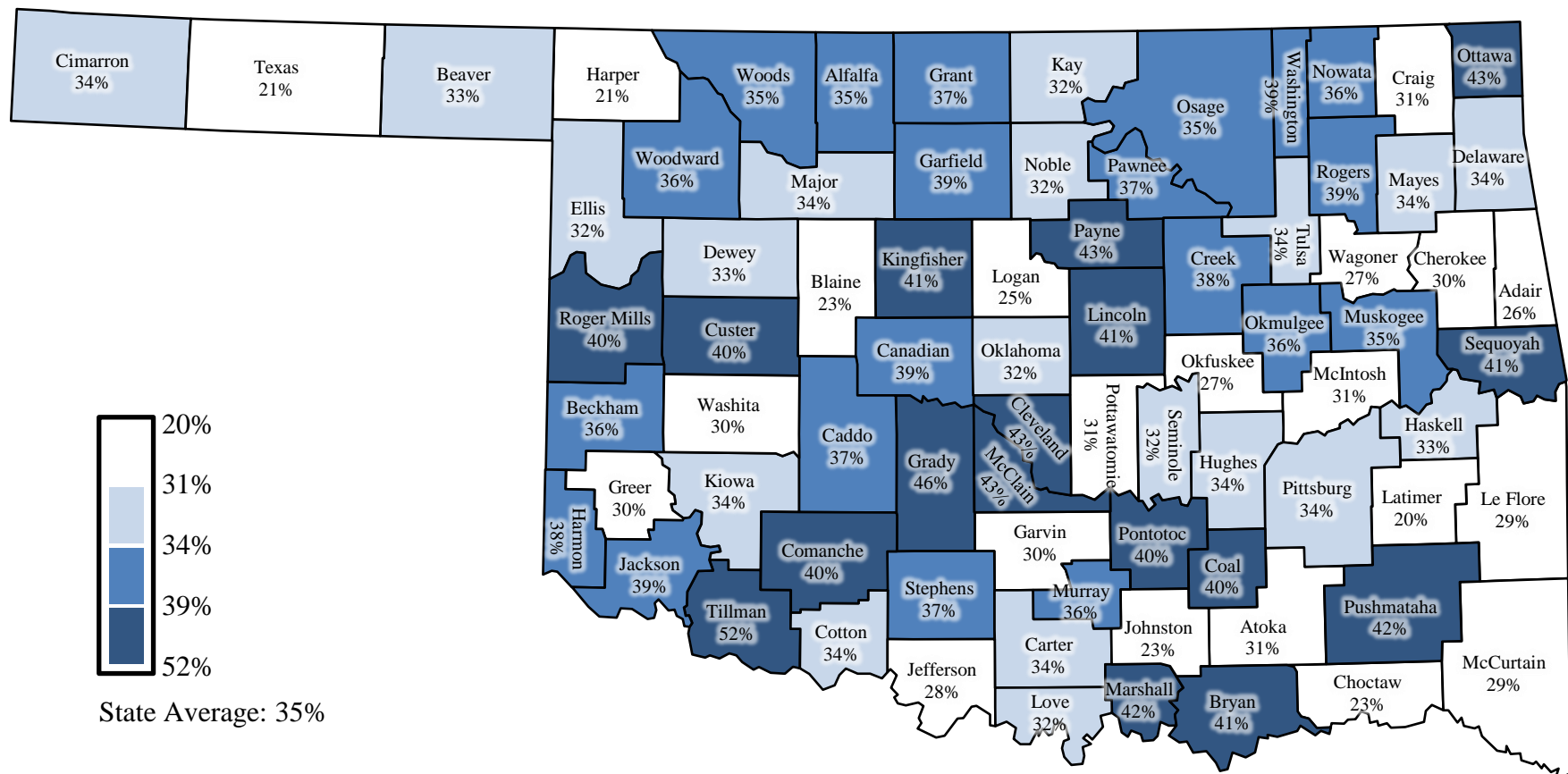

2018 - 2019 School Year



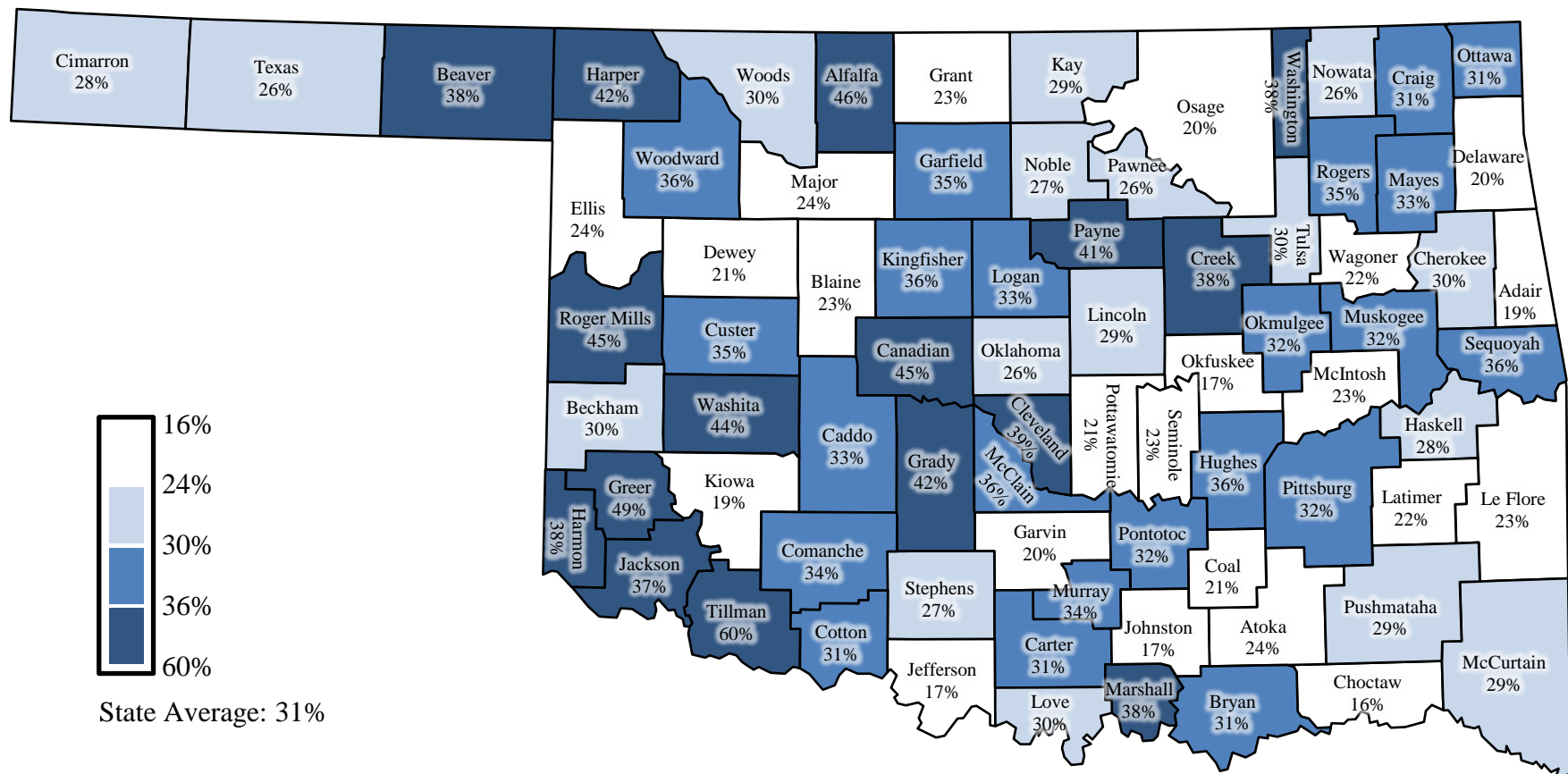

2018 - 2019 School Year



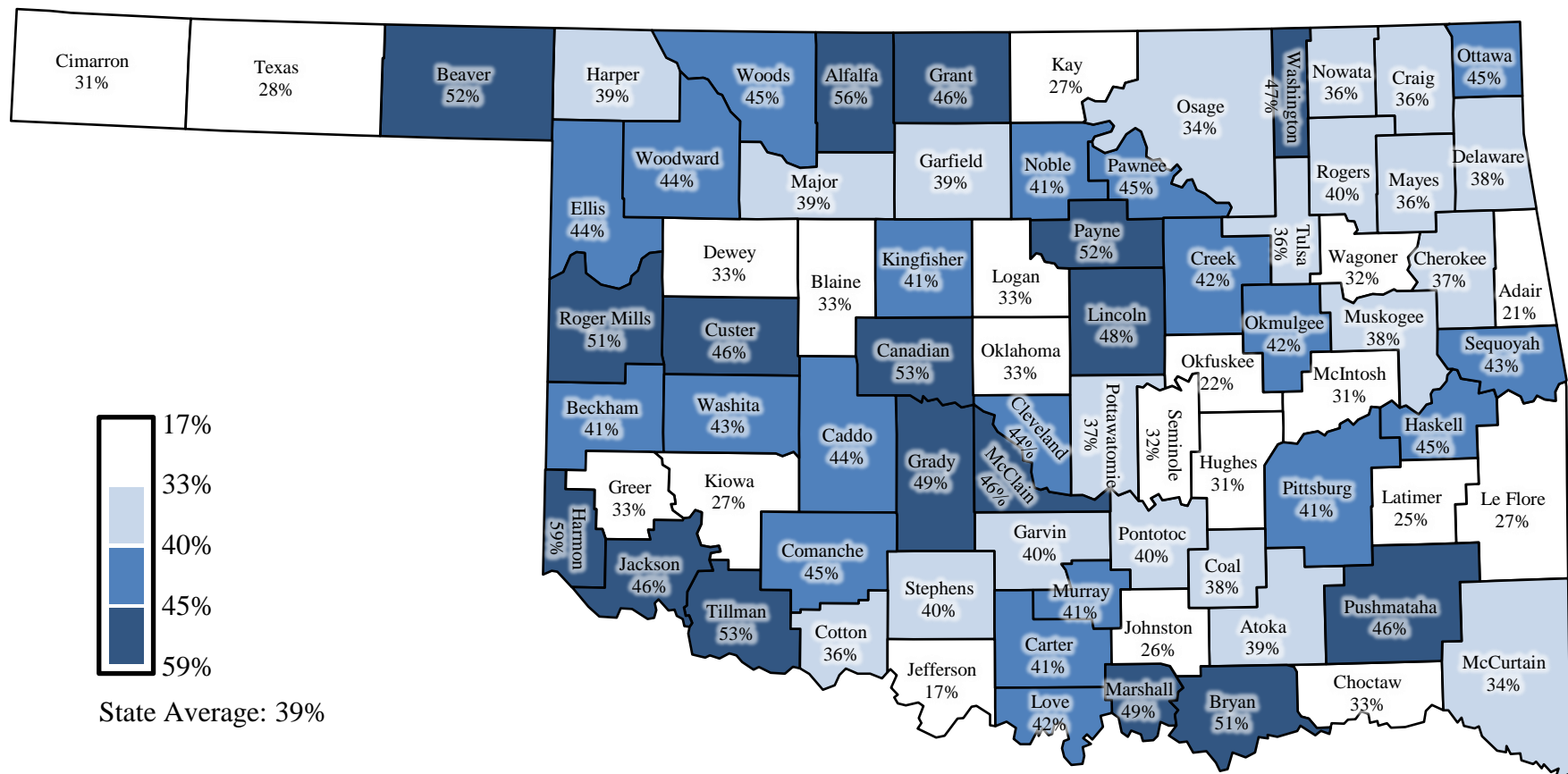

2018 - 2019 School Year



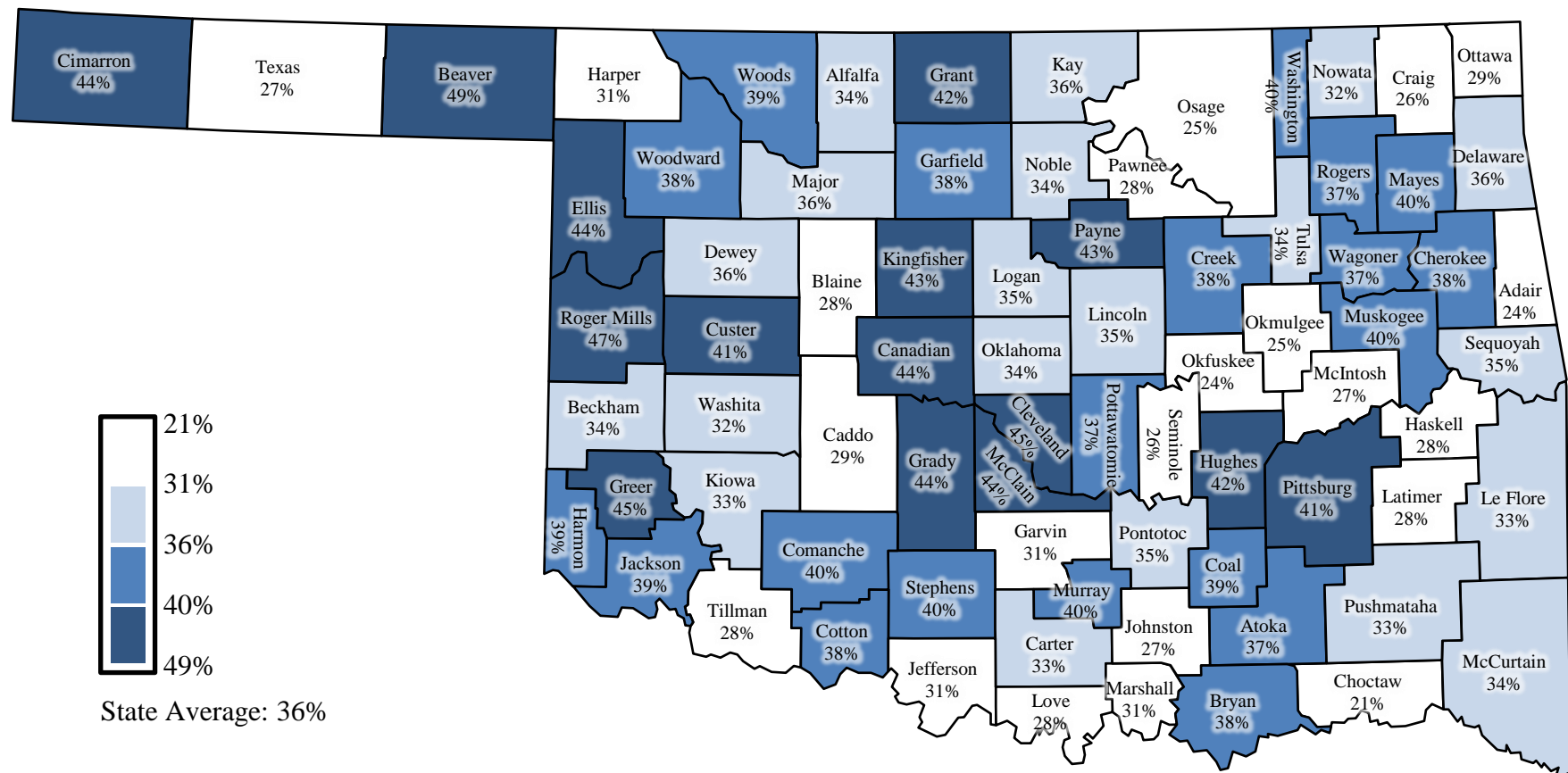

6th Grade OSTP - ELA

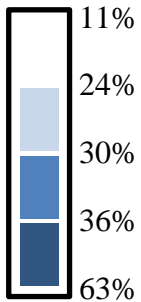

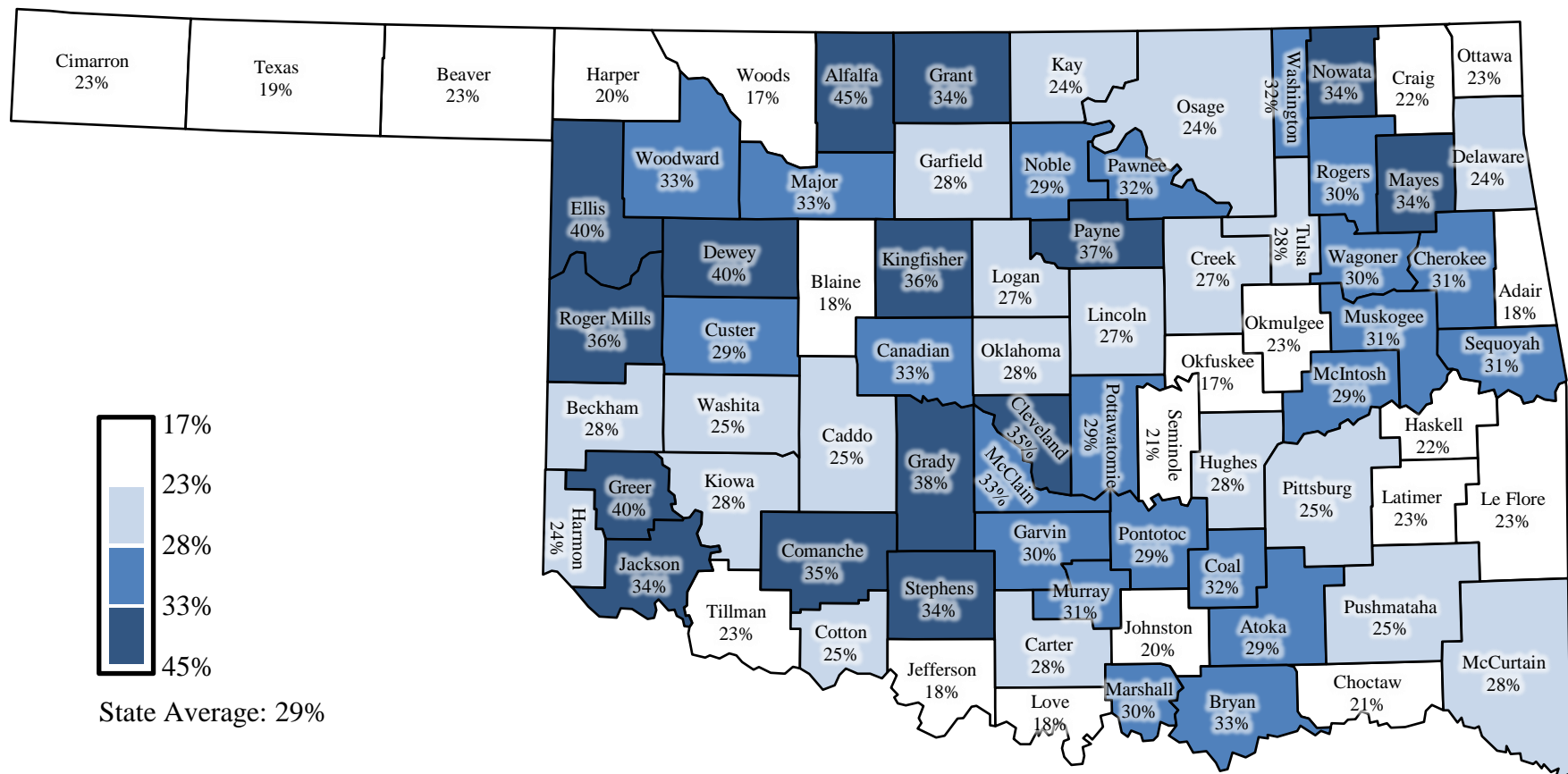

2018 - 2019 School Year



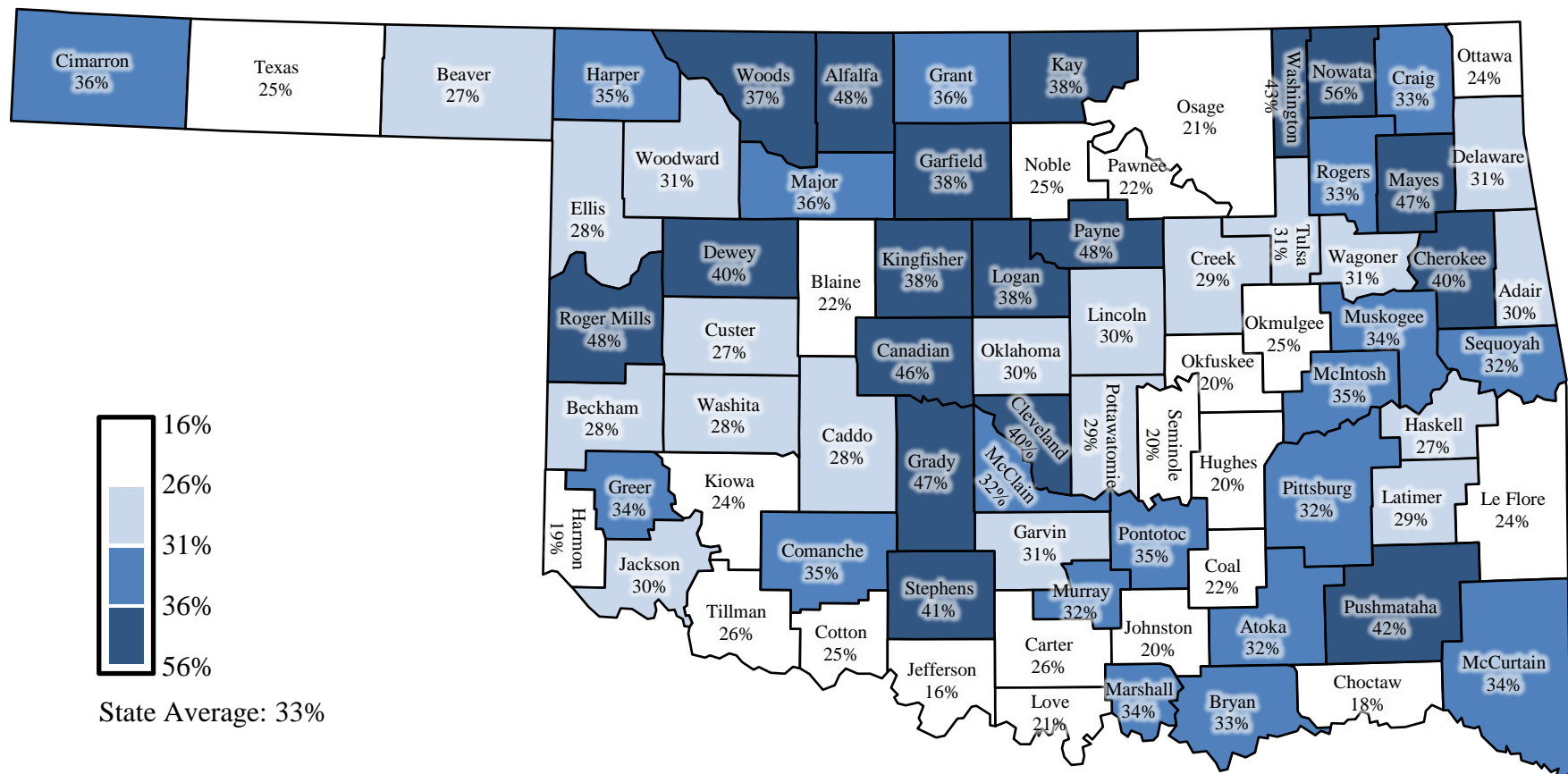

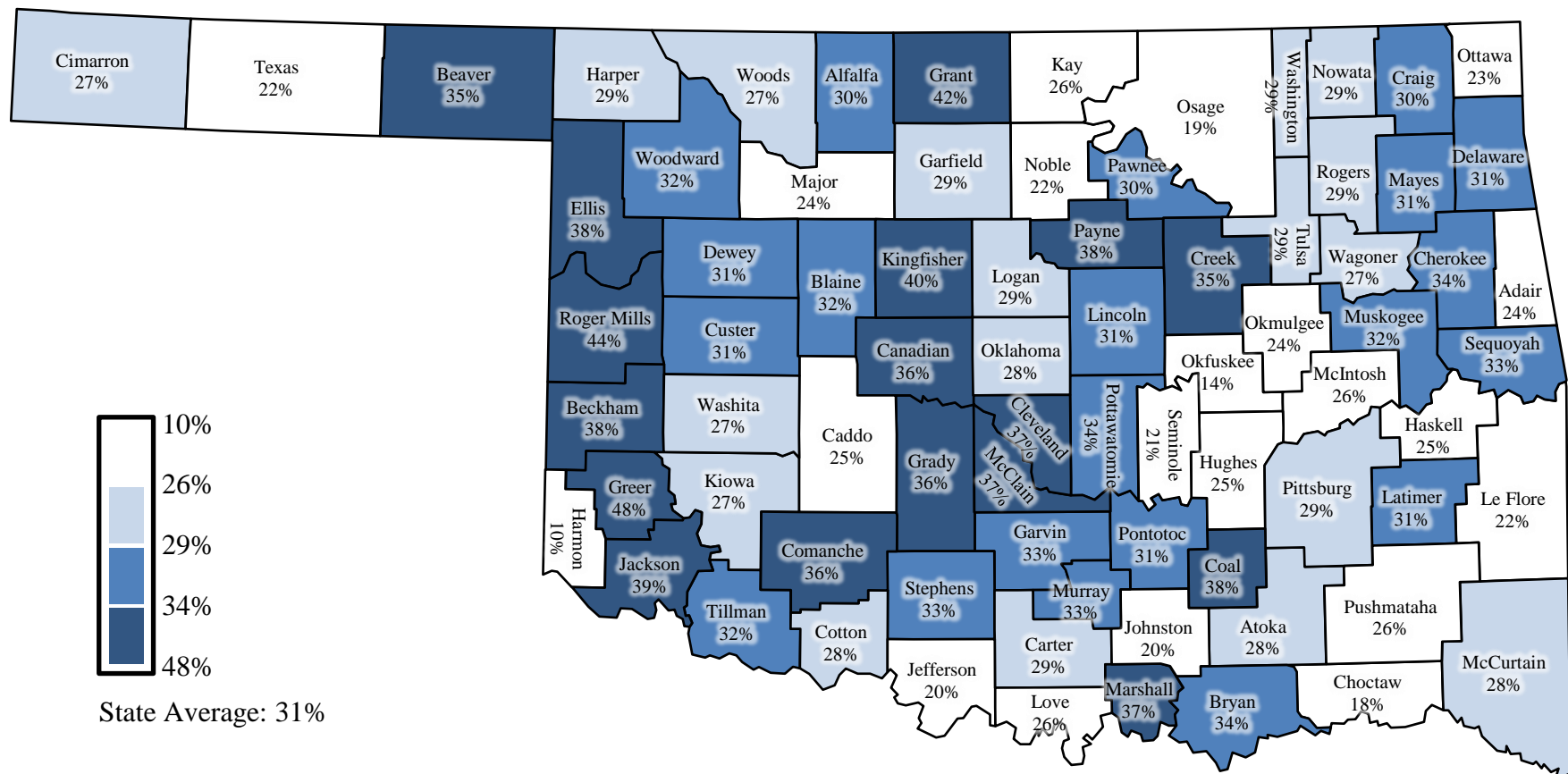

8th Grade OSTP - ELA

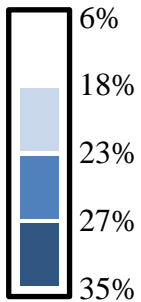

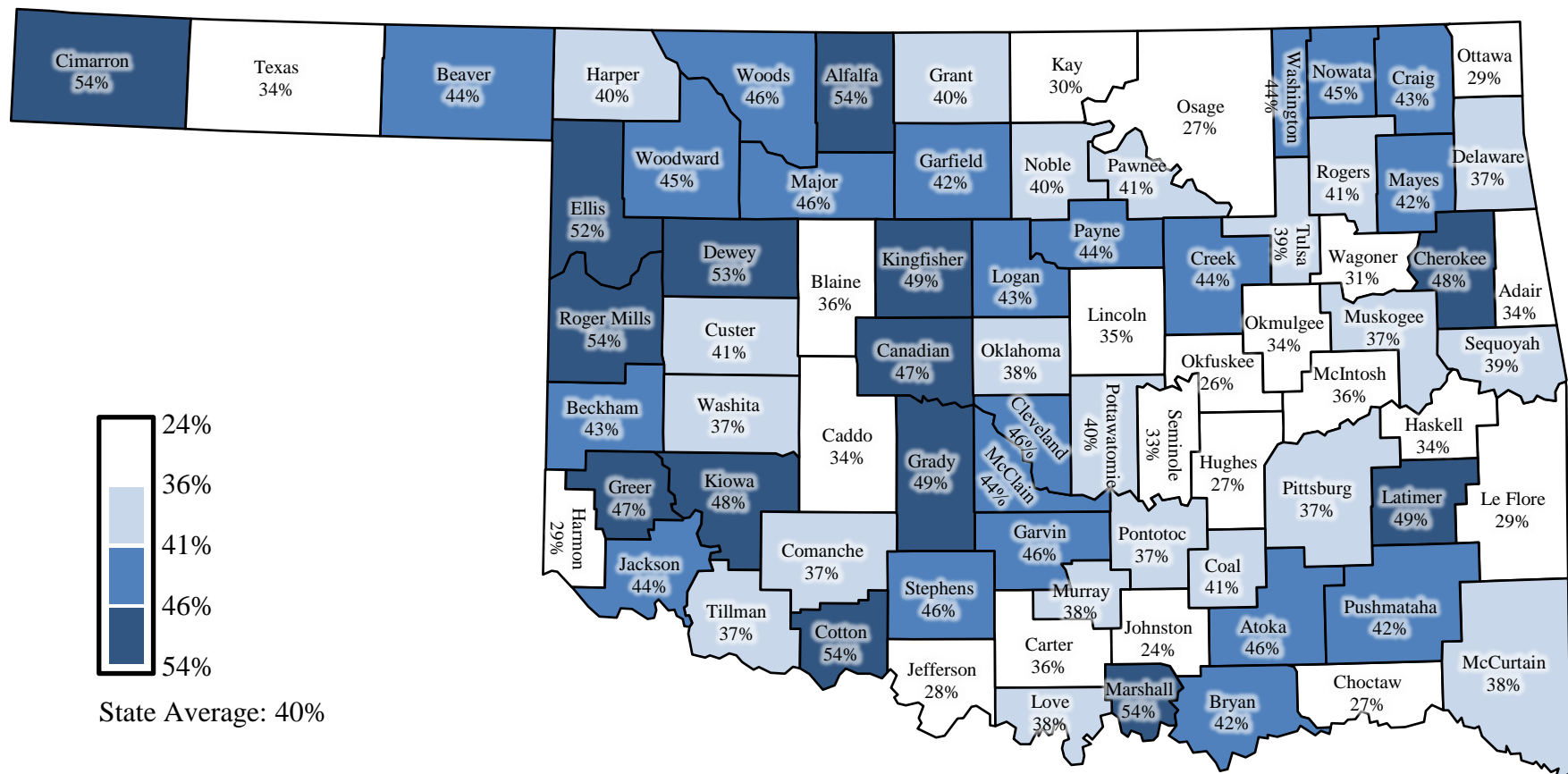

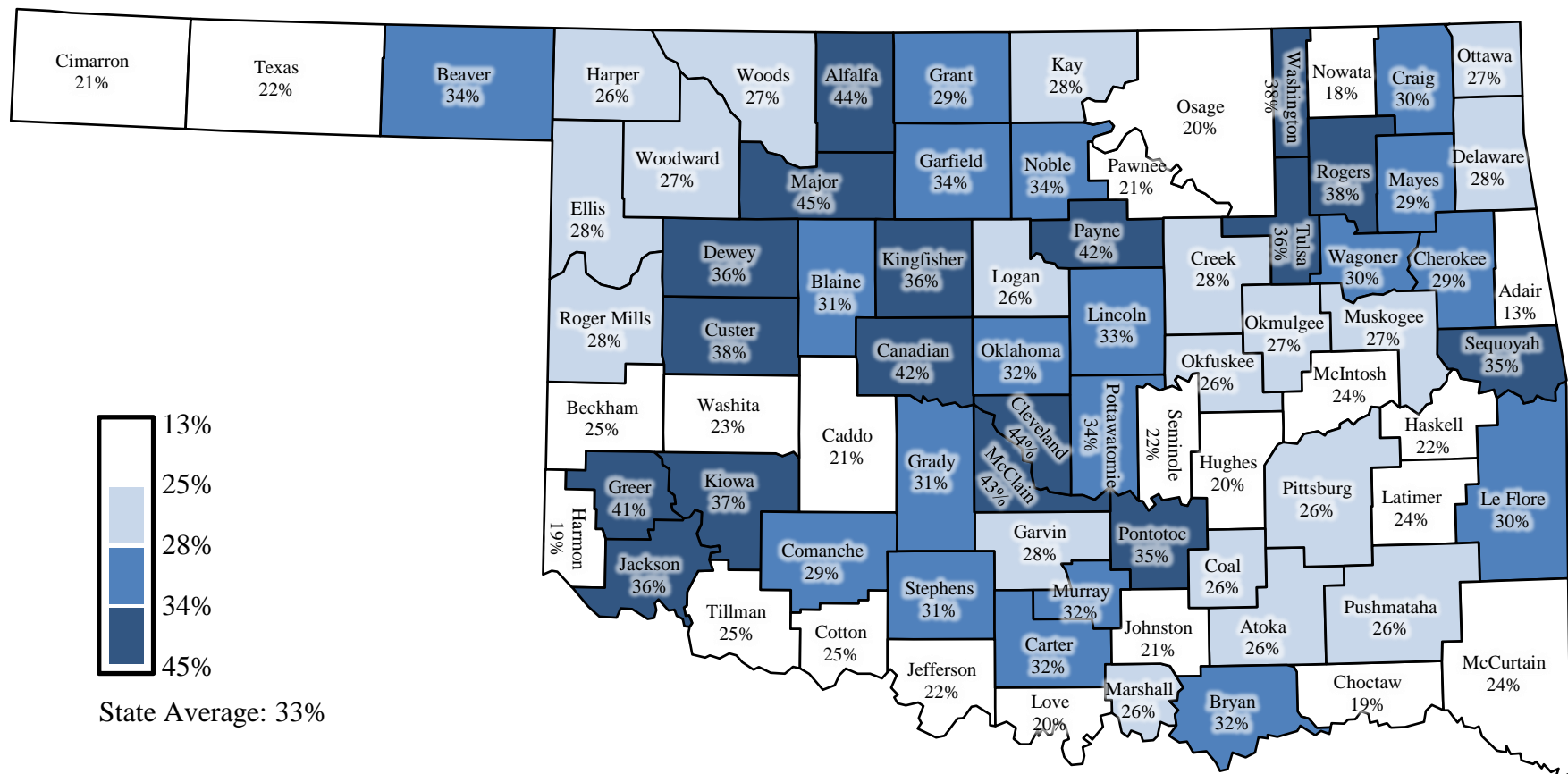

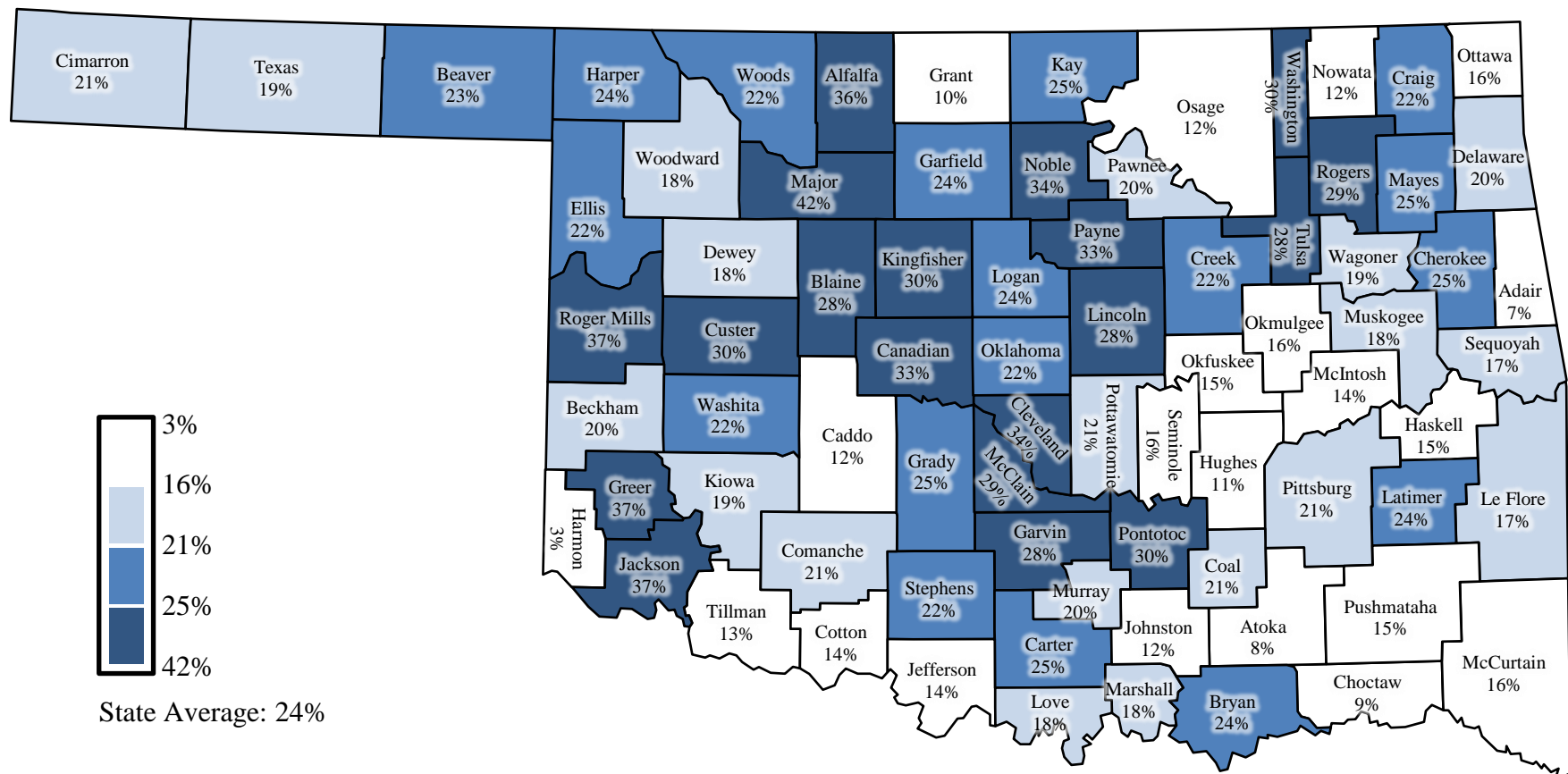

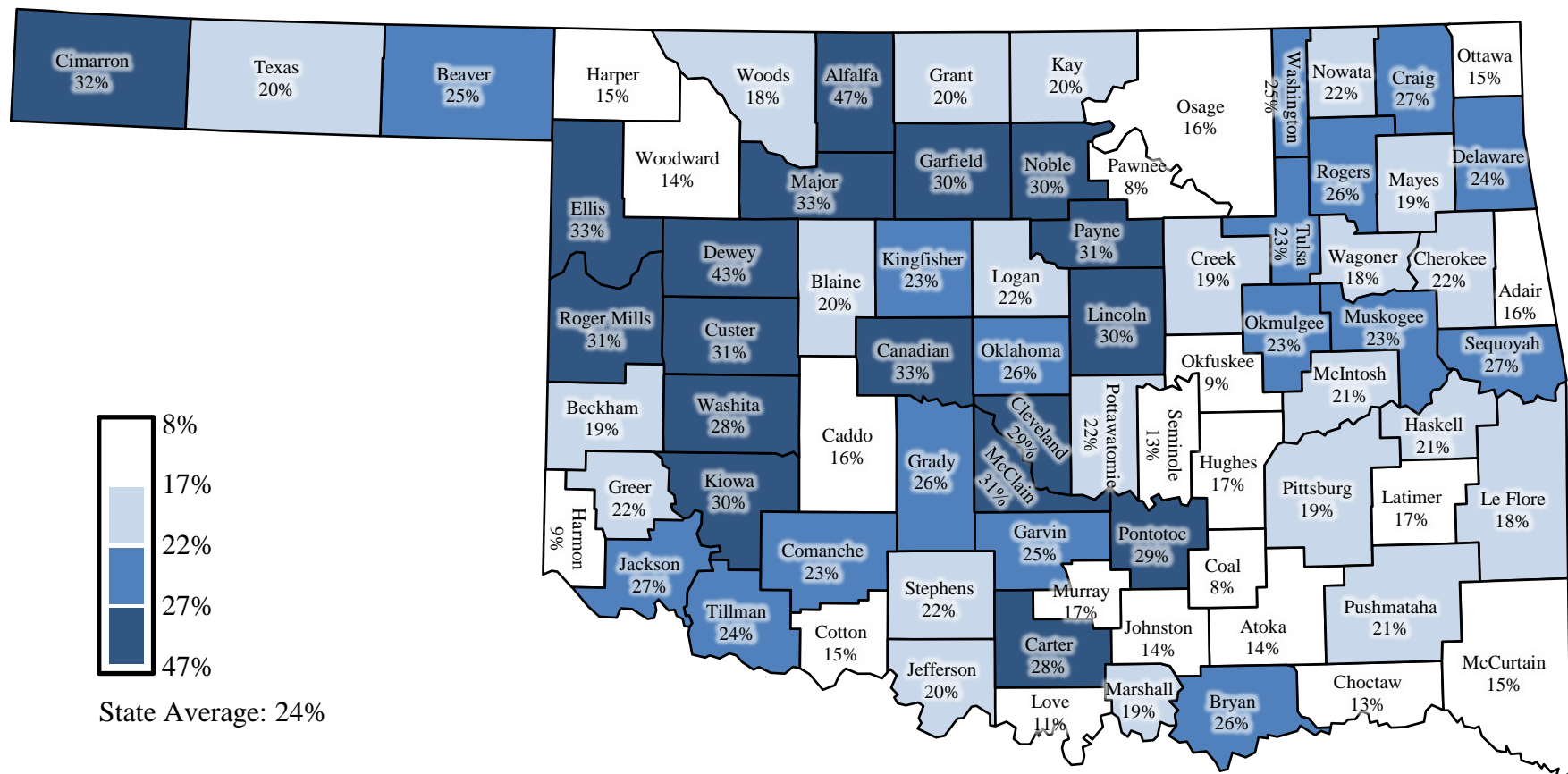

% Students Scoring Proficient or Above

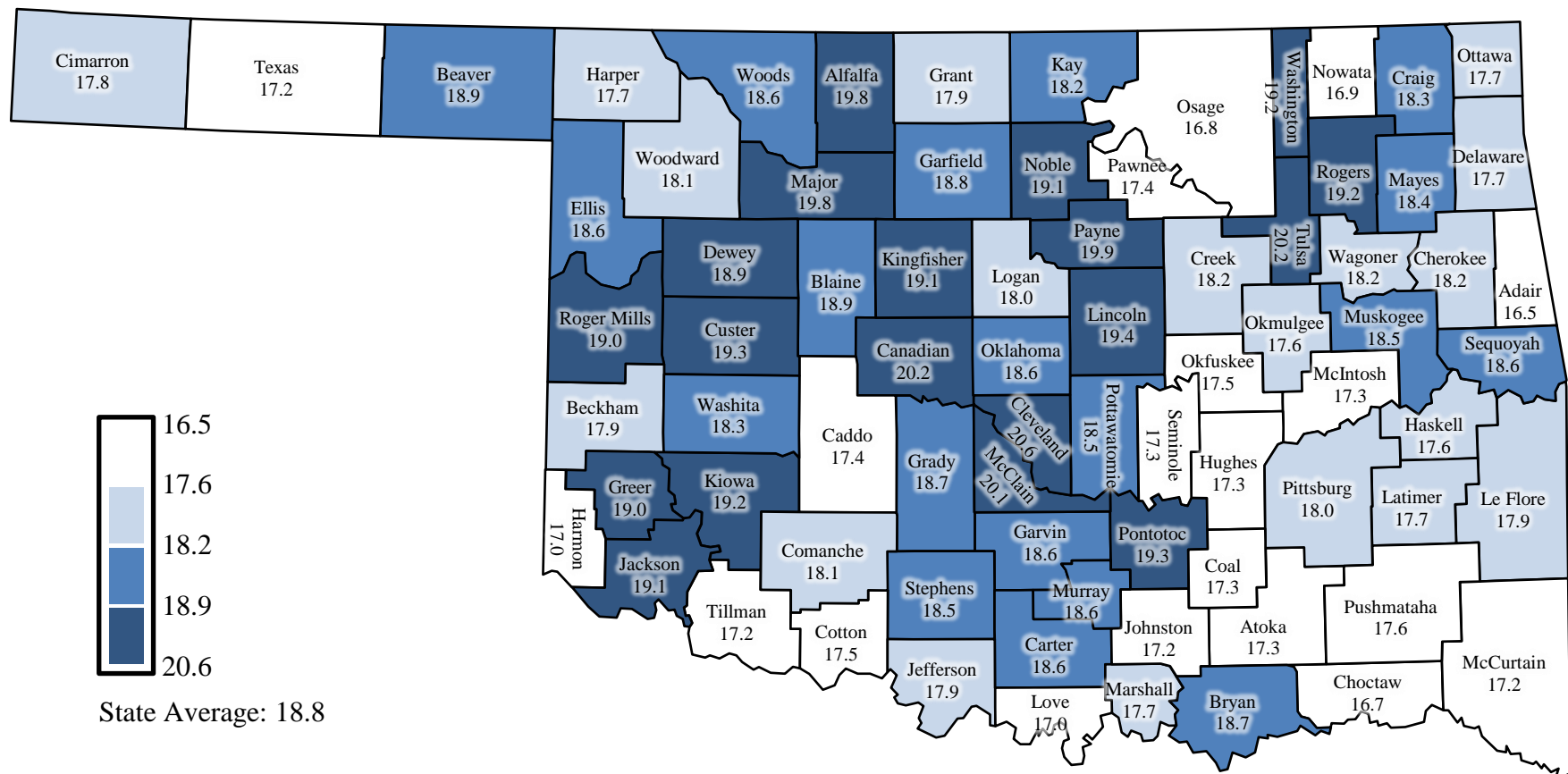

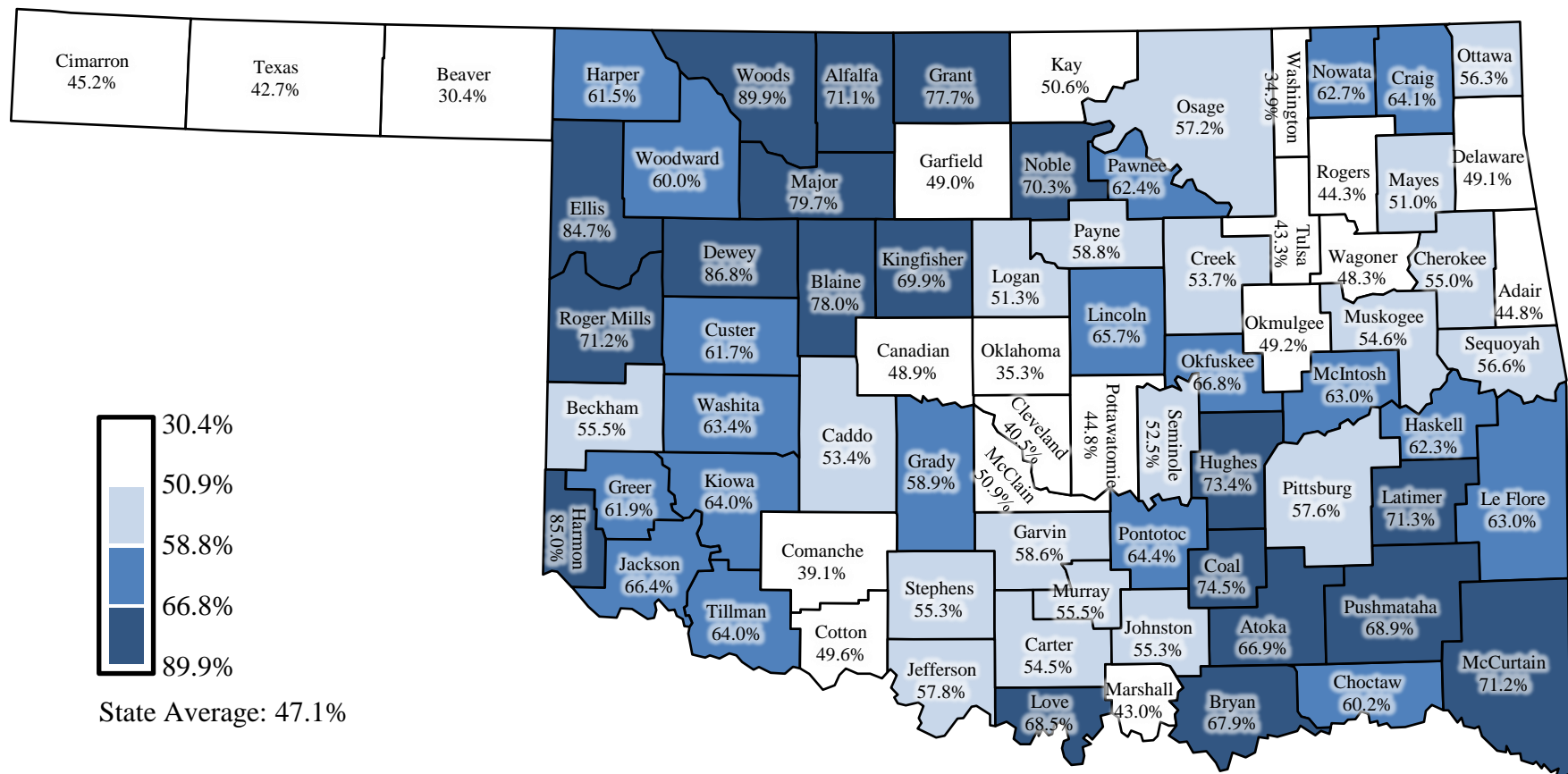

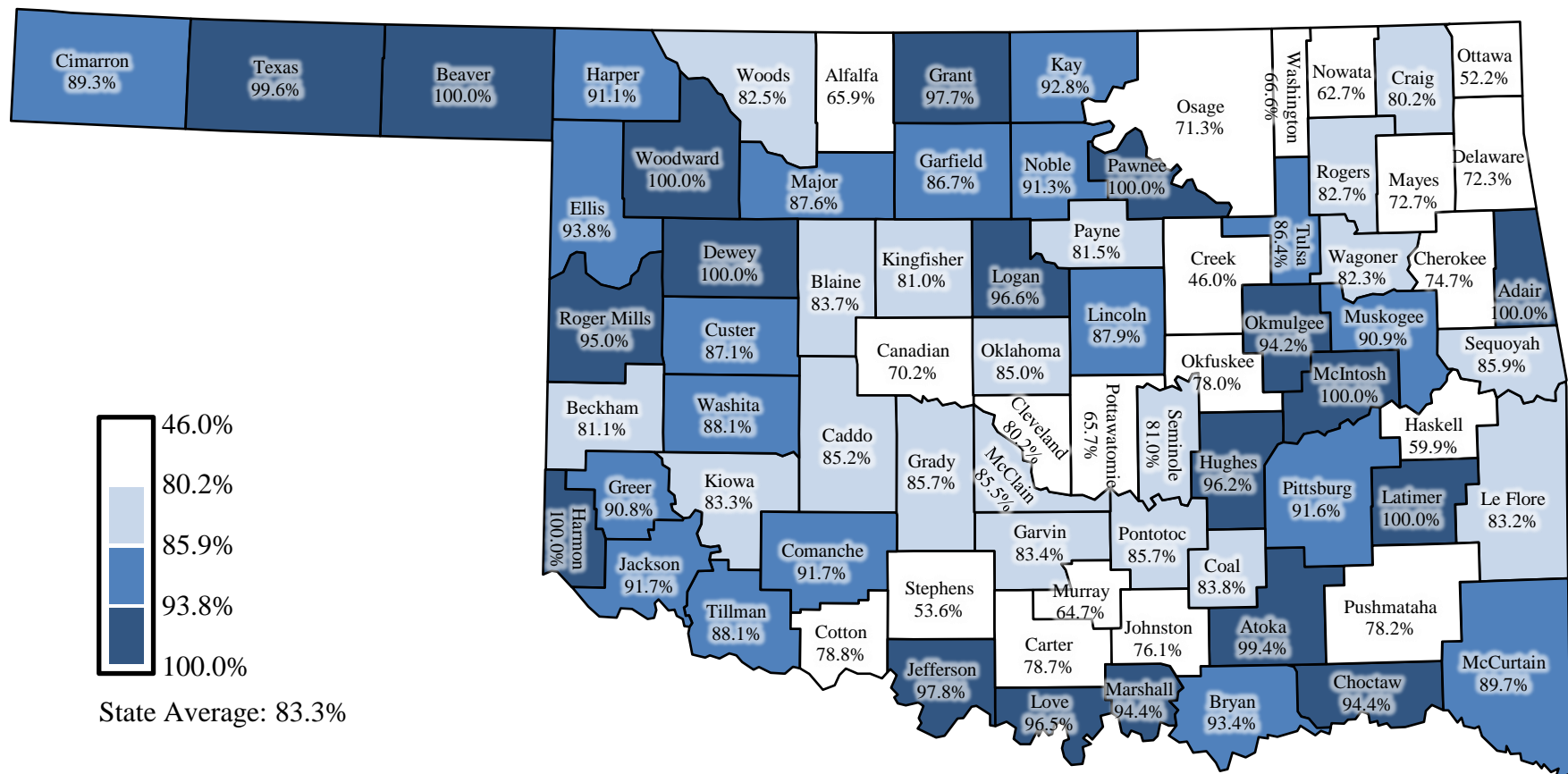
% Juniors/Seniors Served by CareerTech 2019 - 2020 School Year

% High School Graduates Completing College-Bound Curriculum 2019 - 2020 School Year

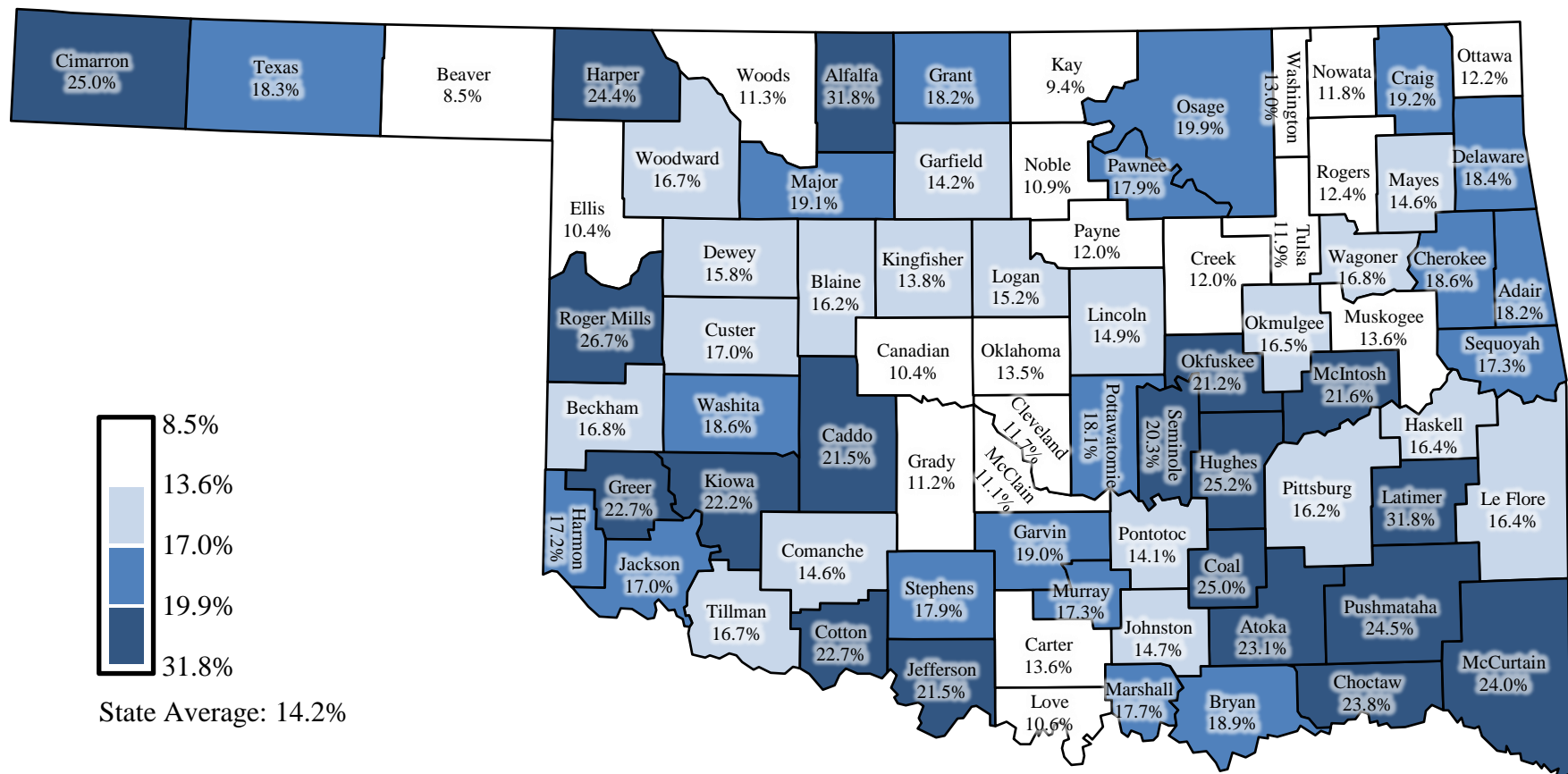

% Graduates Earning OK Promise

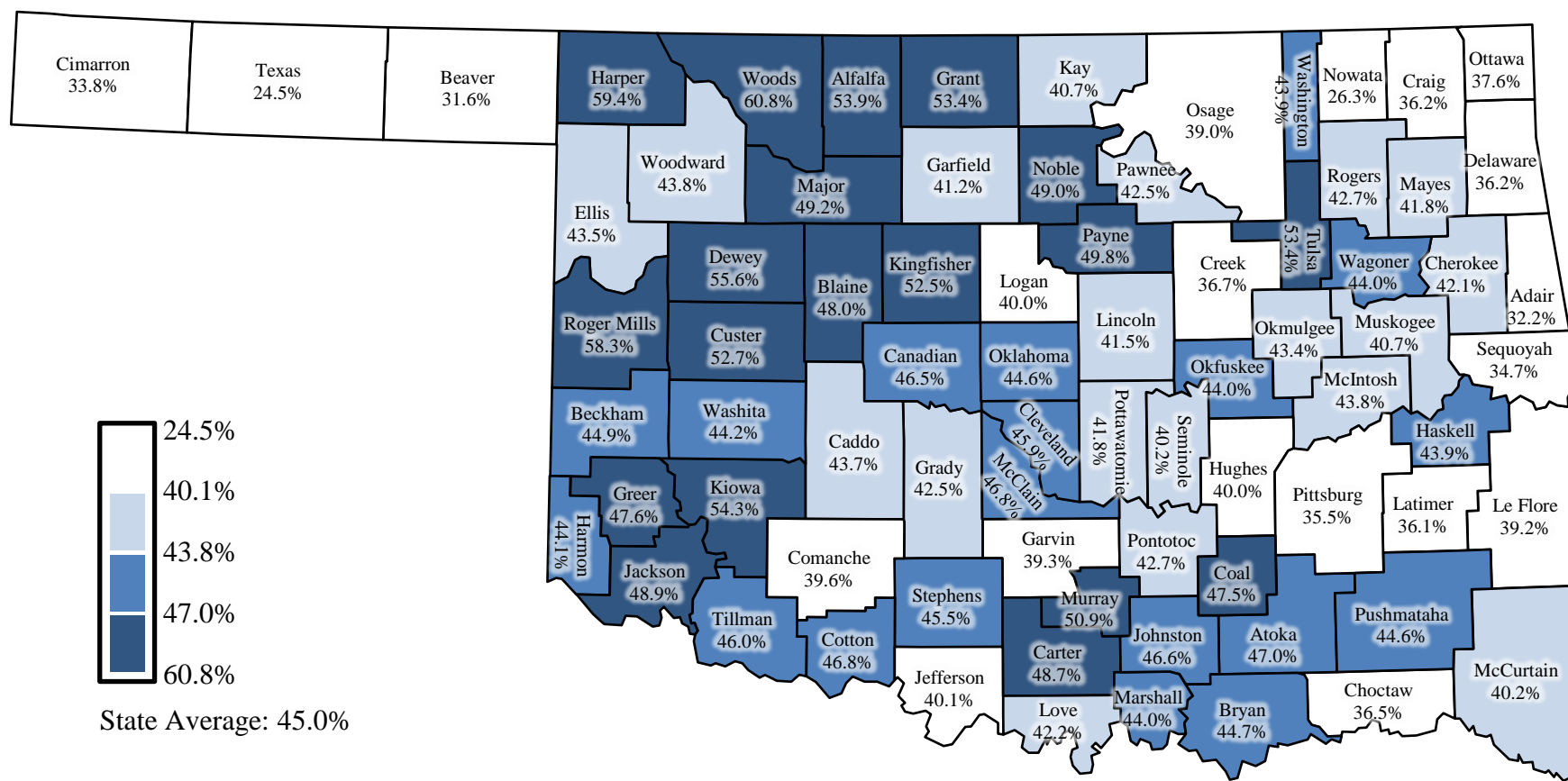

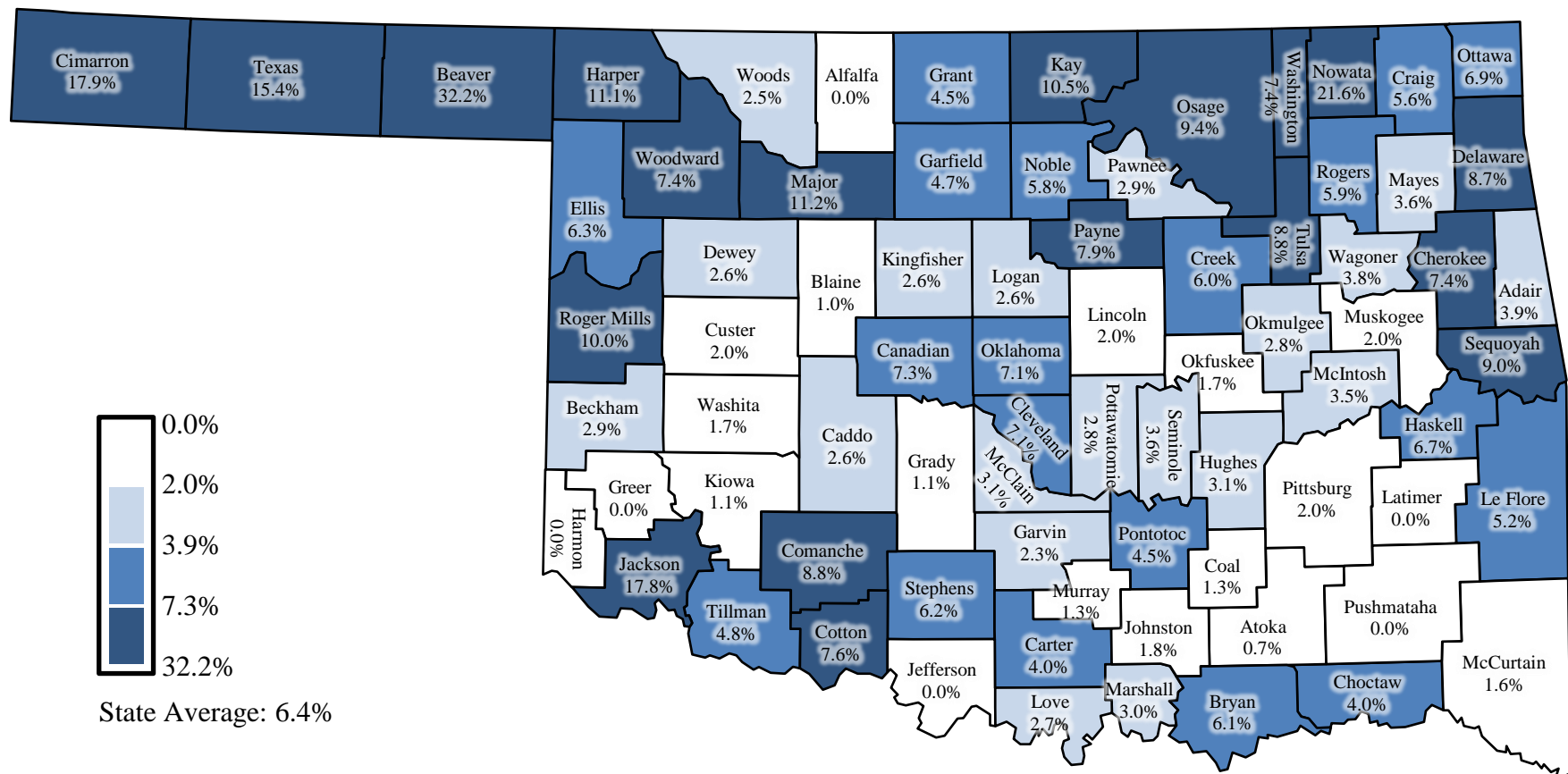
Oklahoma College-Going Rates of High School Graduates 2017 - 2019 School Years

Out-of-State College-Going Rates of High School Graduates 2020 School Year

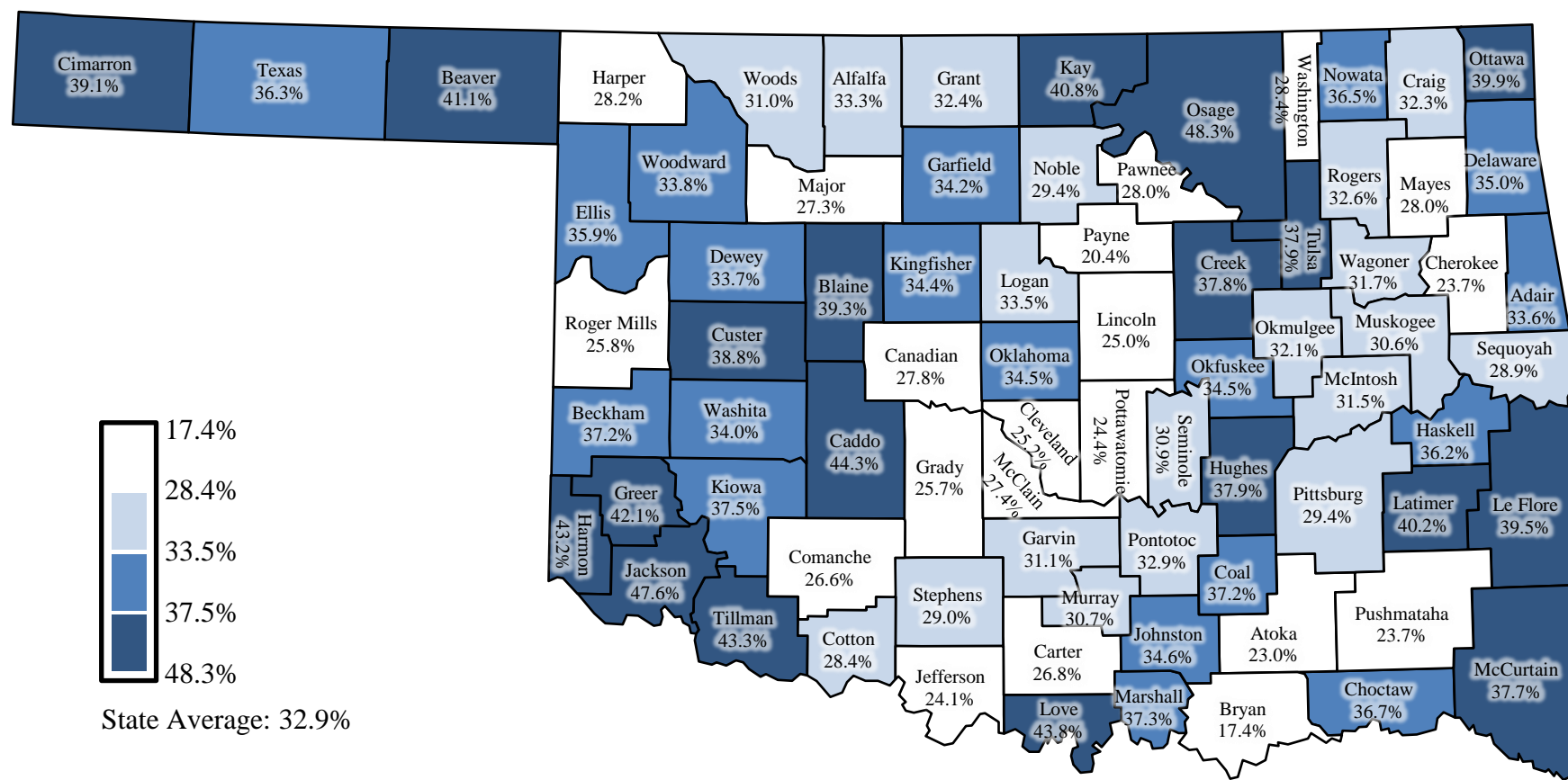

2017-2019 School Years

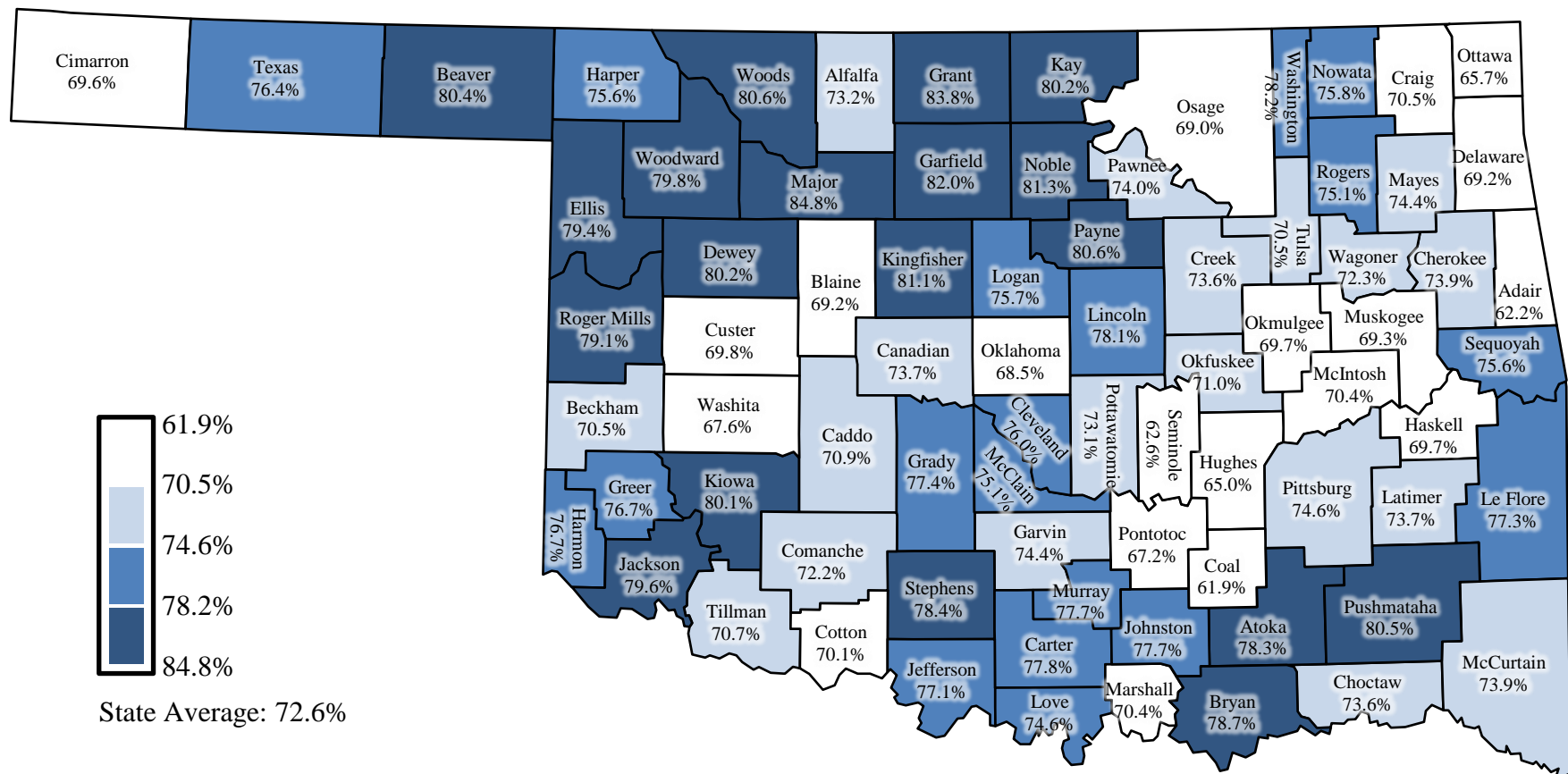

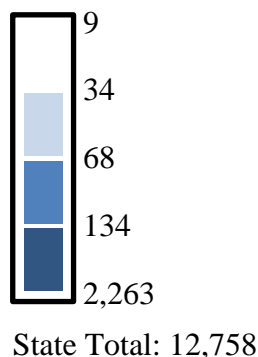
% College Freshman with GPA 2.0 or Above

2019 - 2020 College Year



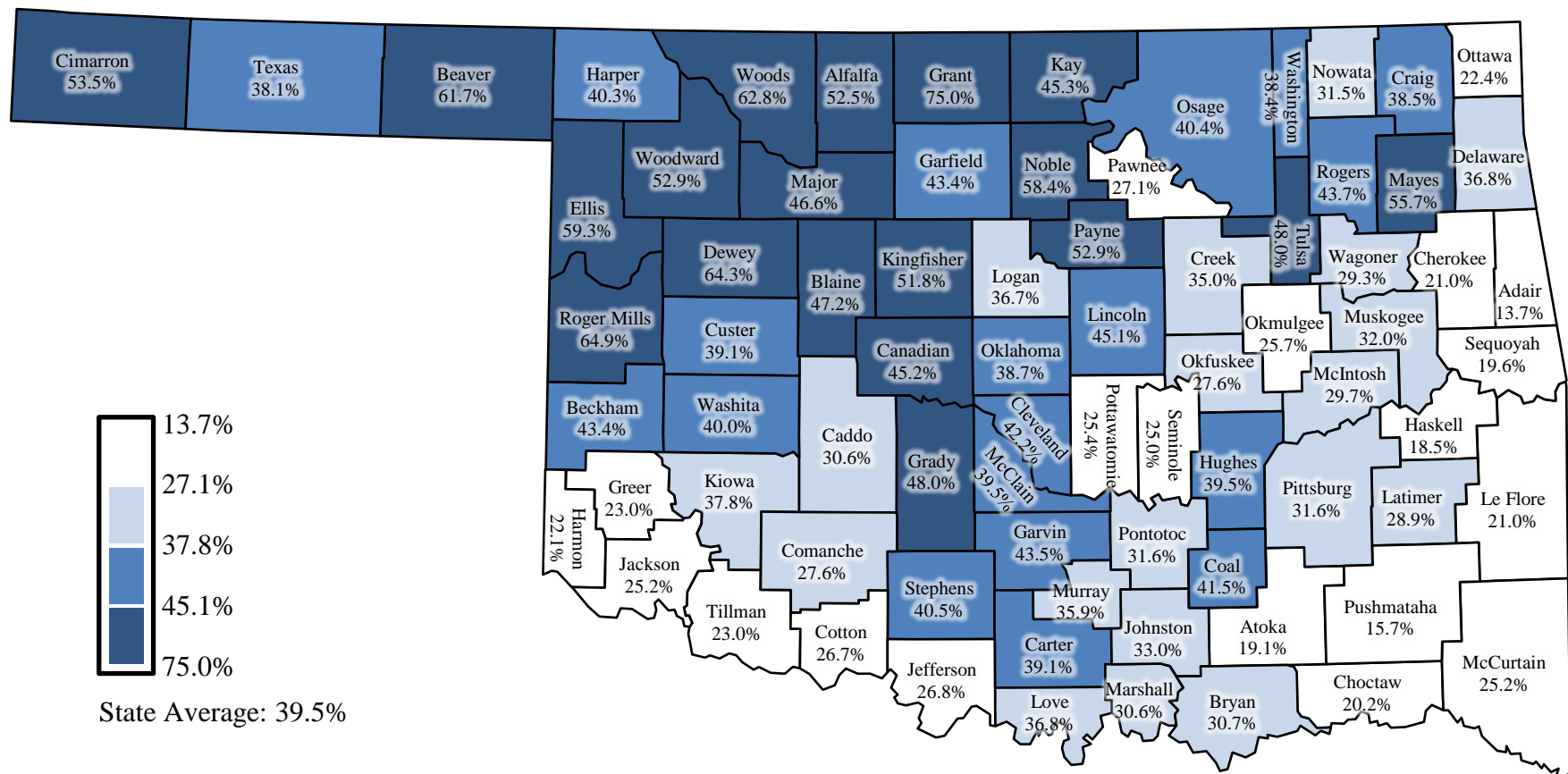

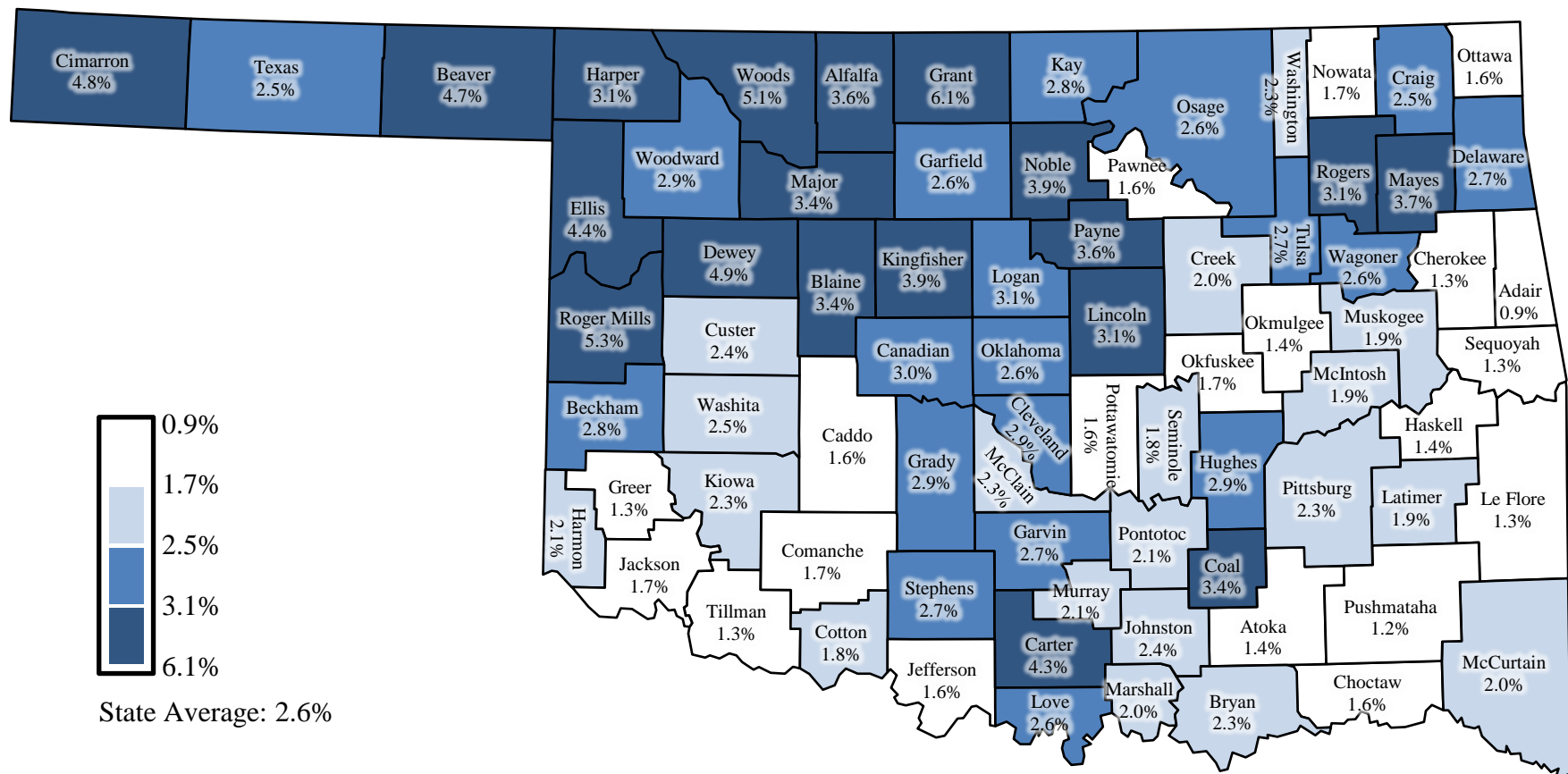

2019 - 2020 School Year



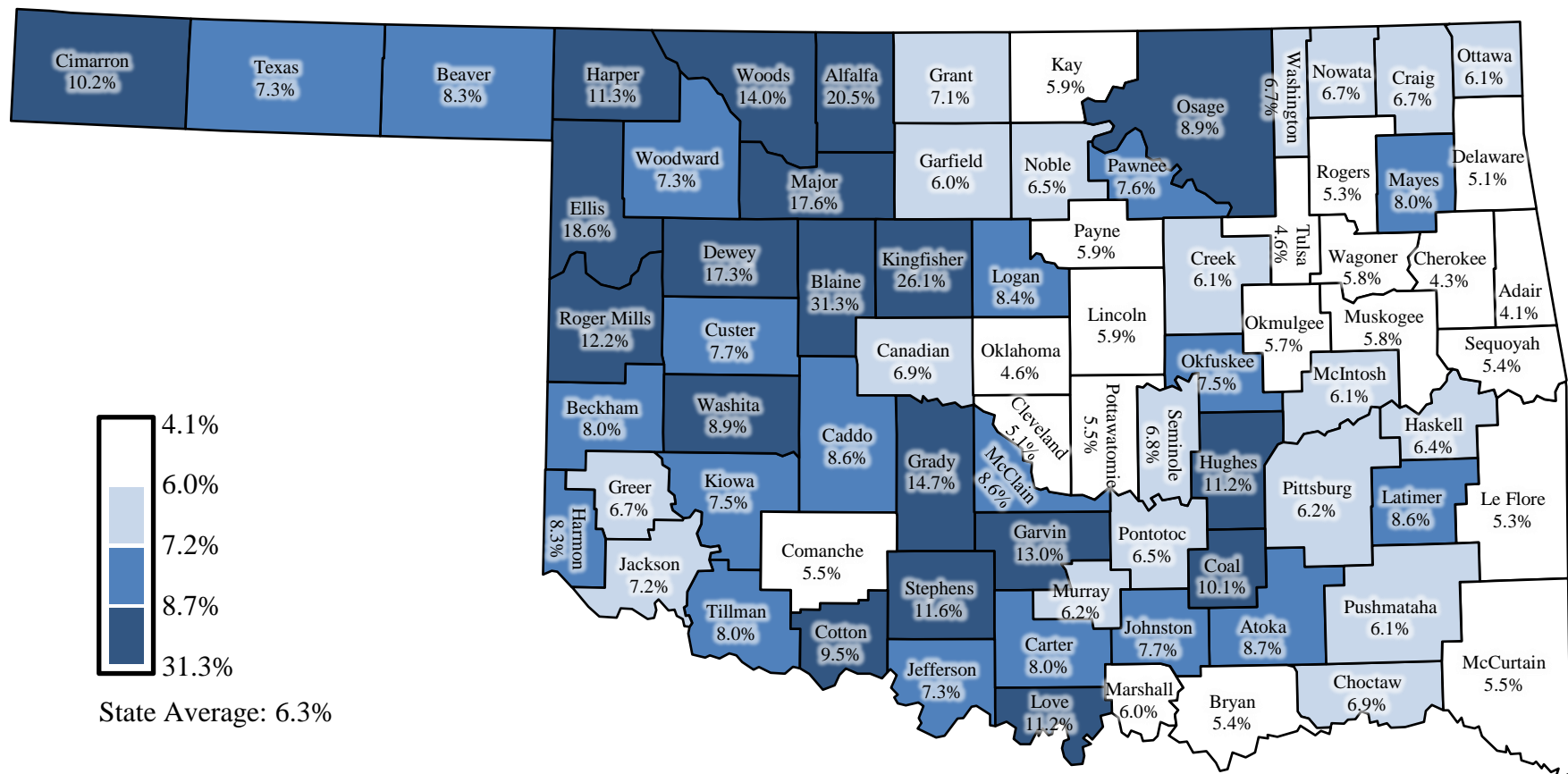

State Dedicated

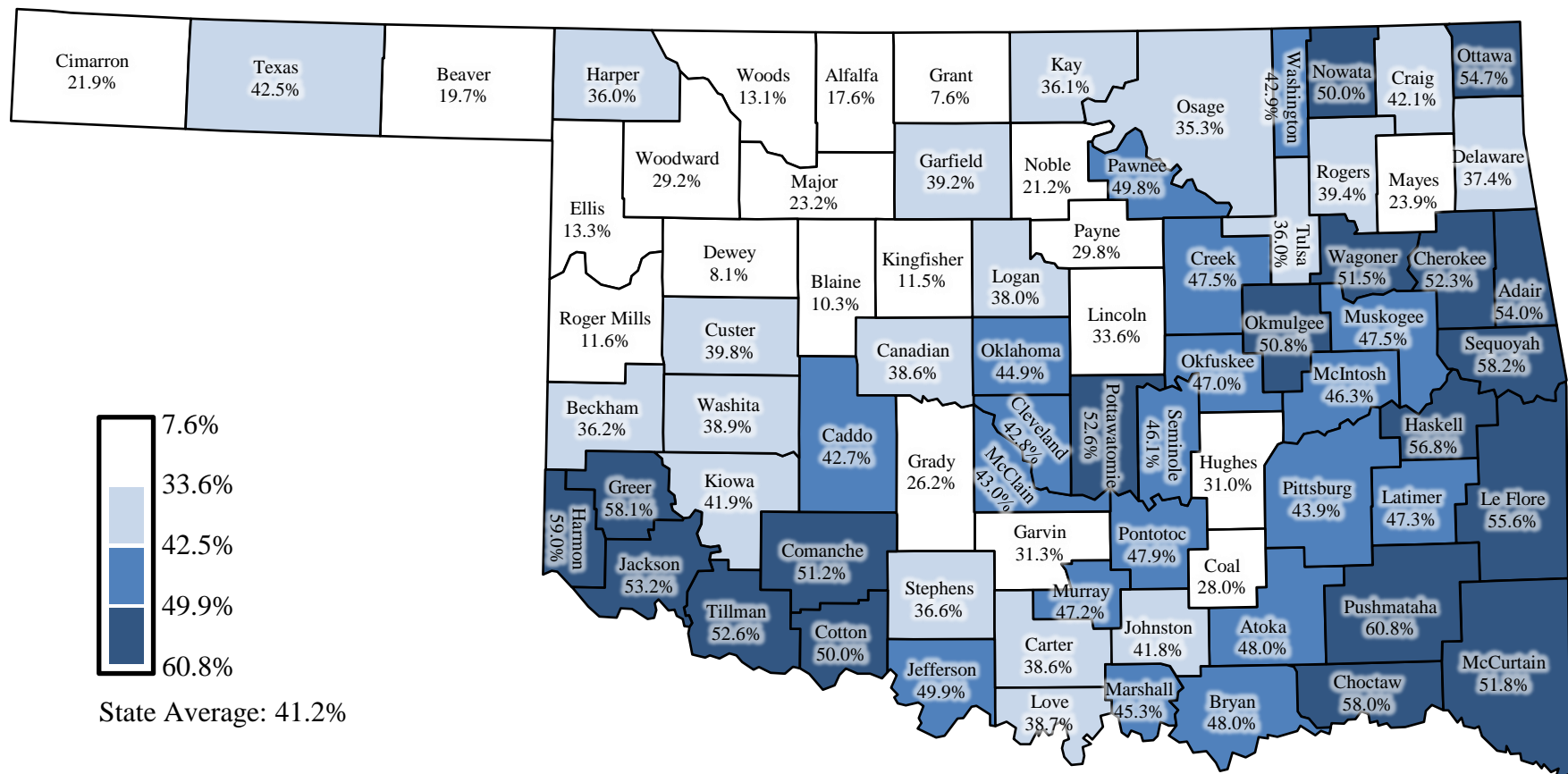

% District Revenue by Source State Appropriated 2019 - 2020 School Year



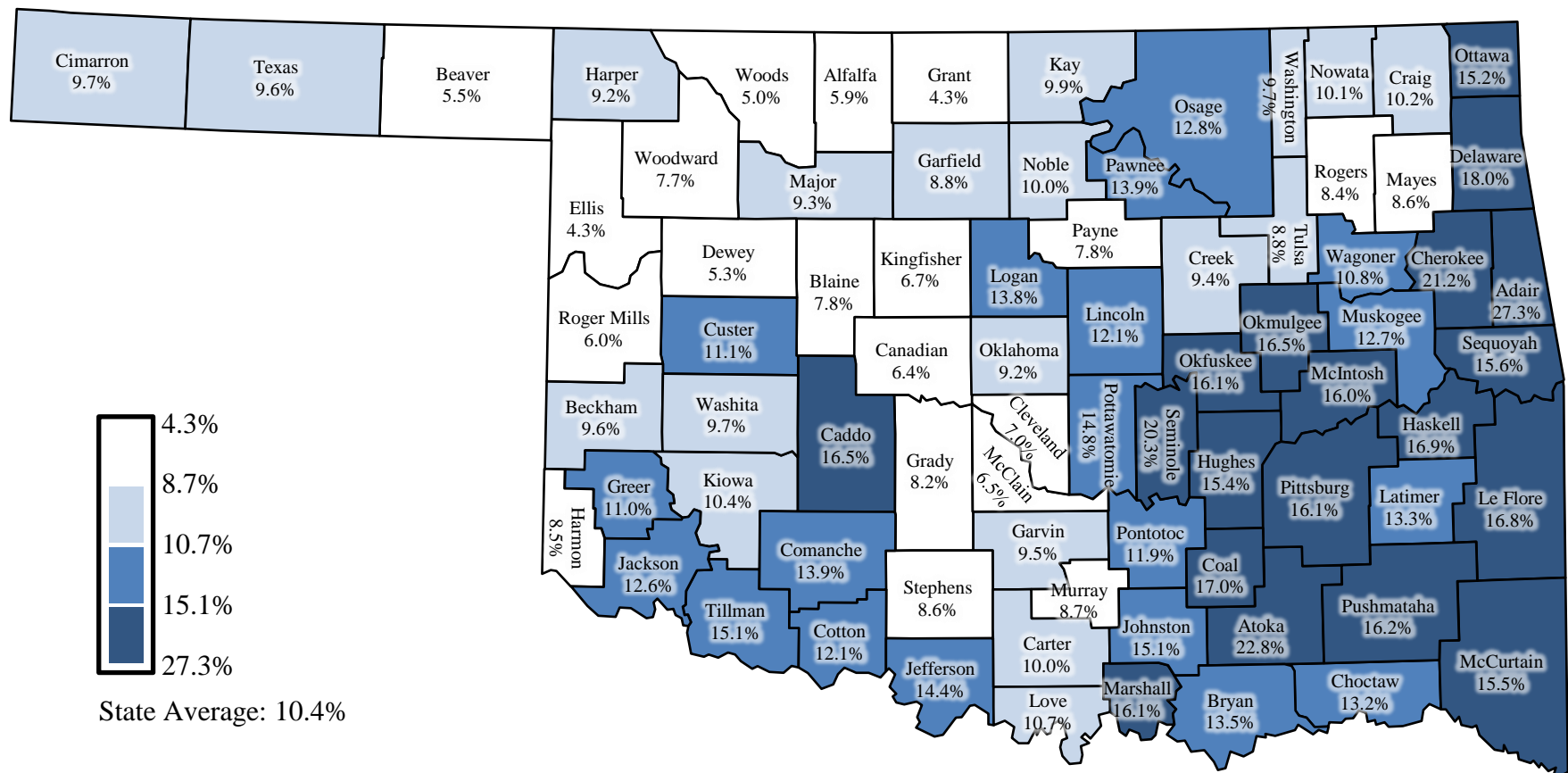

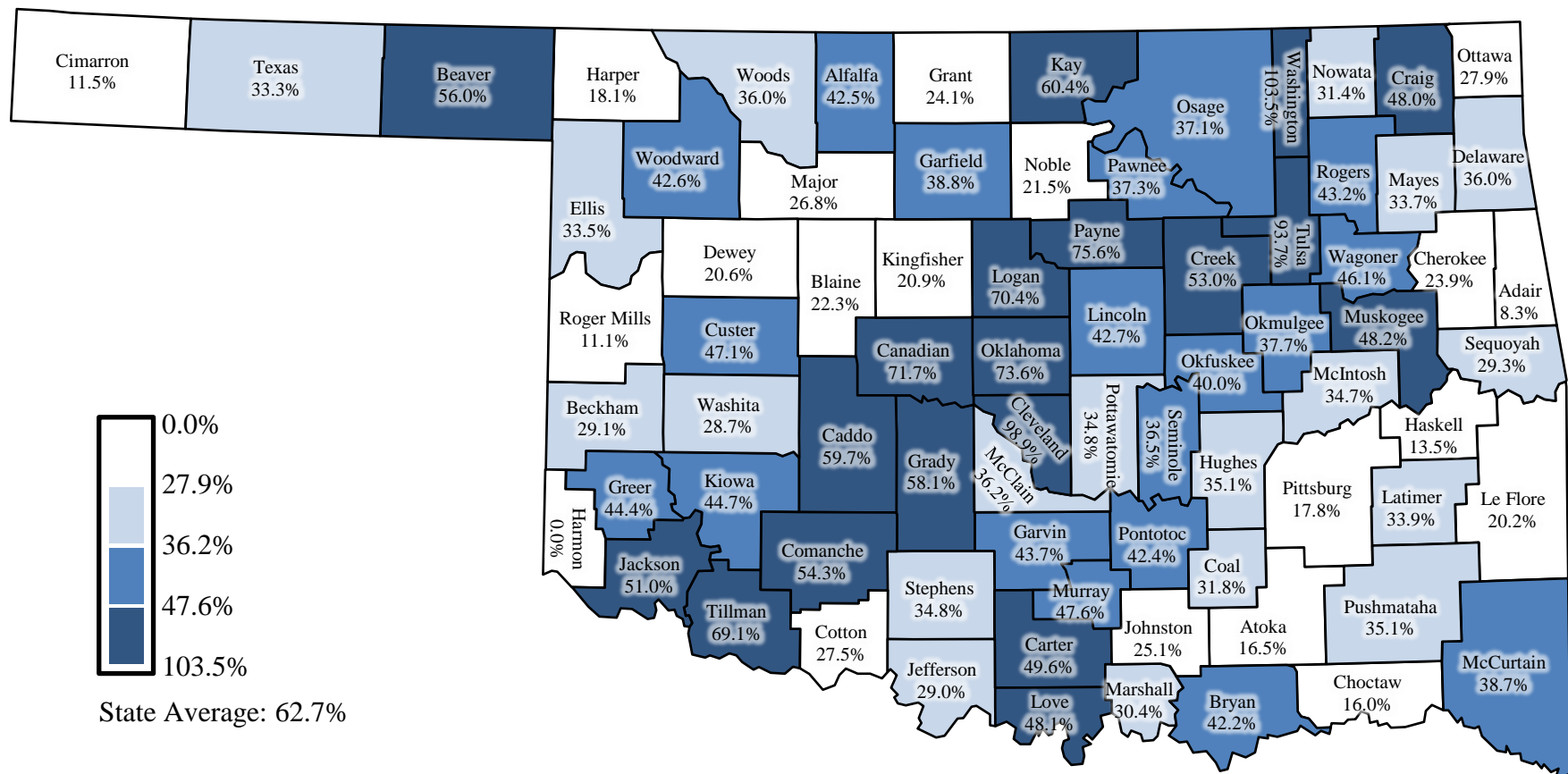

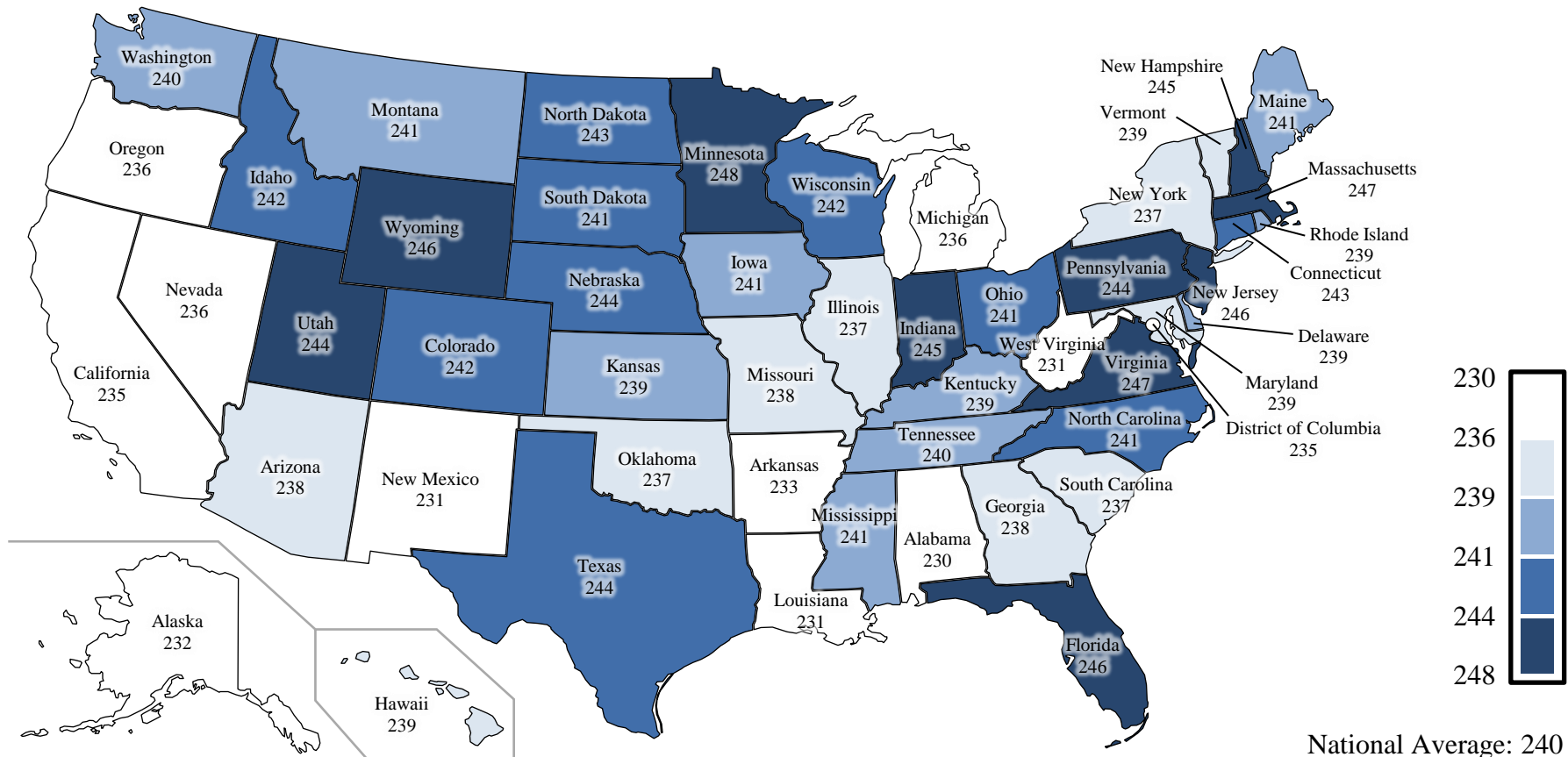

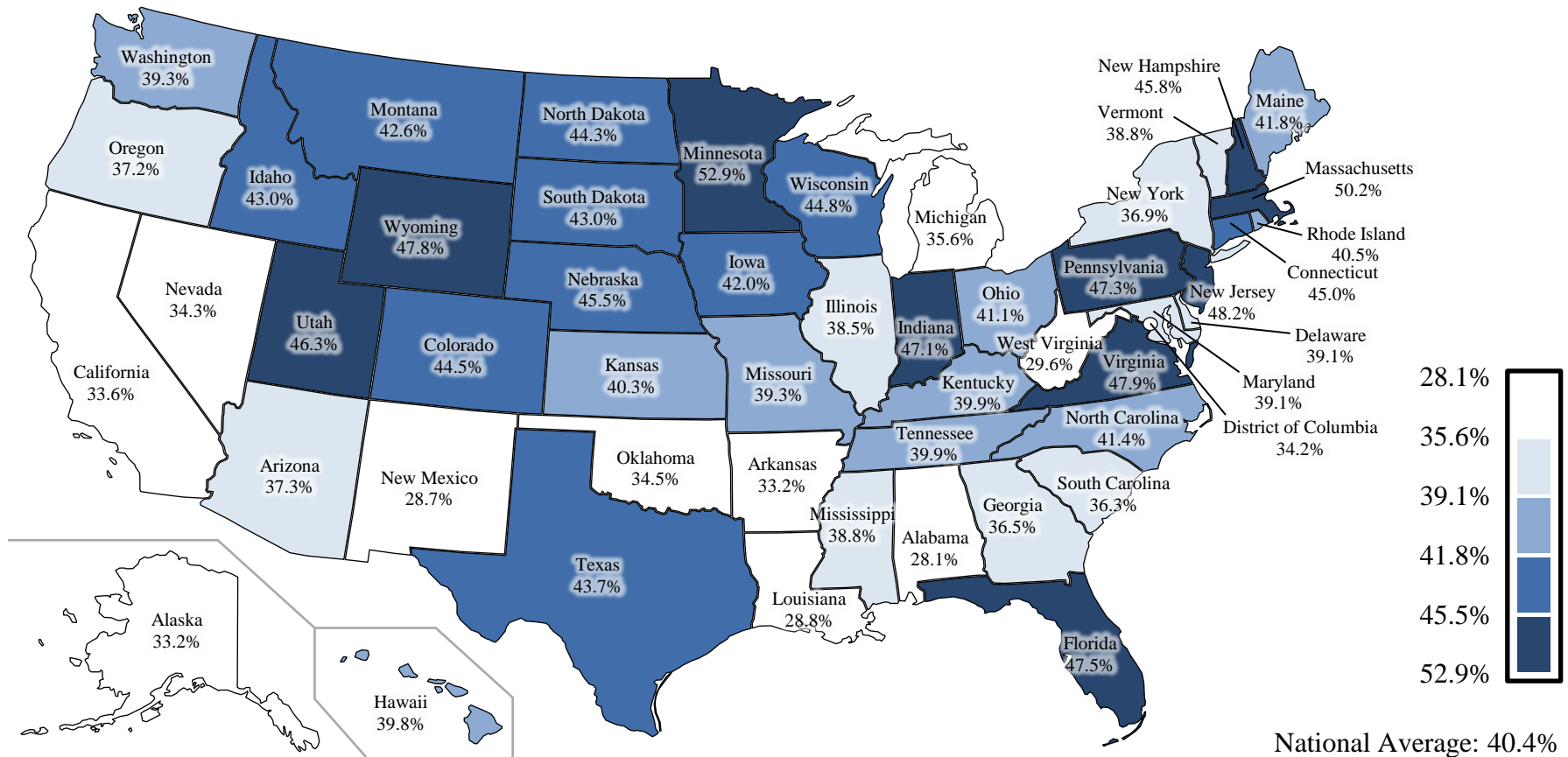

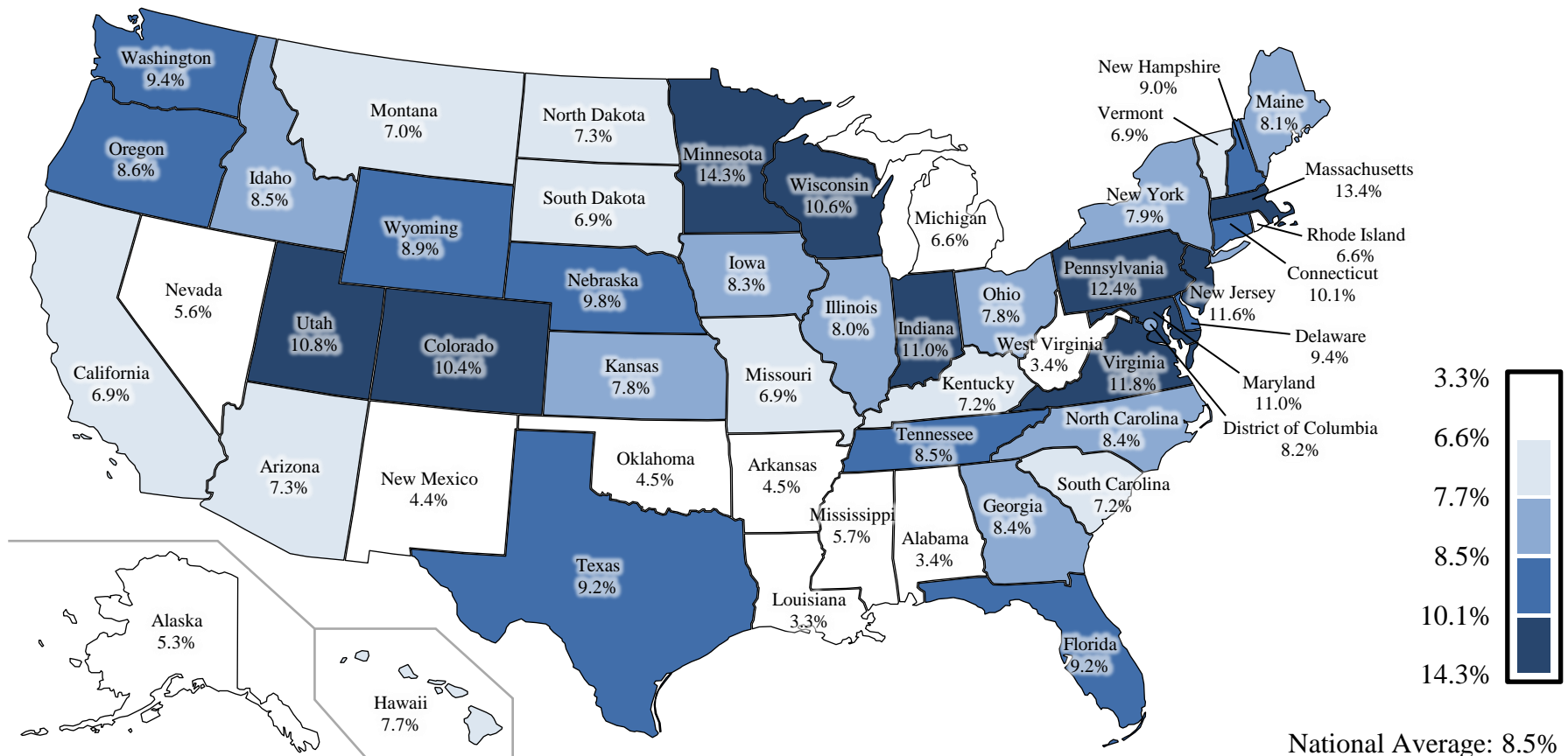

% Students at Advanced Public School Sample



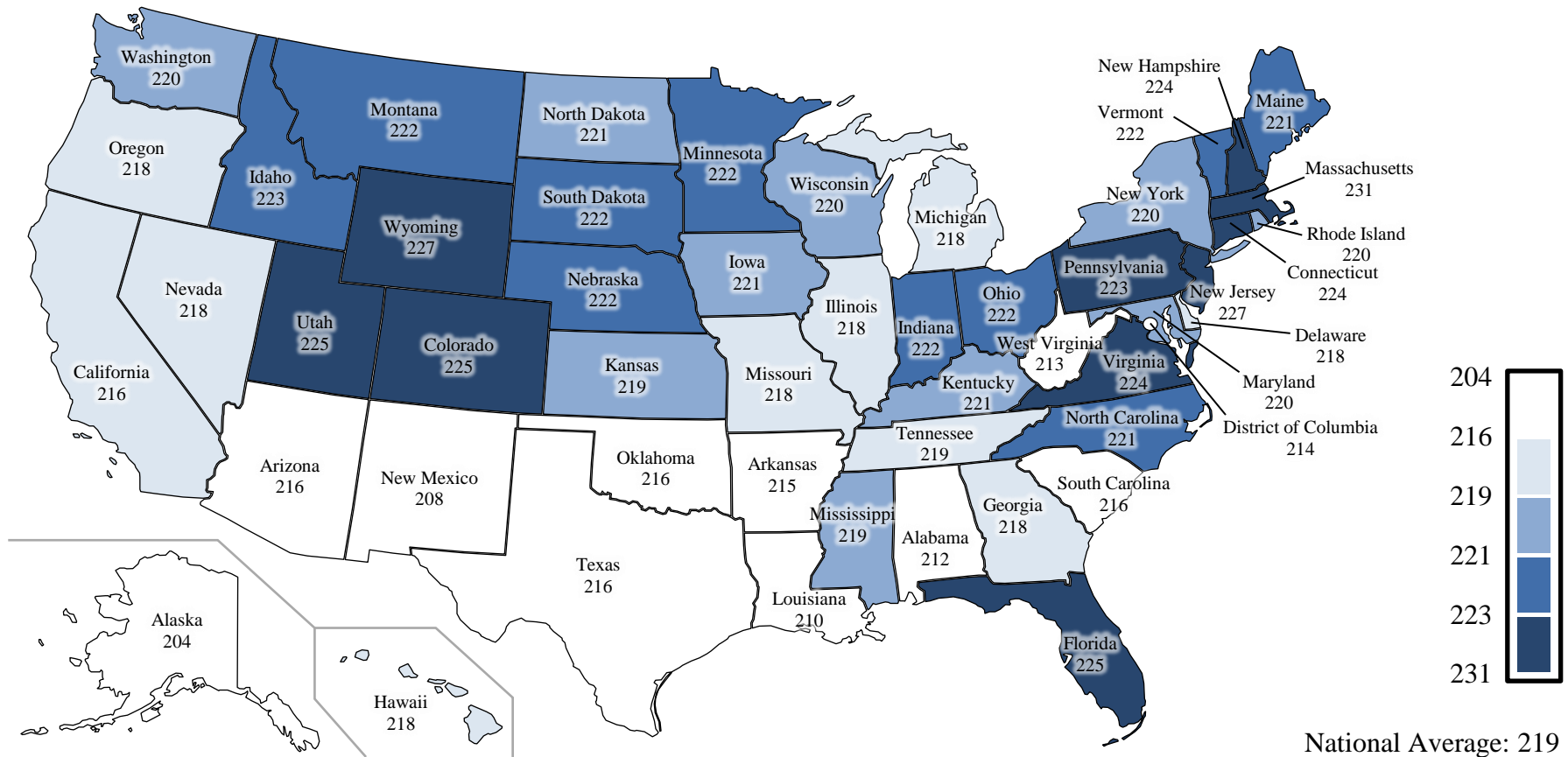

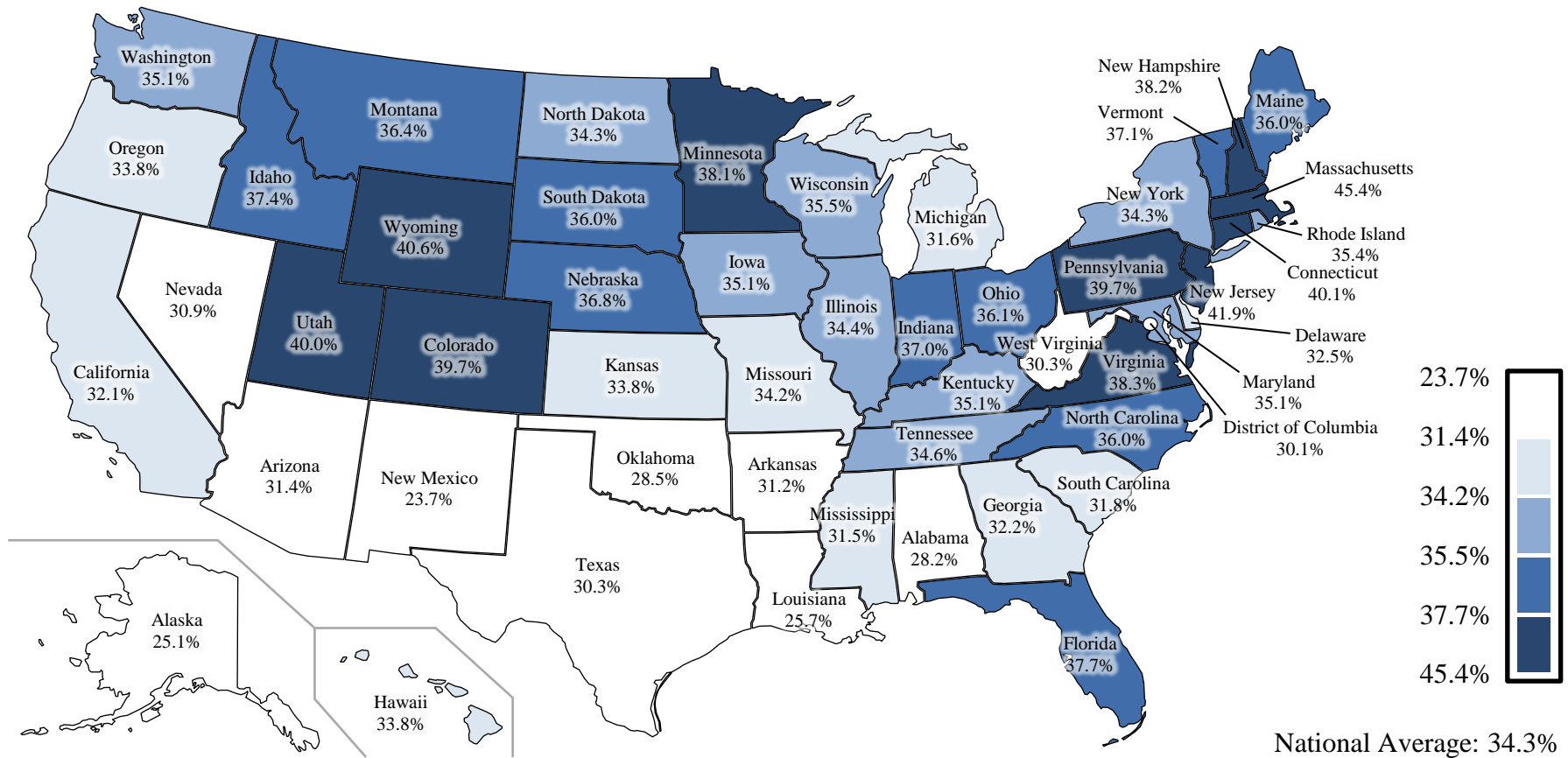

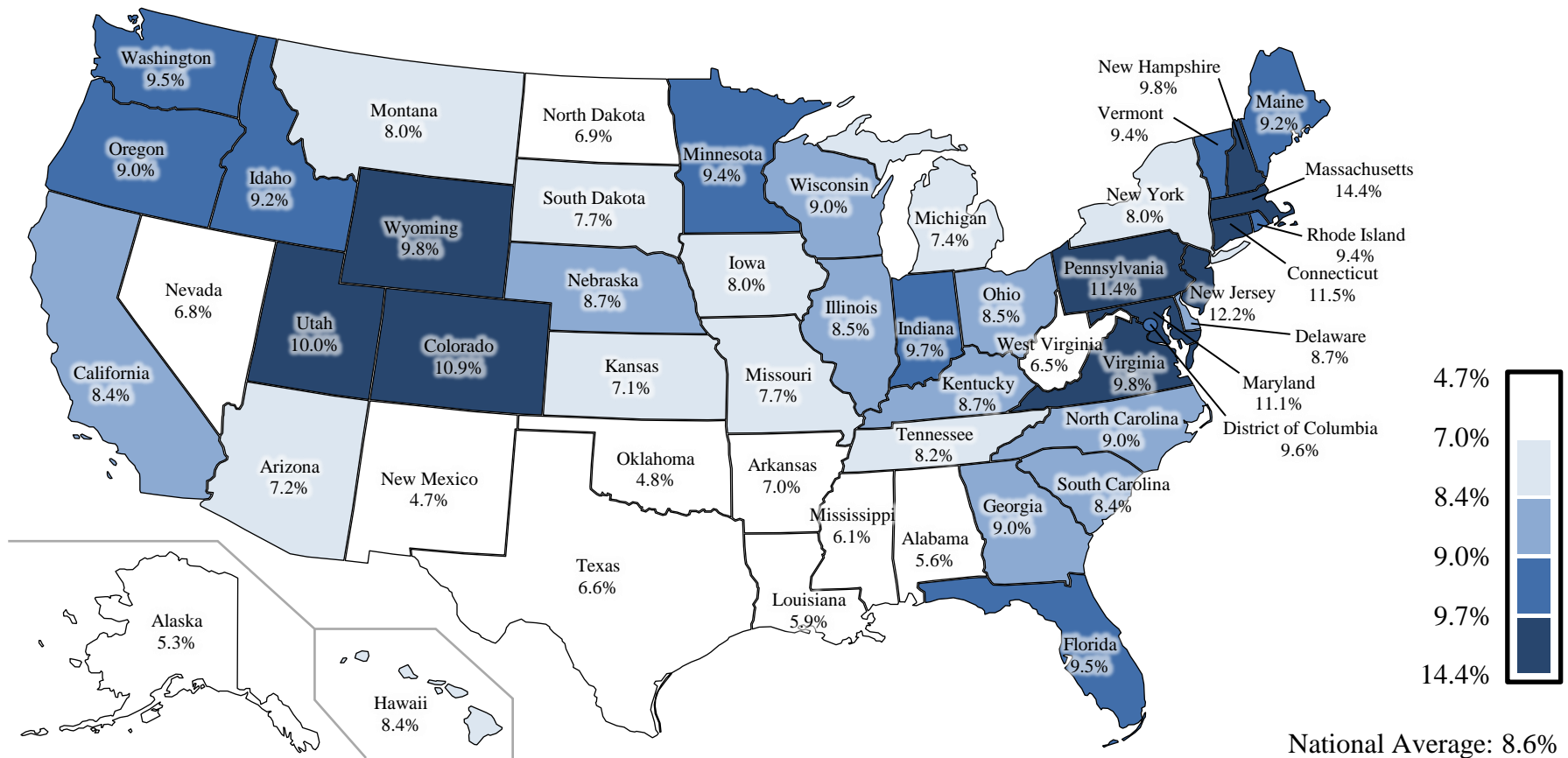

% Students at Advanced Public School Sample



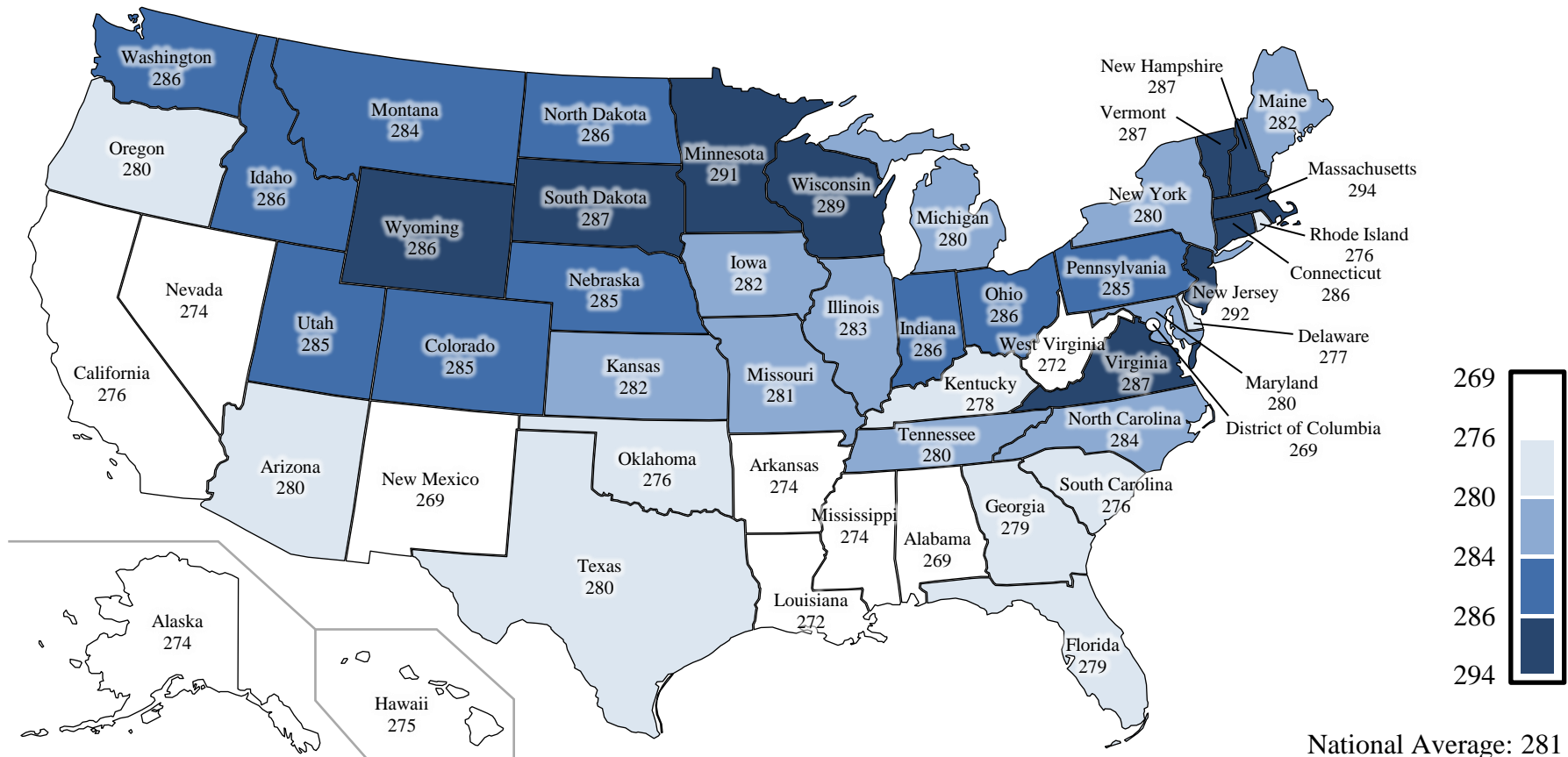

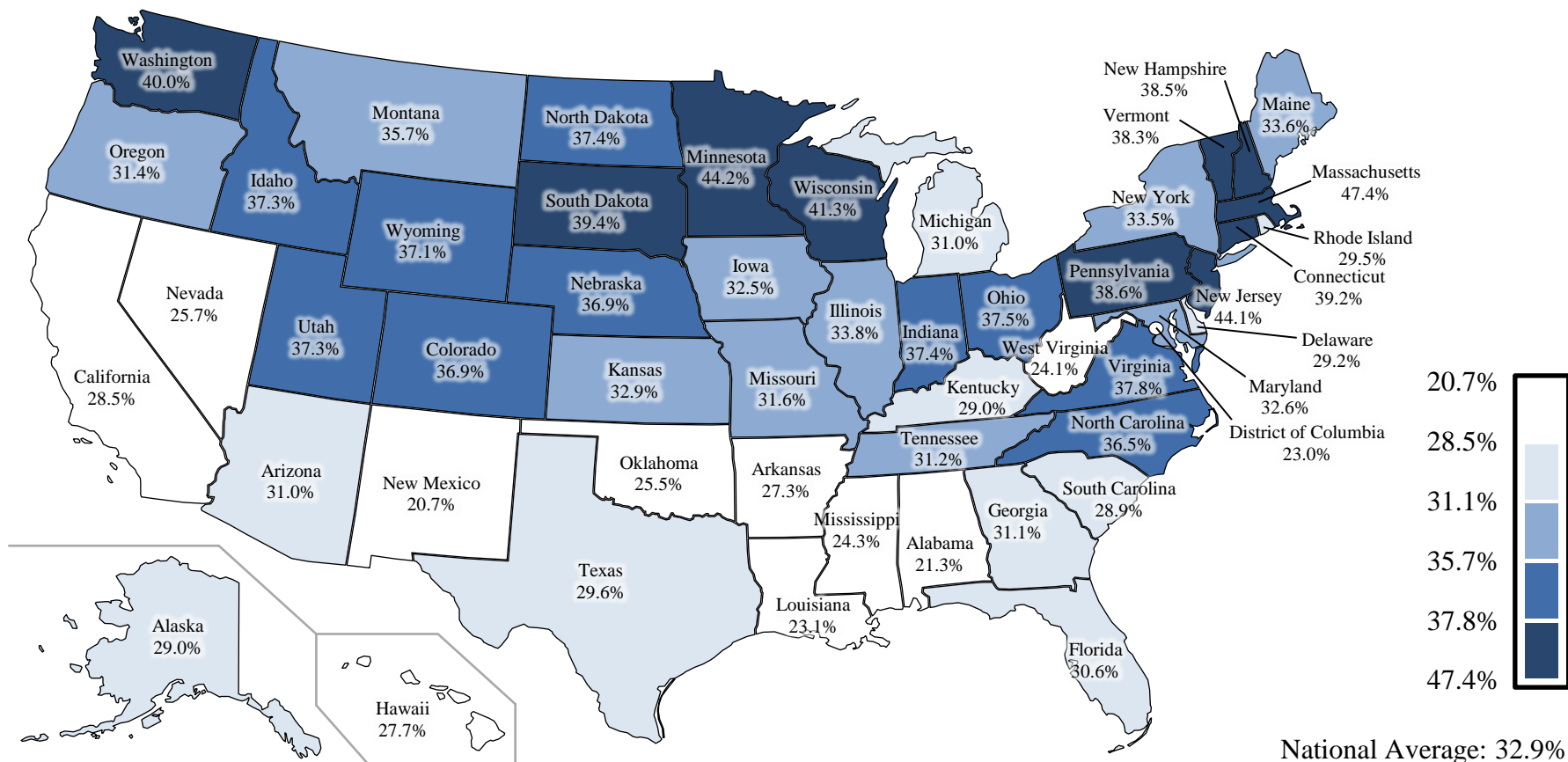

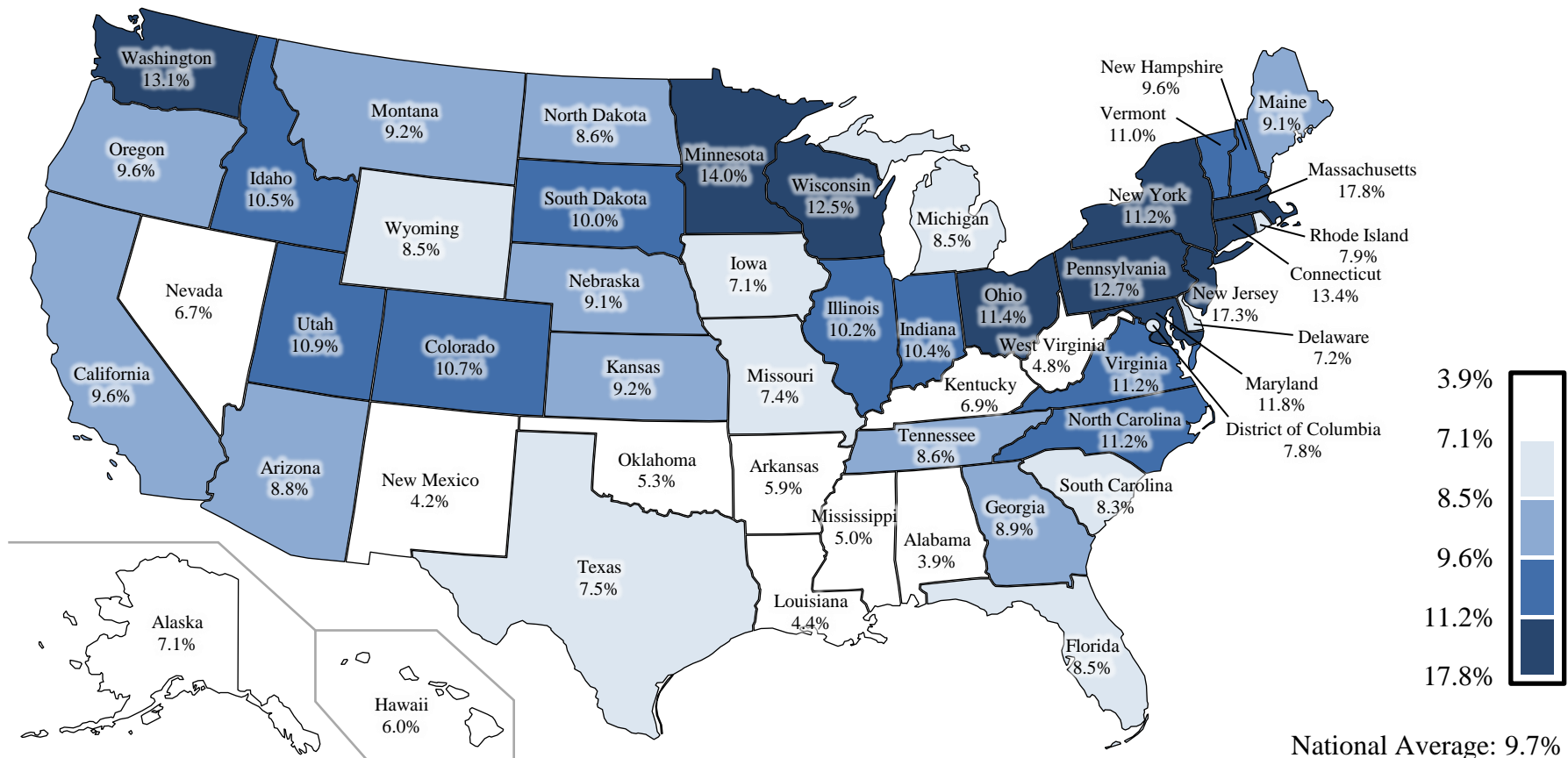

% Students at Advanced Public School Sample



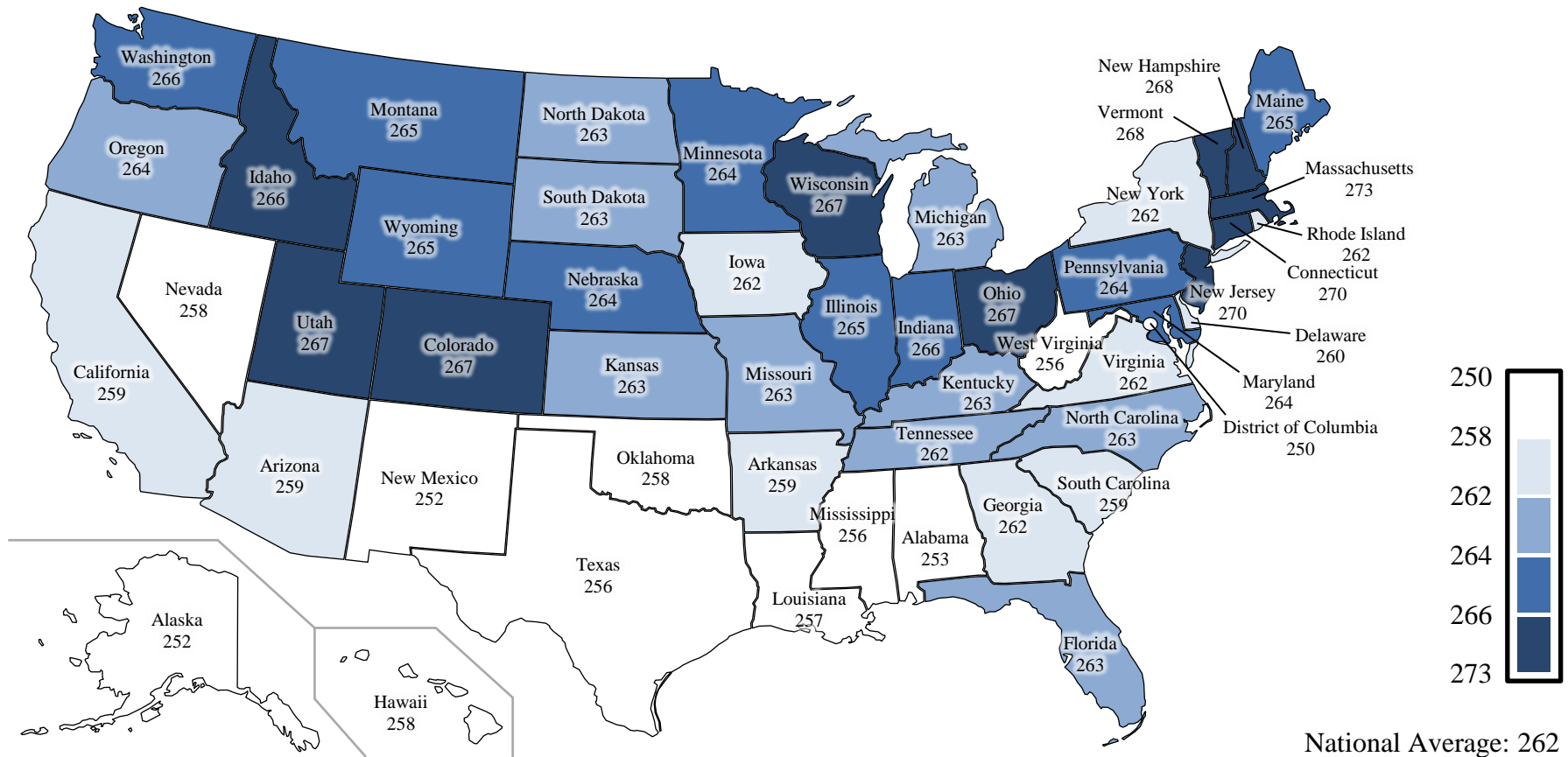

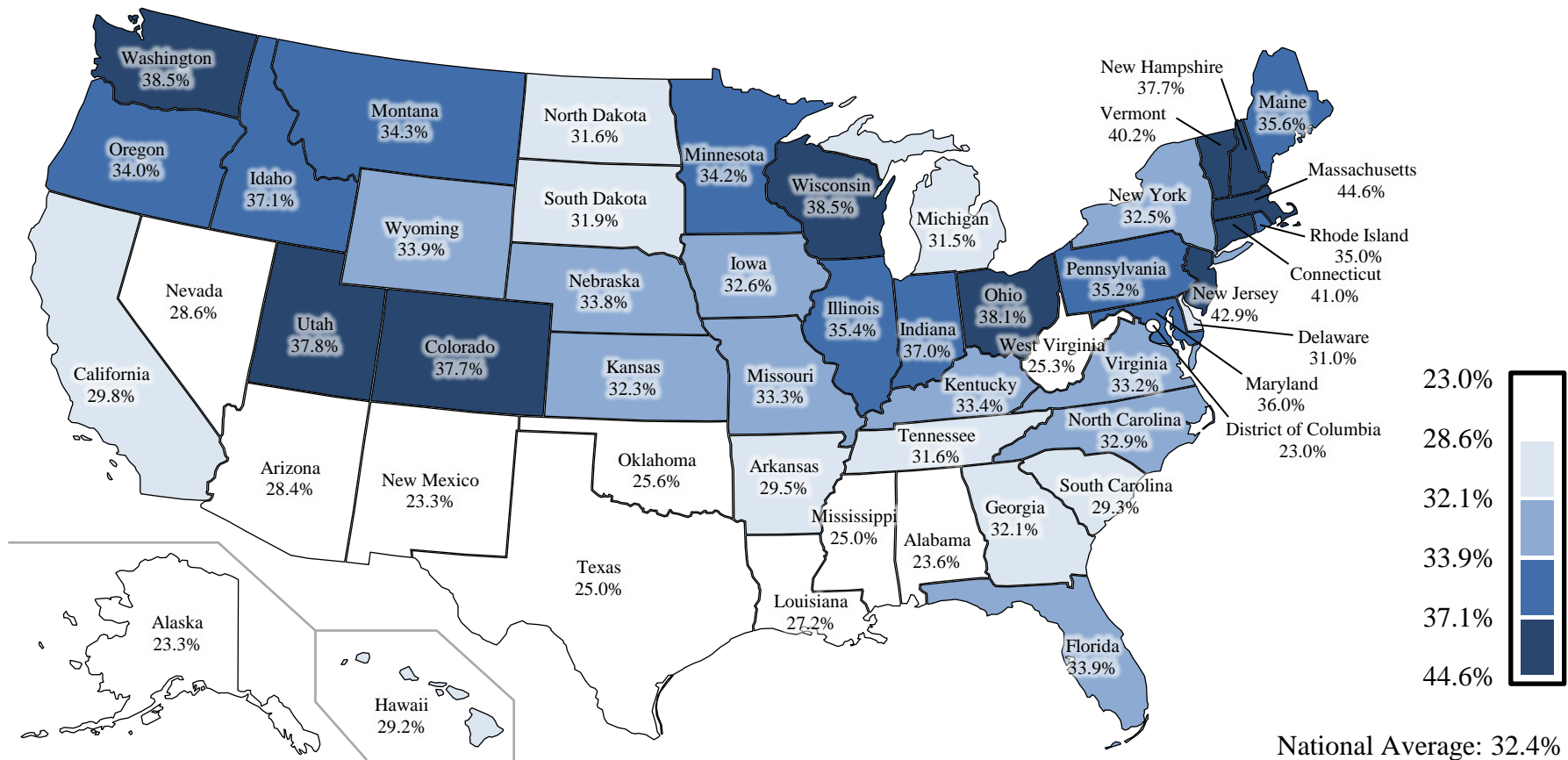

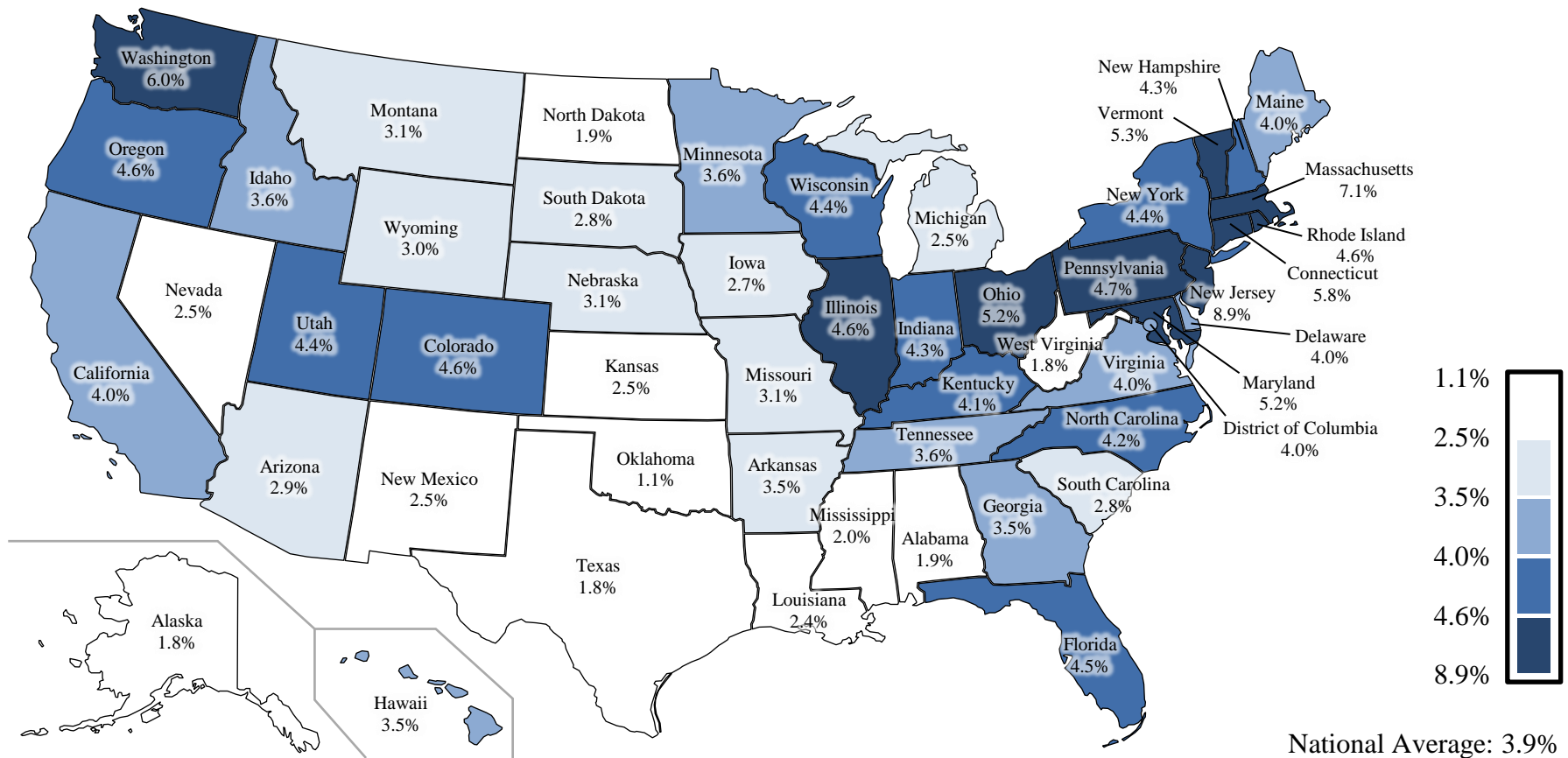

2019 NAEP Results by State - 8th Grade Reading

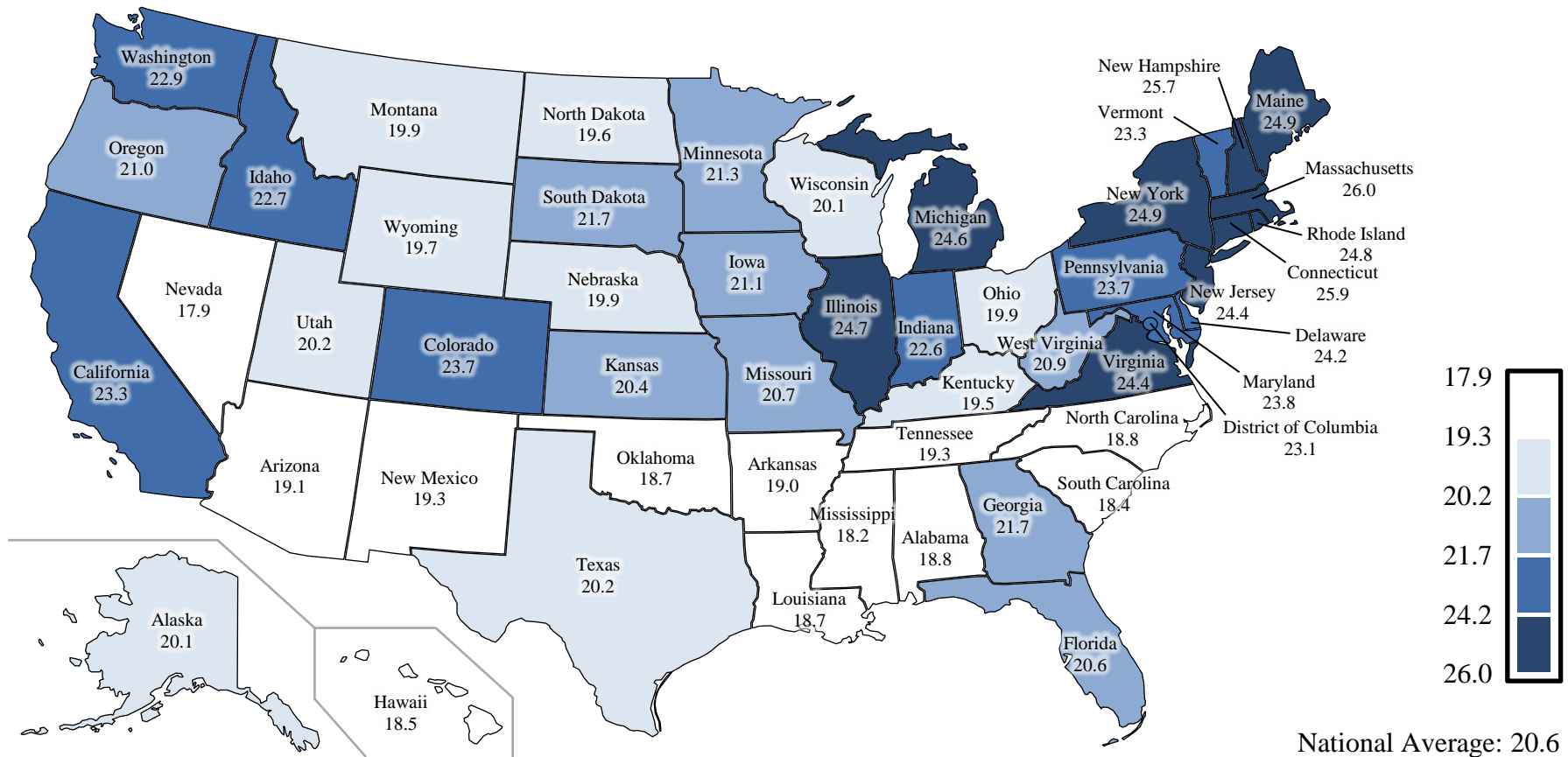
% Students at Advanced Public School Sample

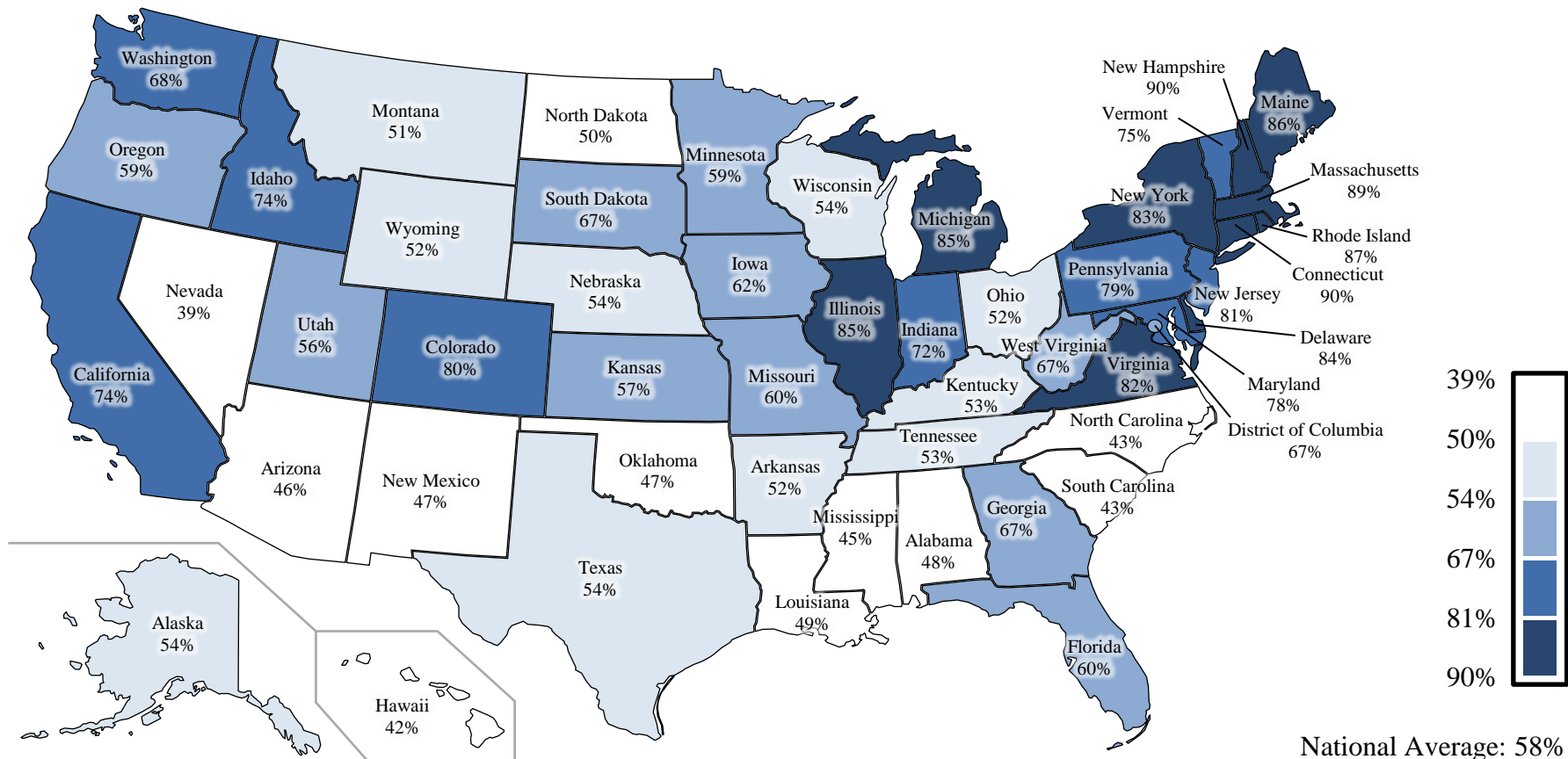
ACT Average Composite Score ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2020

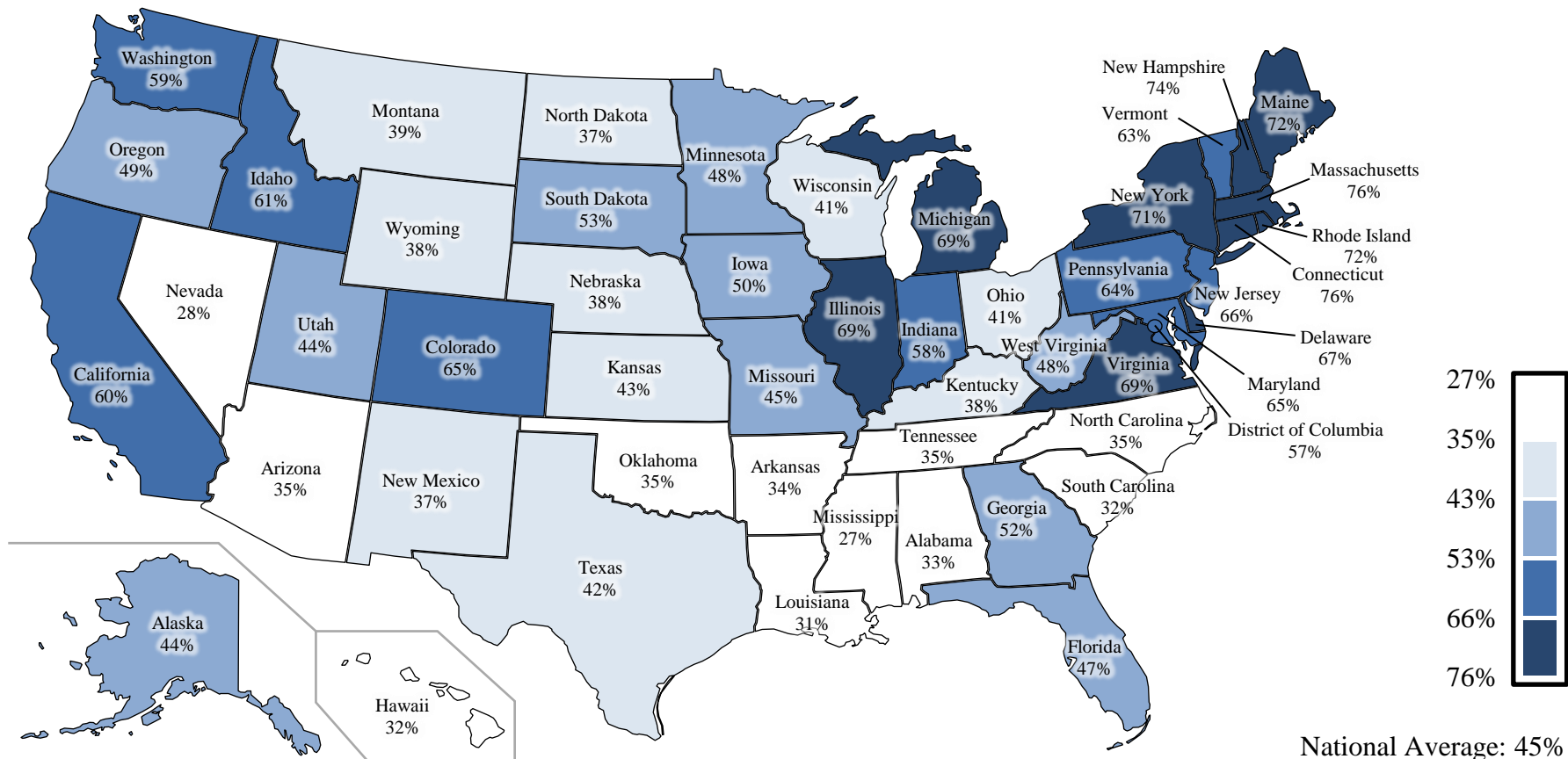
% Meeting ACT College Readiness Benchmark - English ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2020

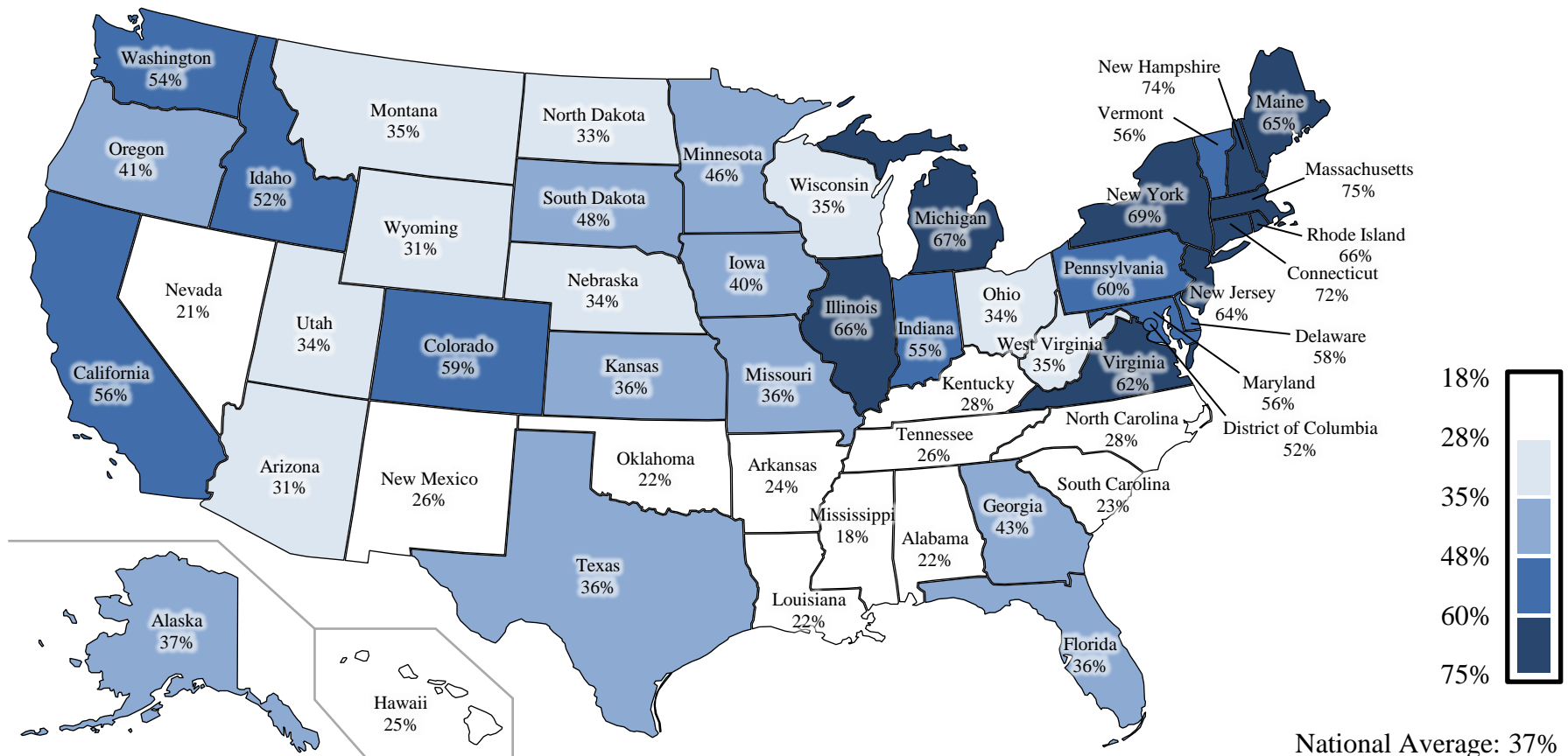
% Meeting ACT College Readiness Benchmark - Reading ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2020

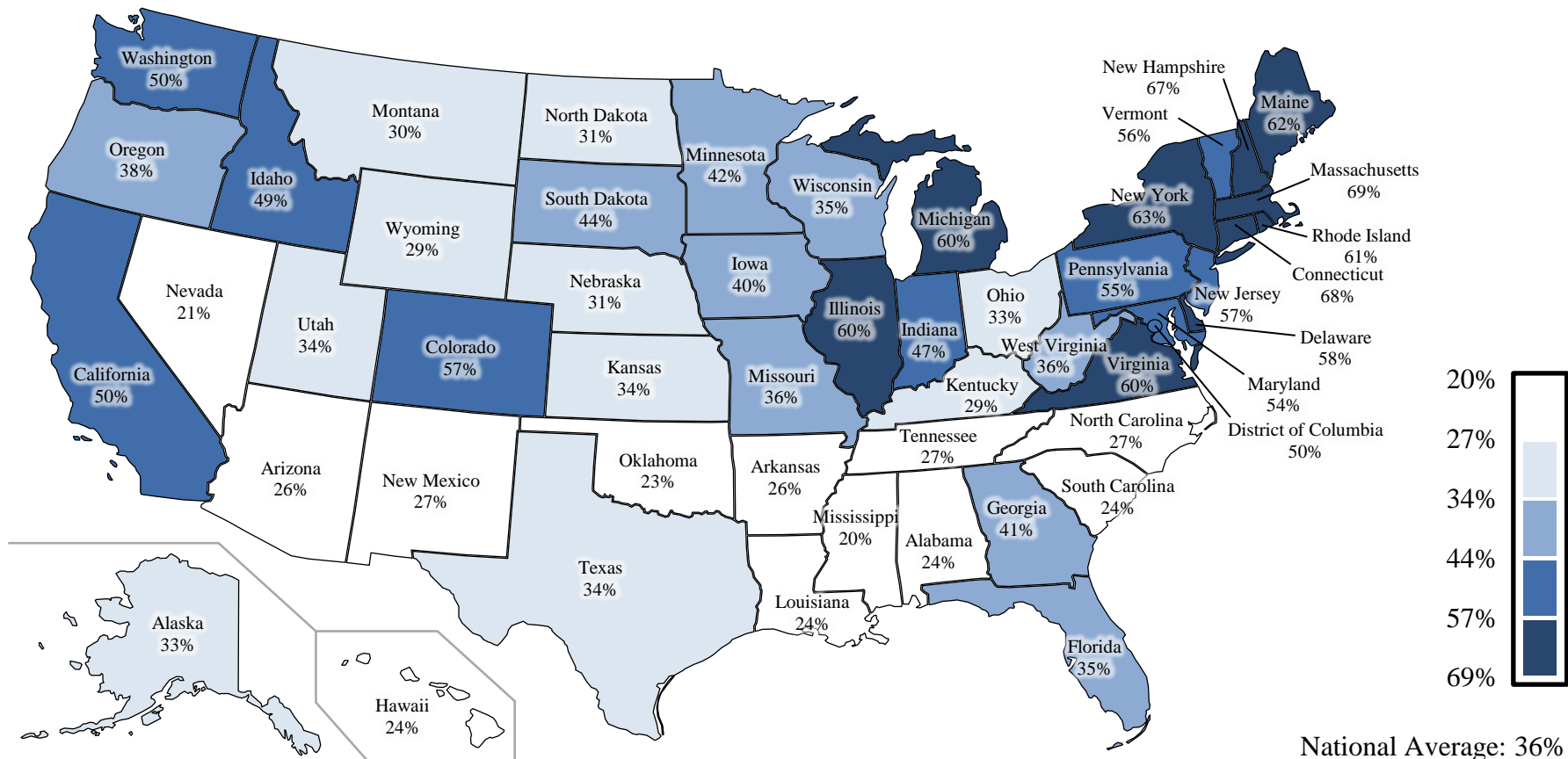
% Meeting ACT College Readiness Benchmark - Math ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2020

% Meeting ACT College Readiness Benchmark - Science ACT-Tested HS Graduates Class of 2020

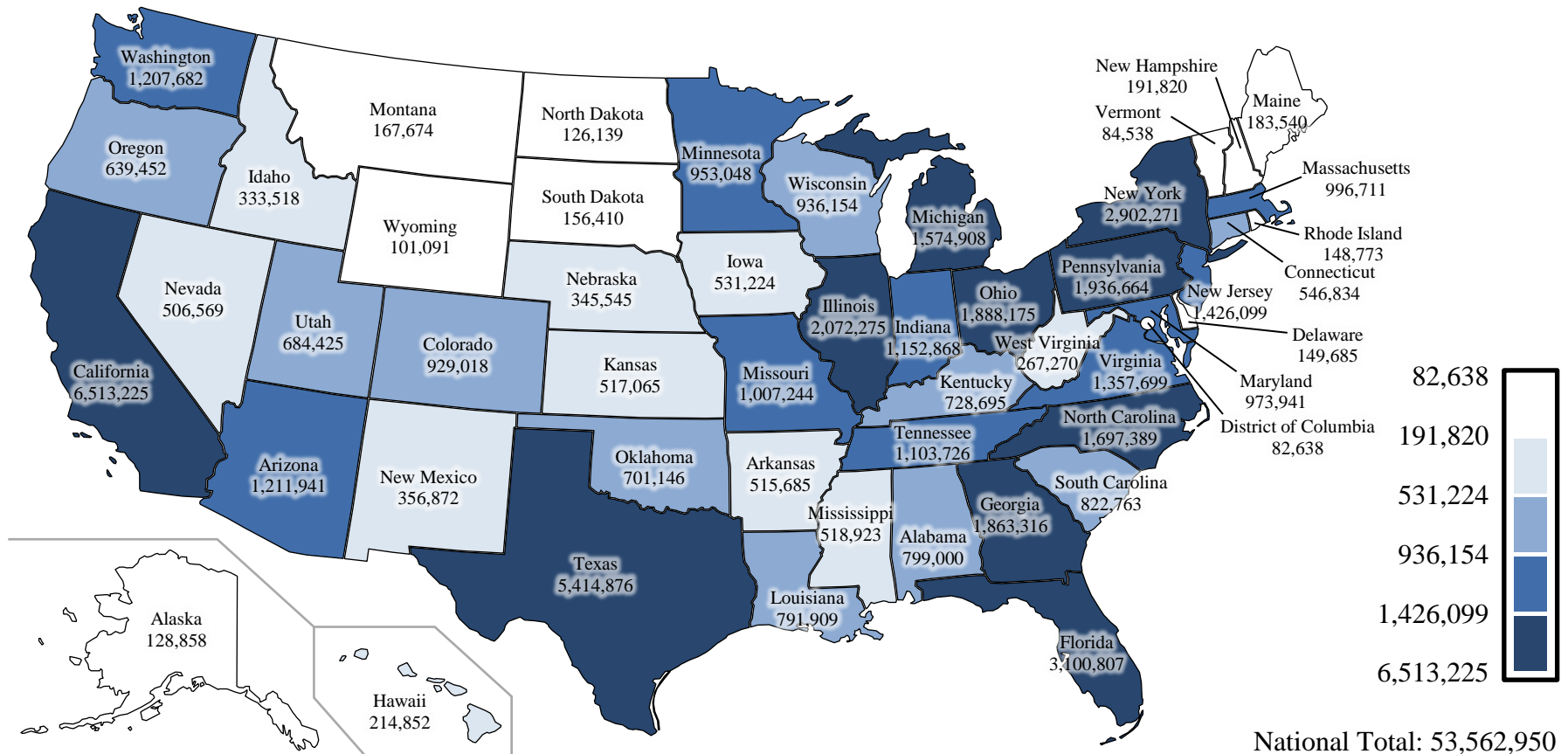

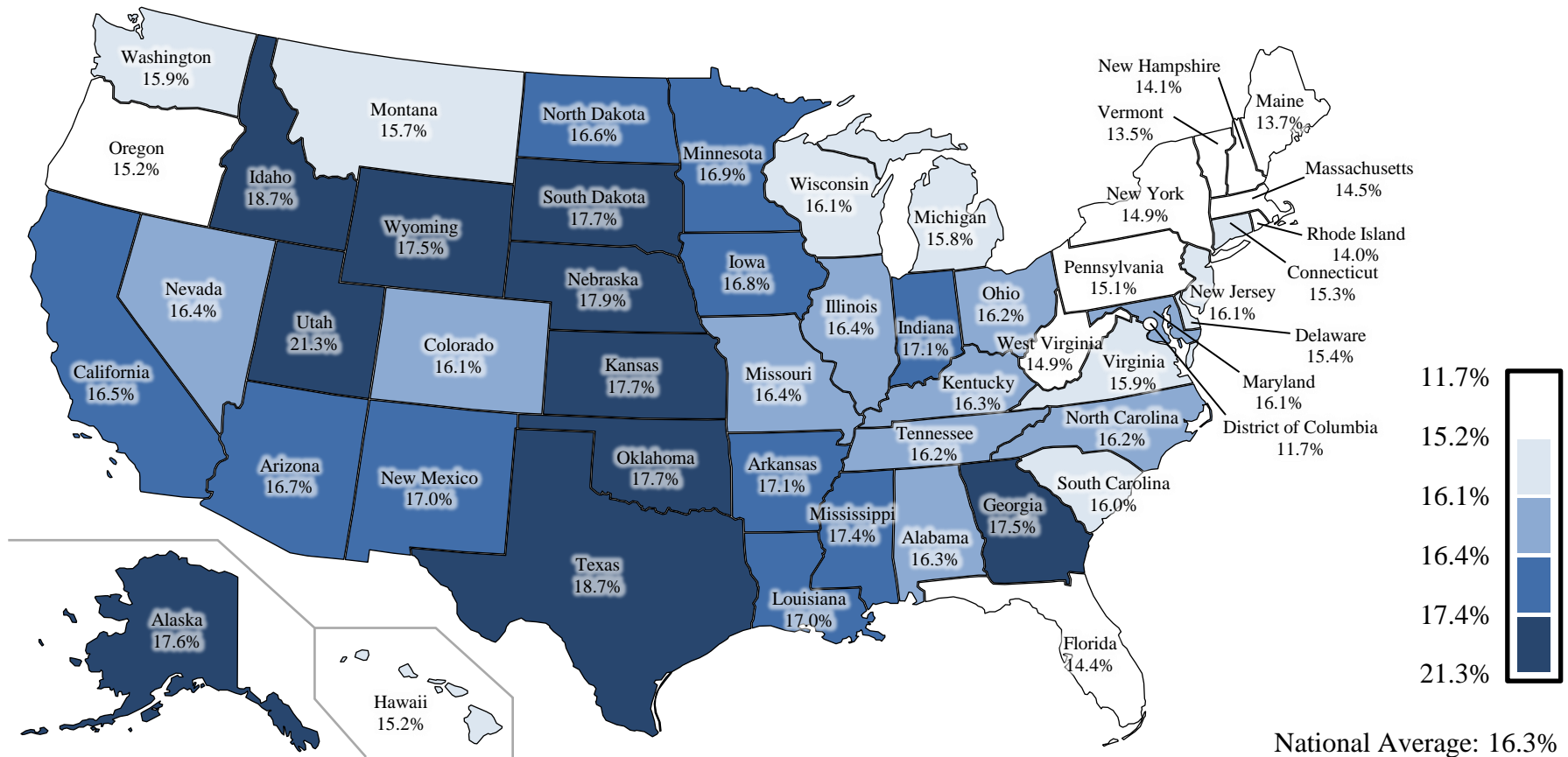

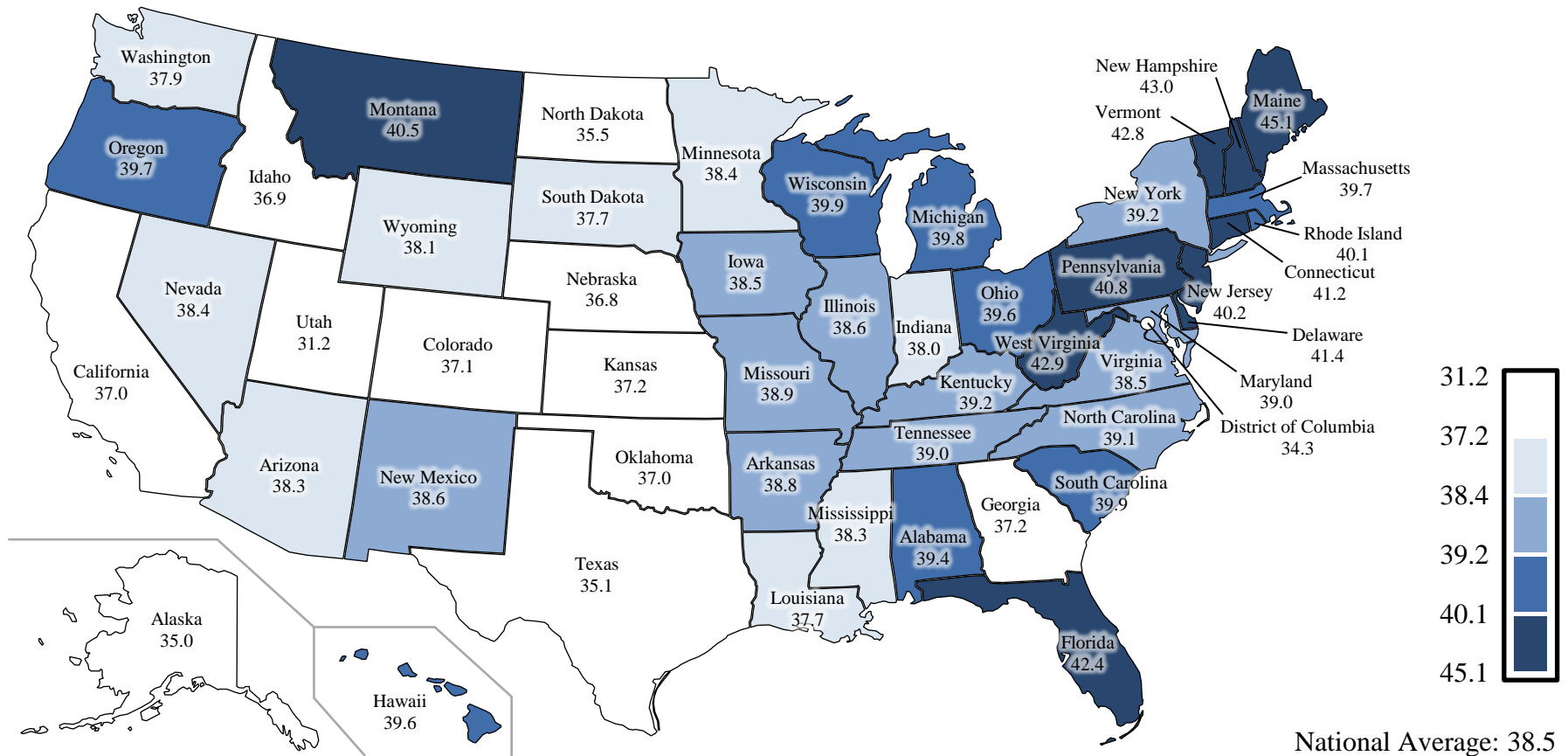

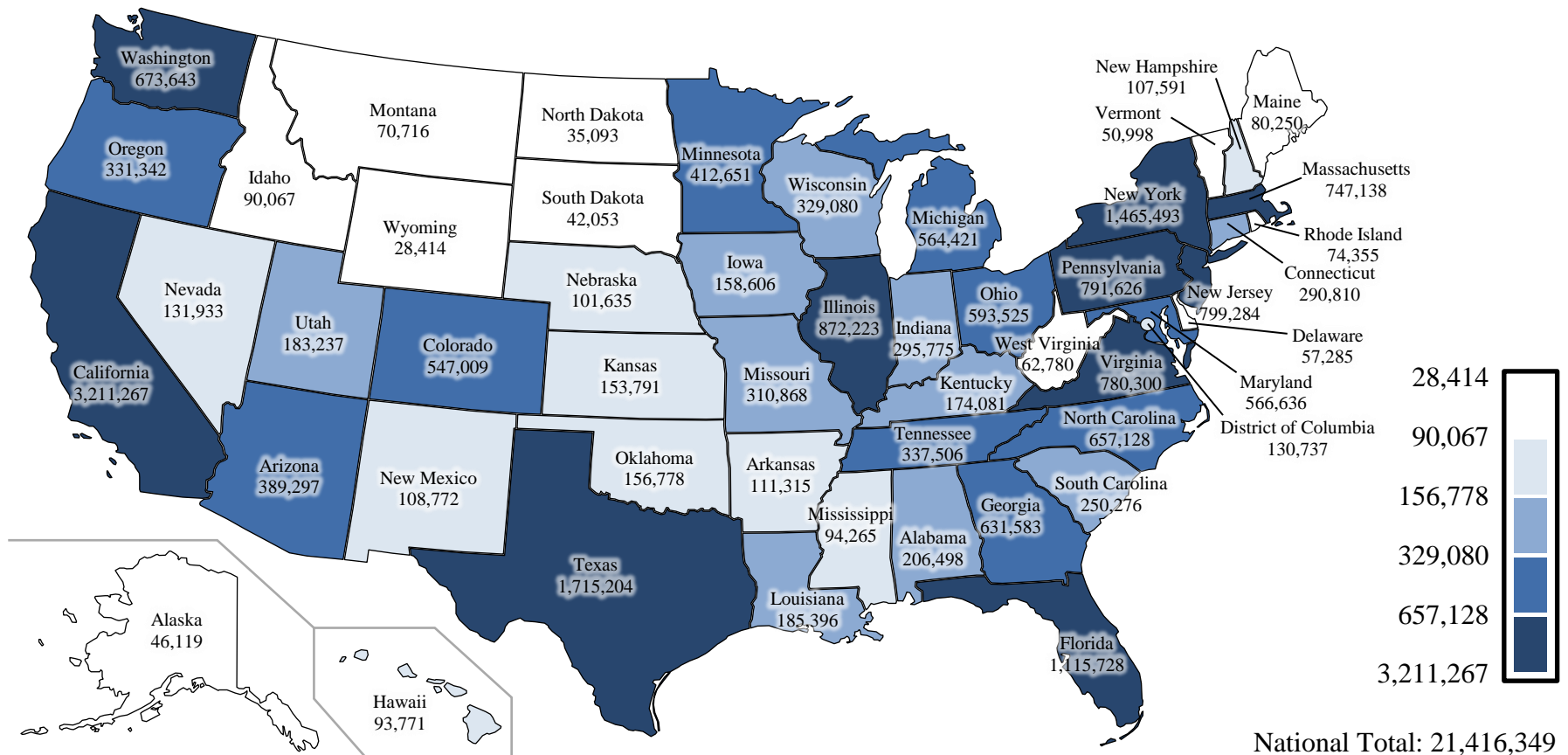

Population with 1st Major in Science & Engineering Age 25-64

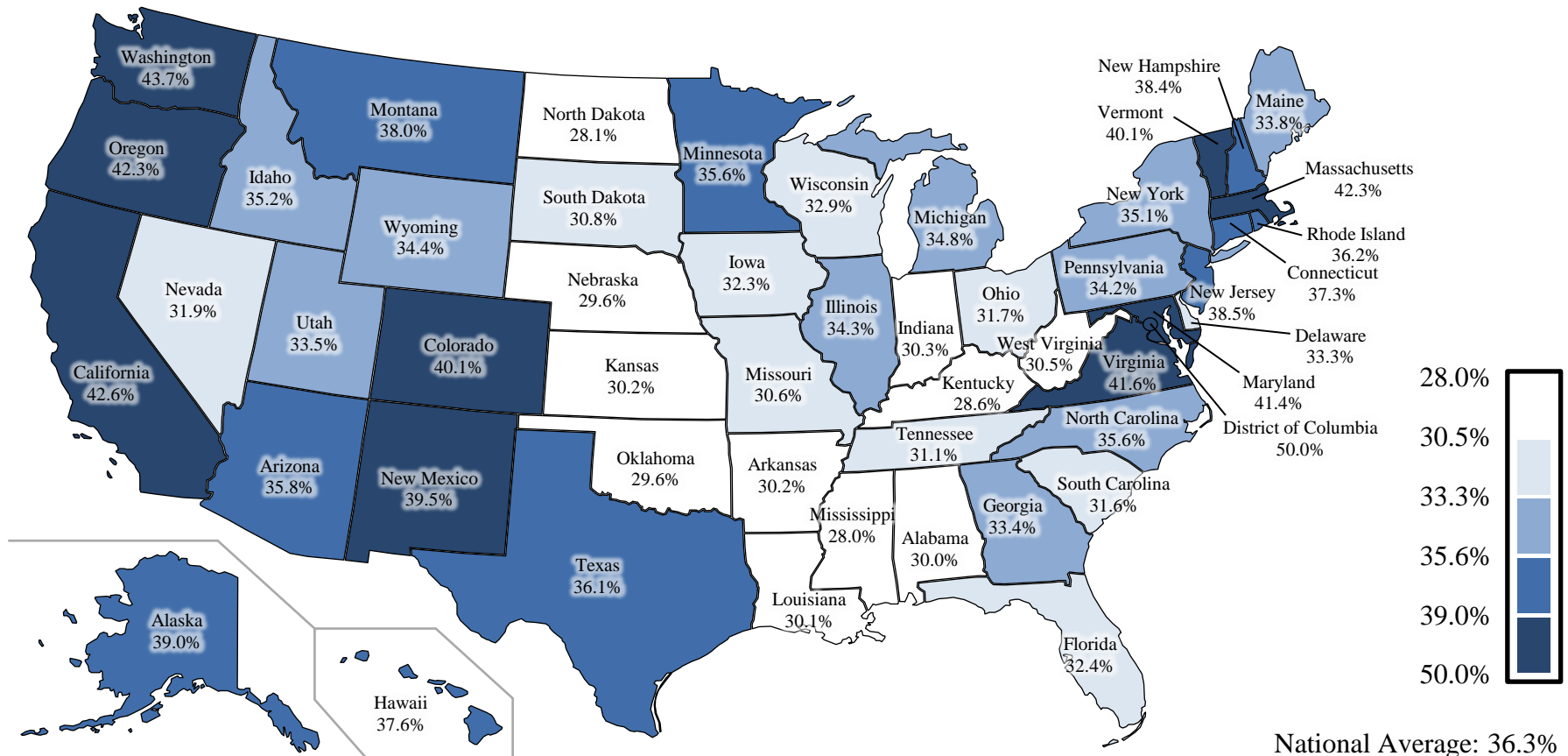

% Population with 1st Major in Science & Engineering of College Graduates Age 25-64 2019 American Community Survey

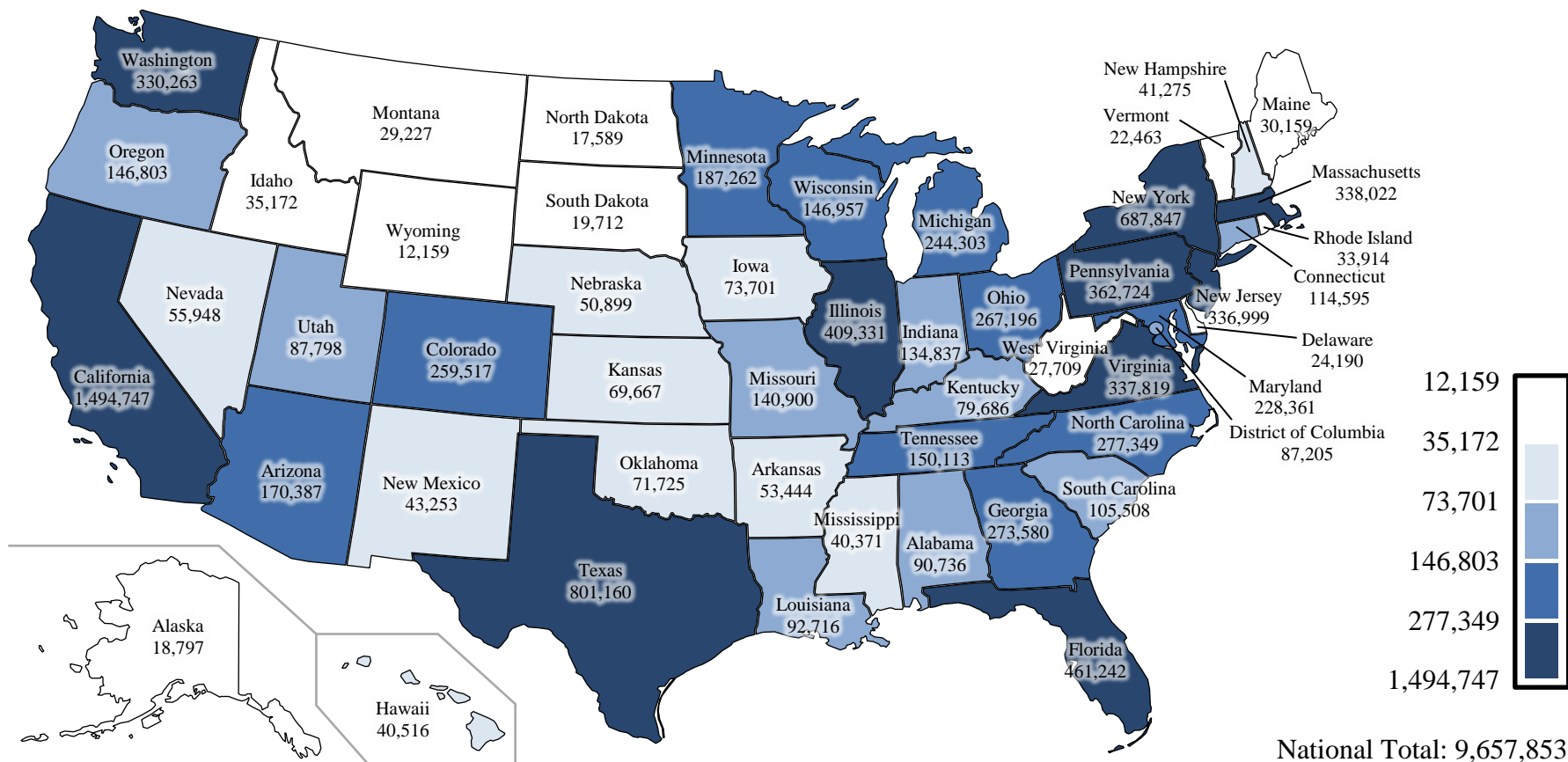

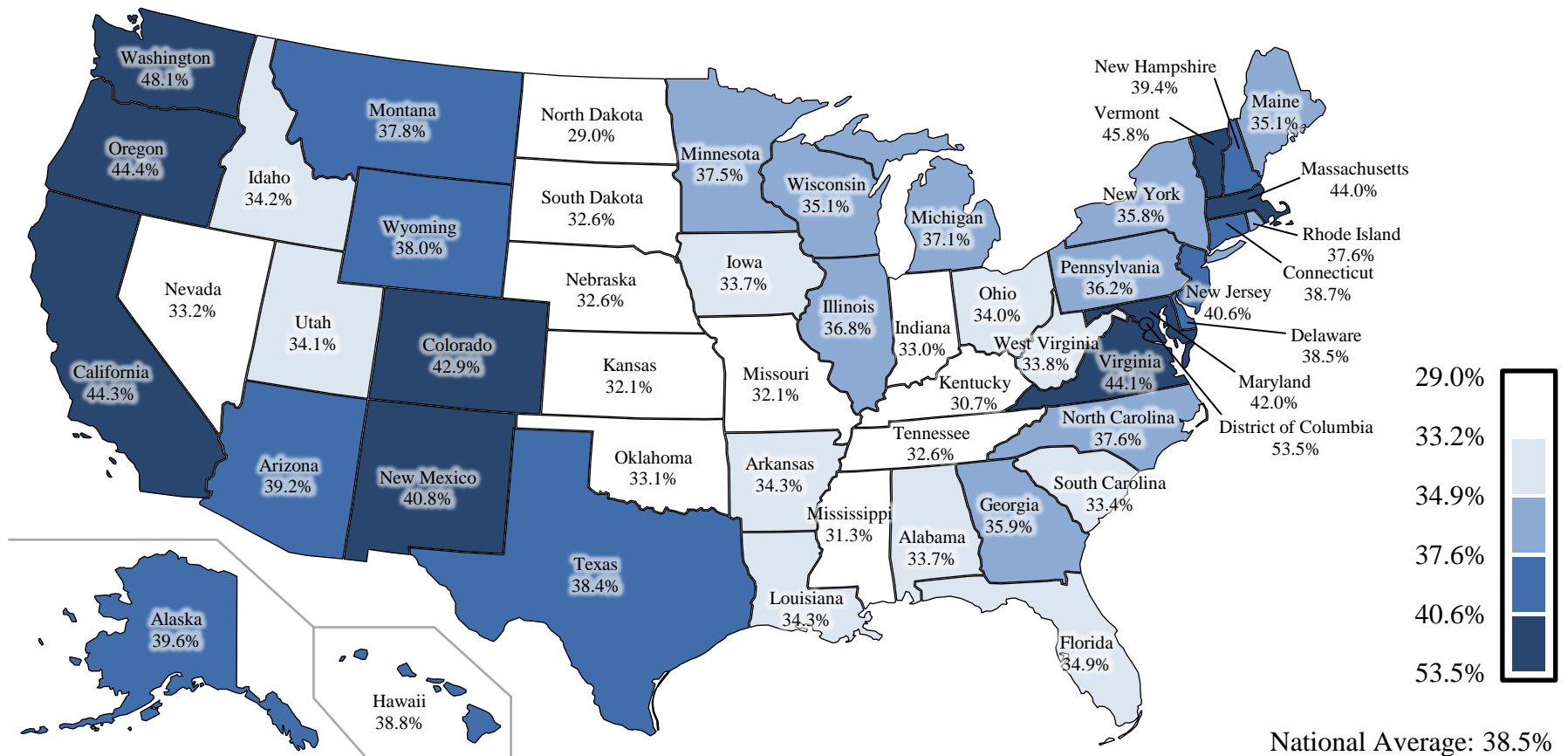

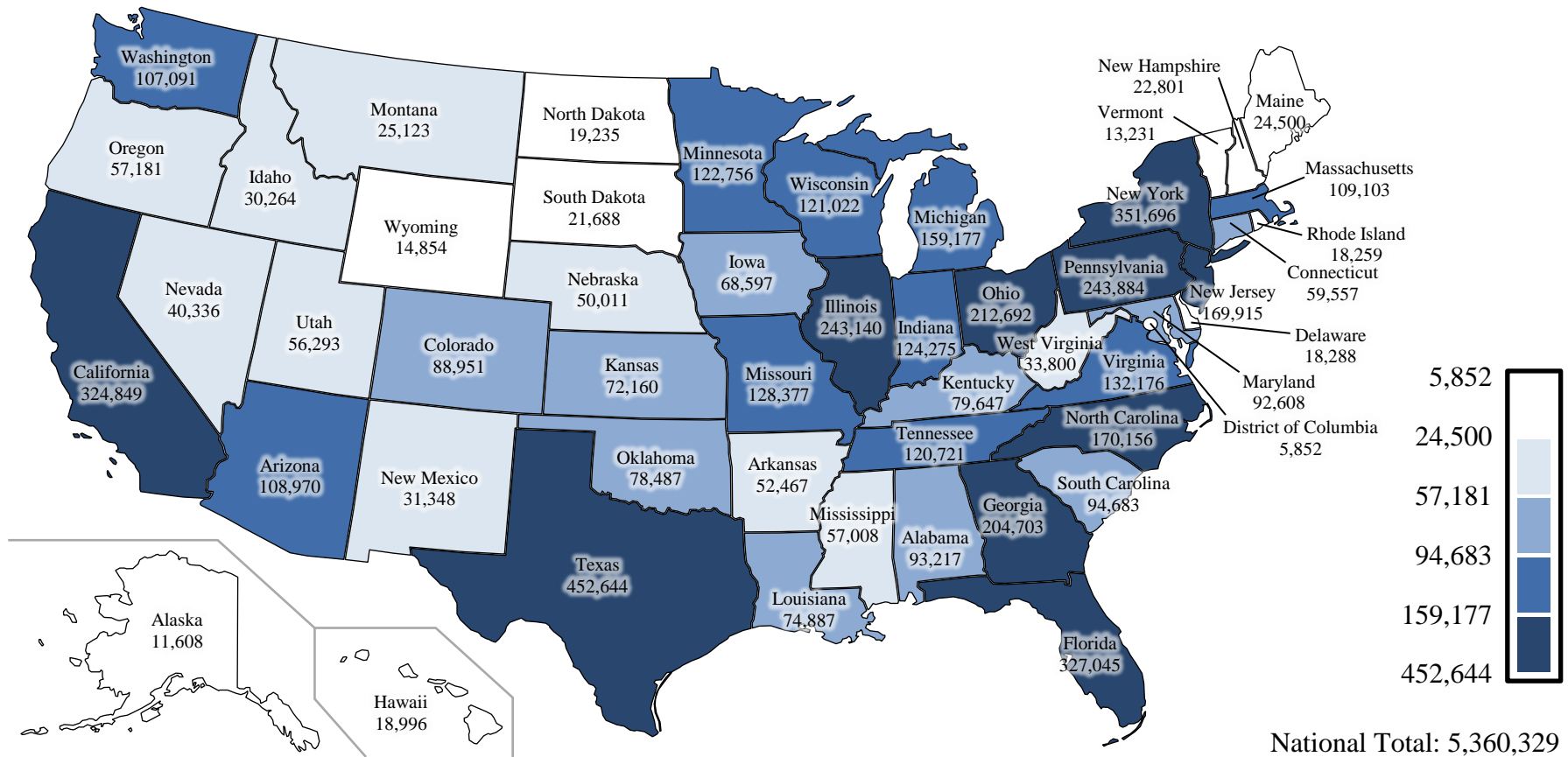

Population with 1st Major in Education Age 25-64

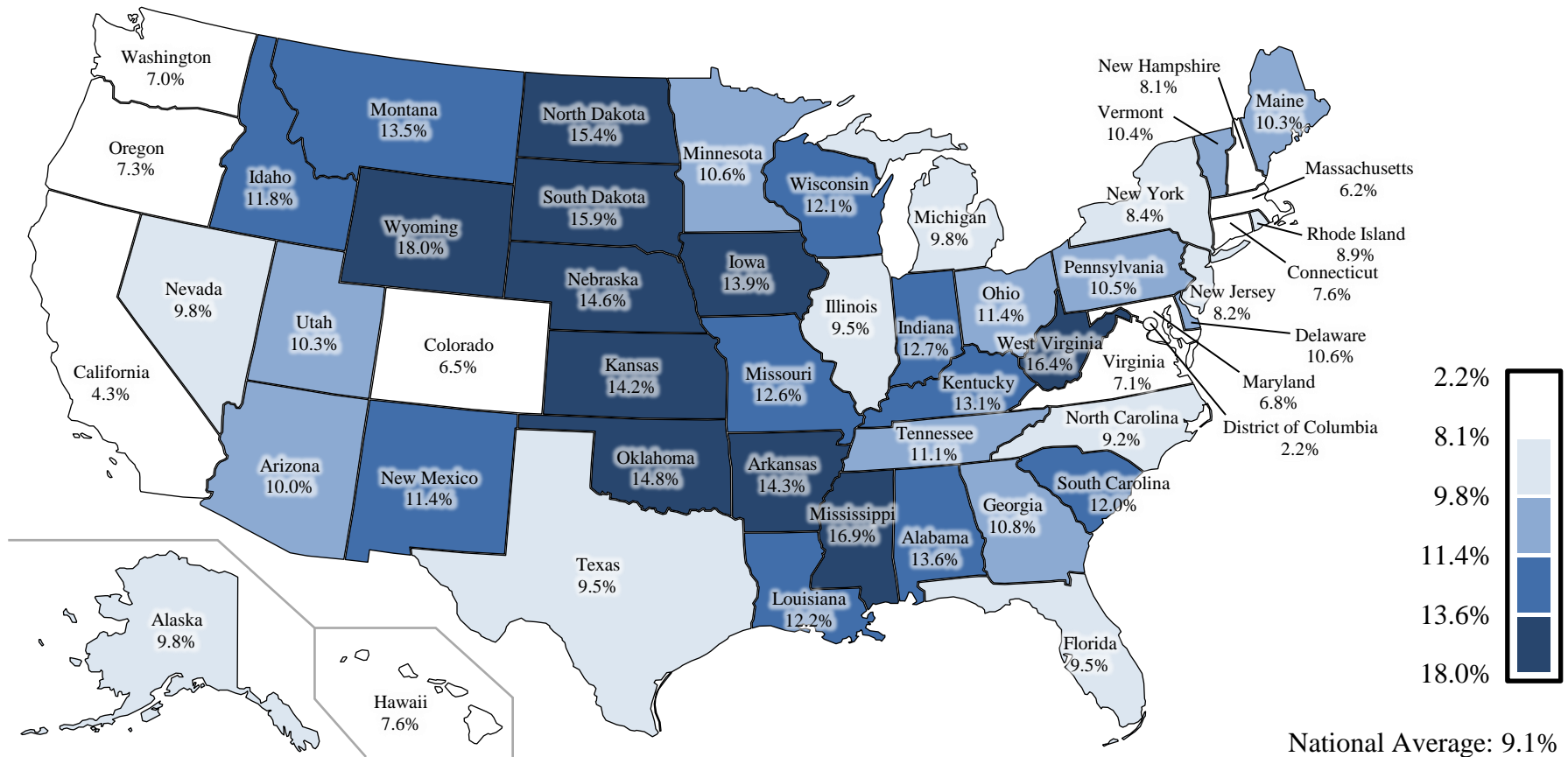

% Population with 1st Major in Education of College Graduates Age 25-64 2019 American Community Survey

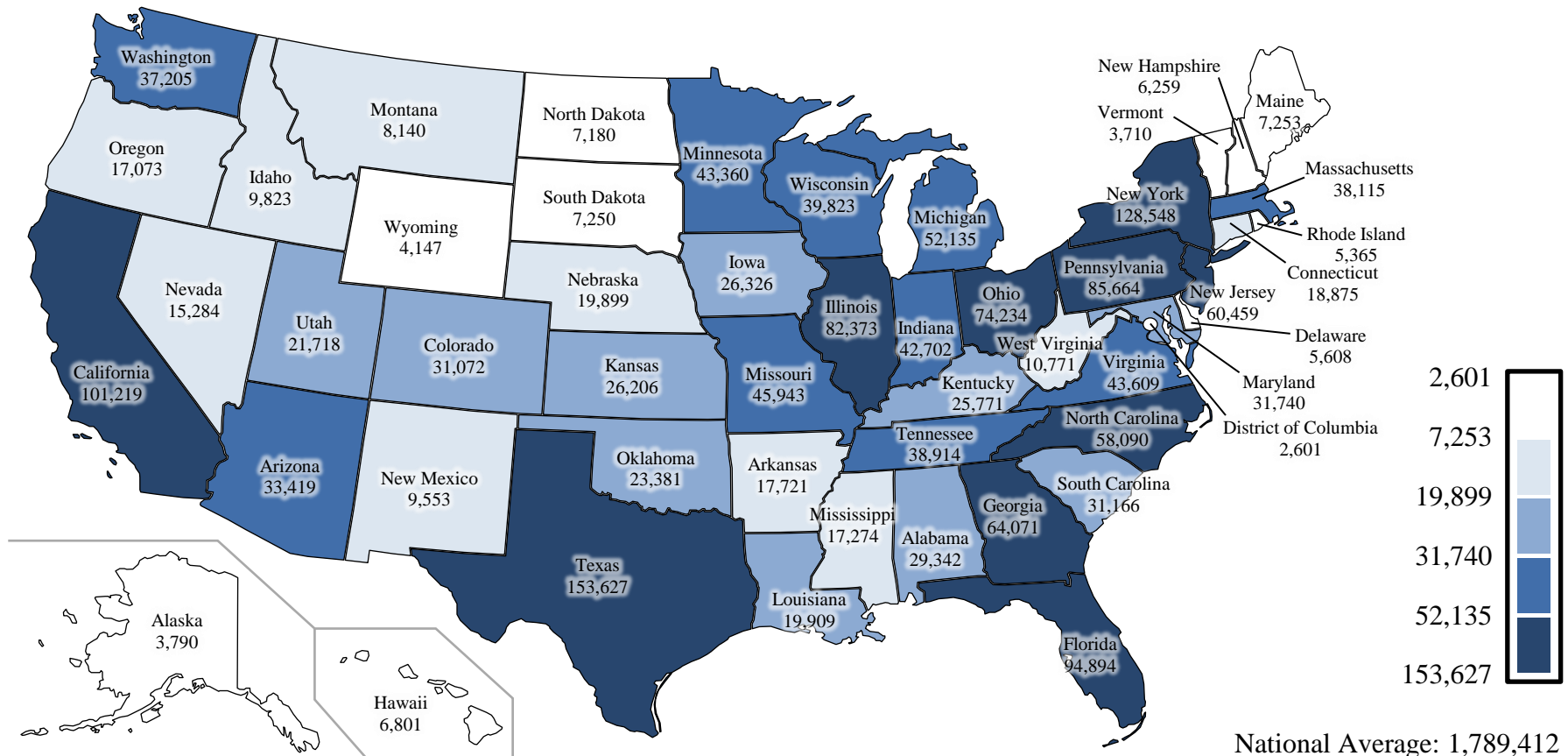

Population with 1st Major in Education Age 25-39

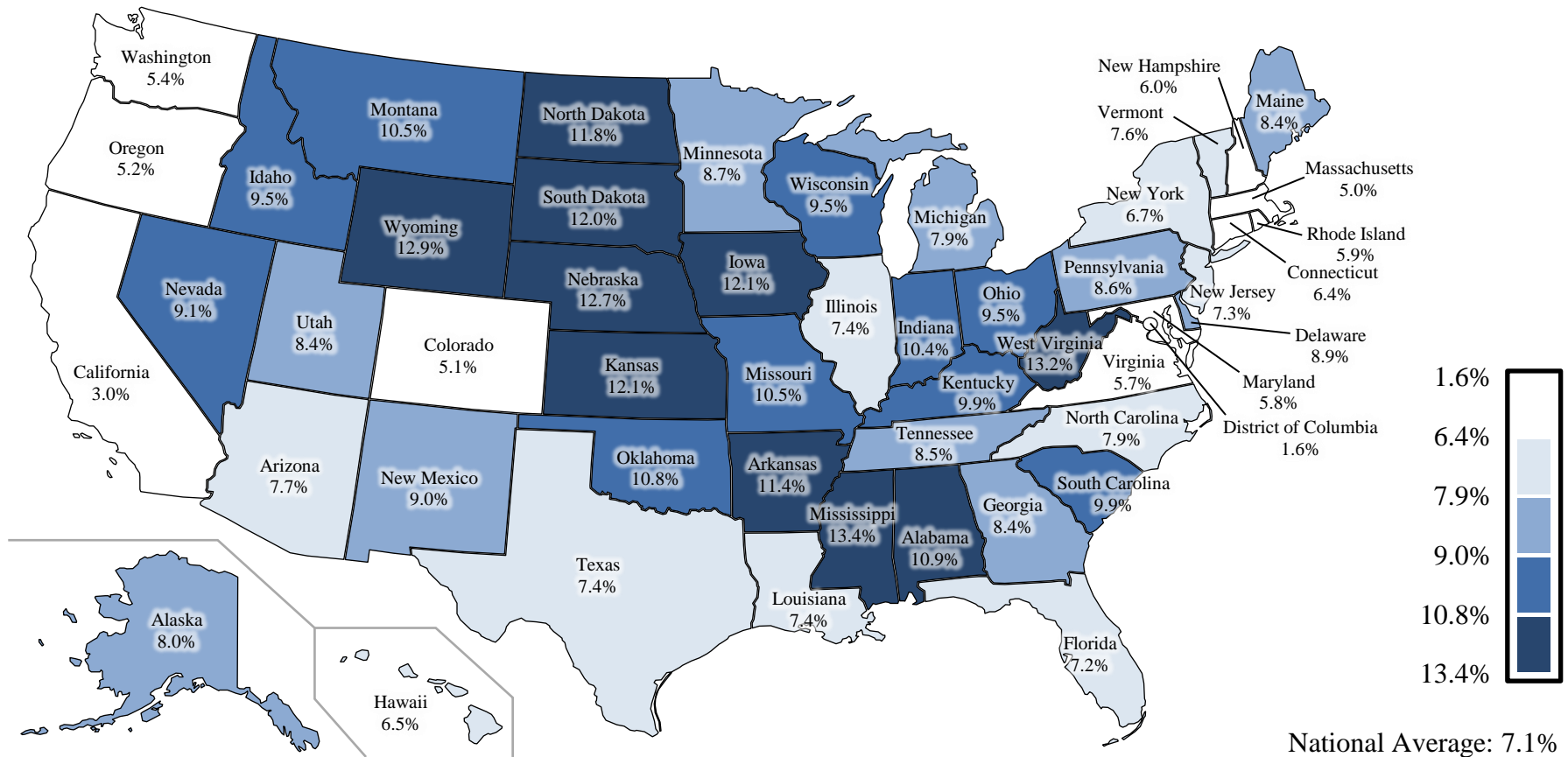

% Population with 1st Major in Education of College Graduates Age 25-39 2019 American Community Survey

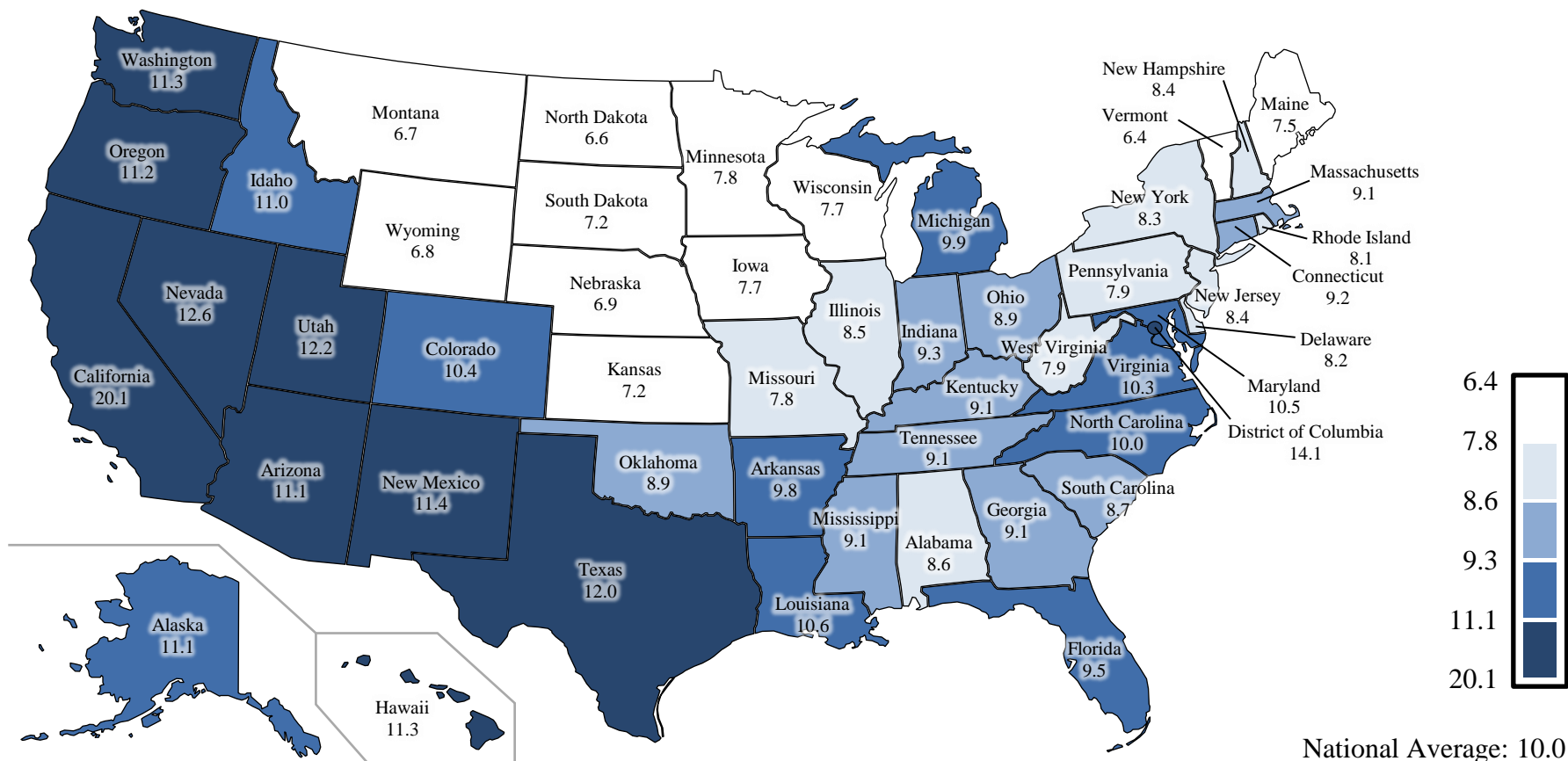

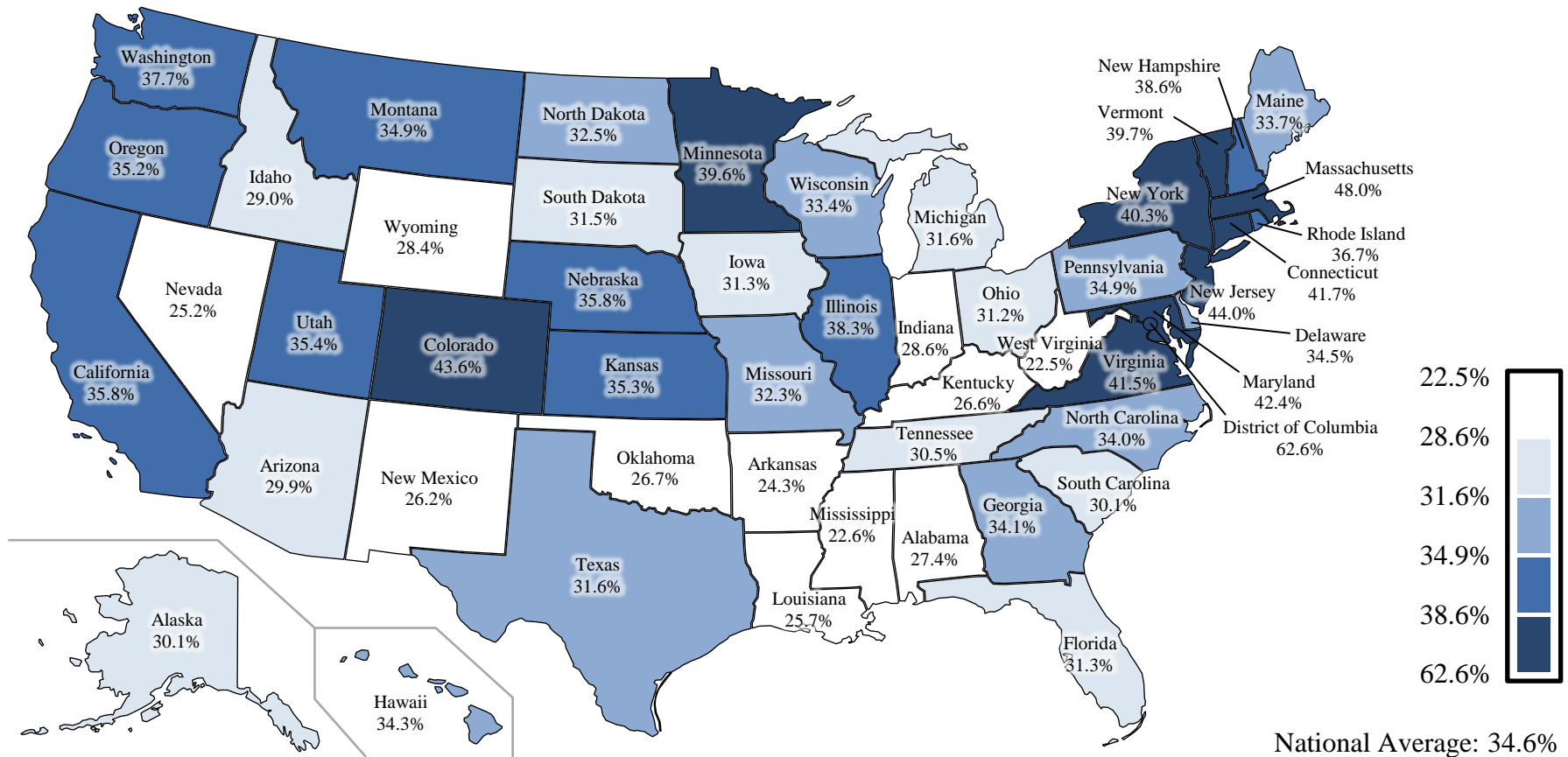

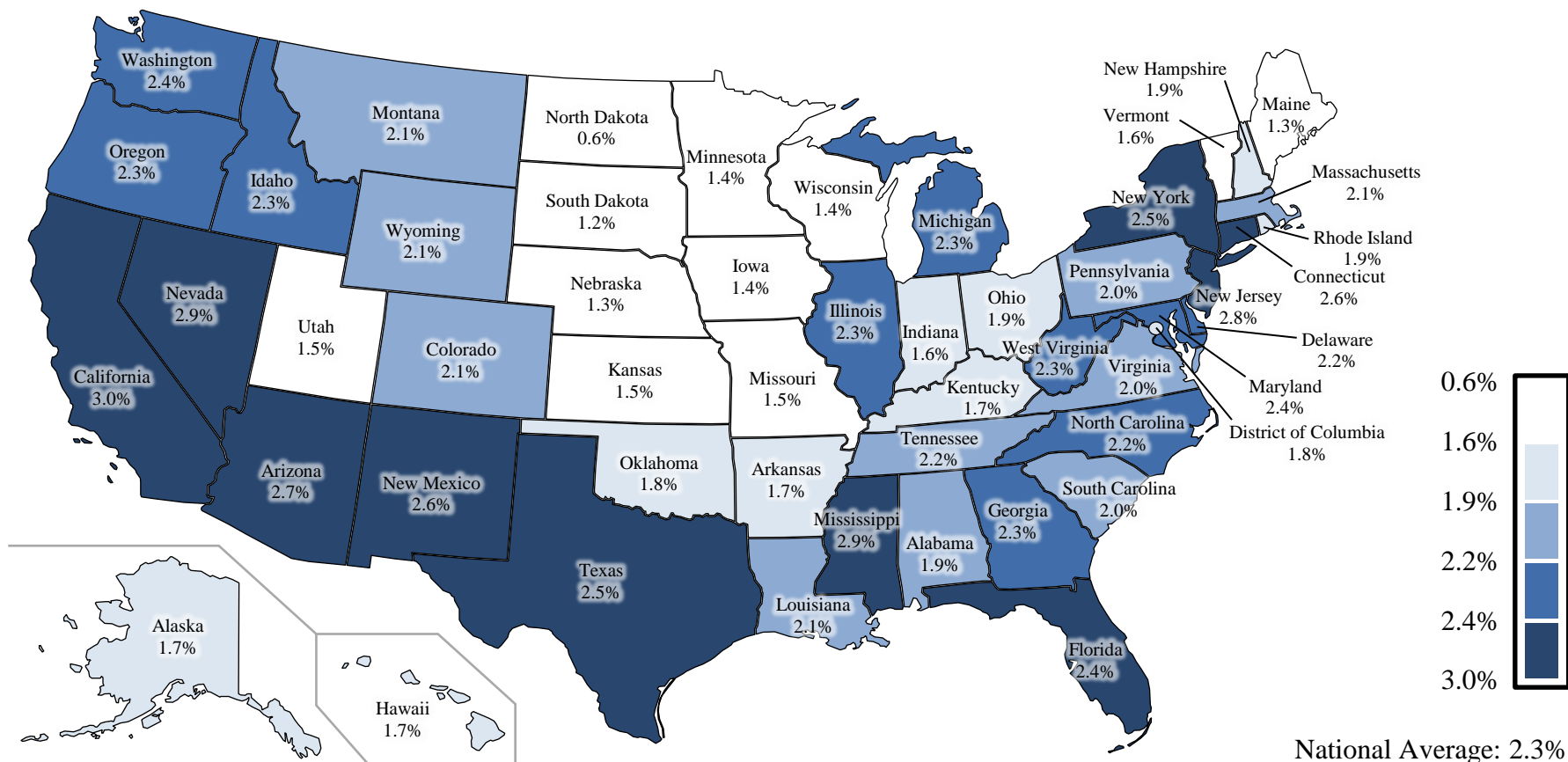

Unemployment Rate among Population with Bachelor's Degree or Higher (Age 25-64)

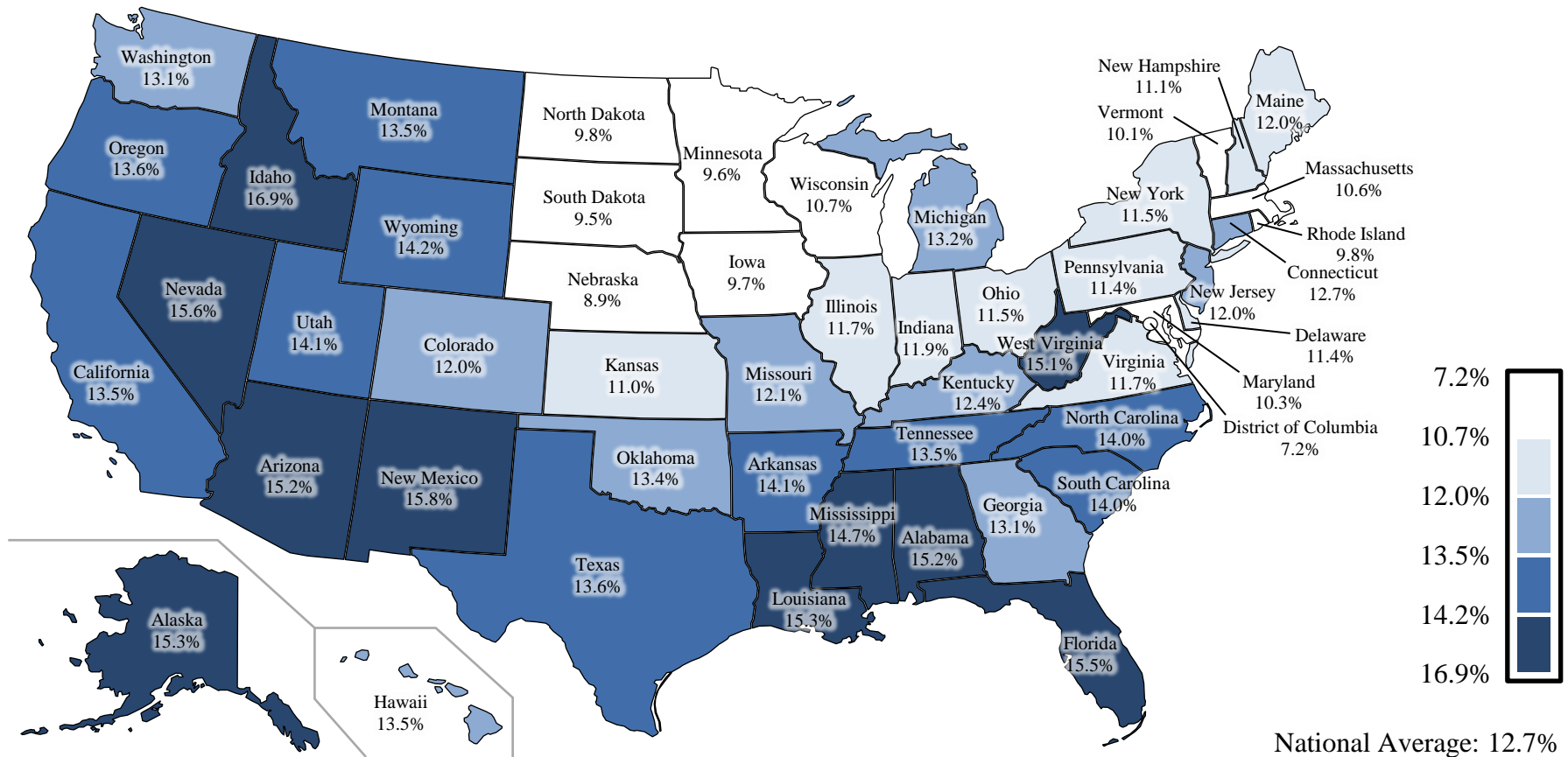
